

EUGENE. the ladies of the Philoptochos hosted a reception for hundreds in attendance for the first native son of the parish to be ordained. That same day was the inauguration of the HOLY ORDER where Archbishop Iakovos inscribed his name as member #1. Father Eugene's initial steps into the priesthood inspired others who had served with him as an altar boy at Three Hierarchs, namely Fr. Bill Bassakyros, Fr. Dean Martin, and Fr. Nick Krommydas.

Ecumenical Patriarch Bartholomew receives Honorary Doctorate by the Sophia University Institute

His Holiness Pope Francis sent a message on Monday, October 27, 2015 on the ochonorary doctorate to His All-Holiness Ecumenical Patriarch Bartholomew of Constantinople. The Honorary Doctorate in the Culture of Unity was granted to the Ecumenical Patriarch by the Sophia University Institute "for

his service to the unity of the human family."

In his message, the Pope casion of the conferral of an said, "I am pleased with this award which, besides being a rightful recognition of his commitment to the promotion of the culture of unity, contributes favourably to the common journey of our churches towards full and visible unity, to which

we tend with dedication and perseverance."

It is the first doctorate in the Culture of Unity awarded honoris causa by the Institute. The Sophia University Institute (IUS) is an academic center for education and research in which life and intellectual inquiry. different cultures and diverse disciplines, meet up in a context

permeated by a strong relational dimension. Sophia Institute is an expression of the Focolare Movement (Work of Mary), developed through the inspiration of its founder, Chiara Lubich, and an international advisory group of scholars from different disciplines.

Ecumenical Patriarch Bartholomew visits Archbishop Justin Welby of Canterbury

At the invitation of the Archbishop of Canterbury, His All-Holiness Ecumenical Patriarch Bartholomew paid a formal visit to Lambeth Palace from November 2-4, 2015. Ecumenical Patriarch Bartholomew, who is based in Istanbul, Turkey, is Archbishop of Constantinople-New Rome, and occupies the First Throne of the Orthodox Christian Church worldwide. The occasion was in response to Archbishop Justin's visit to the Ecumenical Patriarchate last year.

The two leaders presided over ecumenical services filled with symbolic significance, participated in formal functions organized by the Nikaean Club and the Greek Community, and shared private conversations. A service was held at Lambeth Chapel, where the Archbishop of Canterbury welcomed His All-Holiness and congratulated him on the twenty-fourth anniversary of his enthronement.

The two leaders prayed for those affected by conflict, persecution, climate change and

the refugee crisis. In light of this, they agreed to undertake the joint organization of an international conference in Istanbul next year on overcoming modern slavery and human trafficking.

A choral evensoing took place in Westminster Abbey, where the two leaders visited the Shrine of St. Edward the Confessor and blessed the congregation. During the service, the cochairmen of the International Commission for the Anglican-Orthodox Theological Dialogue presented the Archbishop and the Ecumenical Patriarch with a copy of the latest Agreed Statement, entitled In The Image and Likeness of God: A Hope-Filled Anthropology. The text celebrates what Anglicans and Orthodox affirm together about the human person, created in 'the Image and Likeness of God' and will form the theological foundation for forthcoming discussions on the practical consequences of these theological presuppositions for addressing the key themes, including the protection of the environment, medical interventions, and questions around family life and ethics,

The programme also included two formal addresses by the Ecumenical Patriarch on the ethical concerns imposed by the ecological plight of the planet and on the current state of relations between the Orthodox Church and the Anglican Communion.

The visit concluded with the recognition that the Common Statement of the two leaders at their first meeting at the Phanar in January 2014 continued to provide the necessary basis and vision for witnessing to the Gospel of Jesus Christ today and with an invitation extended by His All-Holiness for a joint pilgrimage with the Archbishop of Canterbury to Nicaea and Cappadocia in 2016.

## Ή μακροθυμία τοῦ Θεοῦ

«Διὰ τοῦτο ἠλεήθην, ἶνα ἐν ἐμοὶ πρώτῳ ἐνδείξηται Ἰησοῦς Χριστὸς τὴν πᾶσαν μακροθυμίαν» (Α΄ Τιμ. 1,16)

Δέν θὰ ἔπρεπε, ἀγαπητοί μου, στὸν τόπο μας νὰ ὑπάρχῃ οῦτε ἕνας ἄπιστος καὶ ἄθεος. Γιατὶ τὰ χώματά μας εἶνε ἀγιασμένα· καὶ οἱ πέτρες ἀκόμα θὰ φωνάζουν, ὅτι ἡ θρησκεία μας εἶνε ζωντανή, κάνει θαὑματα. Δυστυχῶς ὅμως τὰ τελευταῖα χρόνια ὑπάρχουν ἄπιστοι καὶ ἄθεοι. Γι' αὐτοὺς ὁ Δαυἰδ λέει· «Εἶπεν ἄφρων ἐν καρδία αὐτοῦ· Οὐκ ἕστι Θεός» (Μἰμ ἰξι ½). Δηλαδή· μόνο ἄνθρωπος ποὺ οἱ διανοητικές του δυνάμεις ἔχουν διασαλευθῆ, μόνο αὐτὸς μπορεῖ νὰ πῇ ὅτι δὲν ὑπάρχει Θεός.

Συναντάτε ἕναν ἄπιστο καὶ ἄθεο; Κάντε του μία ἐρώτησι, καὶ φτάνει· Ἀσφαλῶς, φίλε μου, θὰ κάθεσαι σὲ κάποιο σπίτι. Ἐὰν λοιπὸν μοῦ πῆς ὅτι τὸ σπίτι αὐτὸ φύτρωσε ἕτσι μόνο του, χωρὶς μηχανικὸ καὶ χτίστη, τότε κ' ἐγὼ θὰ δεχθῶ ὅτι τὸ μεγάλο σπίτι ποὺ λέγεται σύμπαν ἔγινε μόνο του. «Πᾶς οἶκος κατασκευάζεται ὑπό τινος, ὁ δὲ τὰ πάντα κατασκευάσας Θεός»(Ἐμ. 3,4). Ἡ λογικὴ ἑπιβάλλει νὰ παραδεχθοῦμε, ὅτι ὑπάρχει Θεὸς ὅημιουργὸς τοῦ παντός.

Ύπάρχουν λοιπὸν ἄπιστοι καὶ ἄθεοι: ὑπάρχουν ὅμως καὶ ἄλλοι, ποὺ λένε ὅτι πιστεύουν, ἕρχονται ὅμως στιγμὲς ποὺ ἡ πίστι τους κλονίζεται. Γιατί; Διότι εἶνε ἀνυπόμονοι. Θέλουν, μέσα στὸ μικρὸ διάστημα τῆς ζωῆς αὐτῆς, νὰ ὅοῦν νὰ λειτουργῆ ἡ θεία δικαιοσύνη, τὸ κακὸ νὰ τιμωρῆται ἀμέσως. Κι ὅταν βλέπουν, κακοὶ καὶ ἐγκληματίες νὰ εἶνε καλὰ καὶ νὰ προοδεύουν, ὅταν βλέπουν τὸ κακὸ νὰ θριαμβεύῃ, χάνουν τὴν πίστι τους καὶ λένε: Ποῦ εἶνε ὁ Θεός; δὲν τὰ βλέπει αὐτά; ὑπάρχει Θεός;...

Μικρέ ἄνθρωπε, σκουλήκι τῆς γῆς, ποὺ θέλεις μὲ τὸ μυαλουδάκι σου νὰ λύσῃς ὅλα τὰ προβλήματα! Ἐὰν τὸ μυρμήγκι δὲν μπορῃ νὰ ξέρῃ τί κάνει ὁ ἄνθρωπος καὶ νὰ τὸν σχολιάσῃ, πολὺ περισσότερο δὲν μπορεῖ ὁ ἄνθρωπος νὰ κρίνῃ τἰς βουλὲς τοῦ Θεοῦ. «Τὰ κρίματα (τοῦ Κυρίου) ὡσεὶ ἄβυσσος πολλή=(ΨψιΞδ. Στήν ἀπορία, γιατί ὁ Θεὸς δὲν τιμωρεῖ τὸ κακὸ ἀμέσως; ἀπαντῷ σήμερα ὁ ἀπόστολος ποὺ ἀκούσαμε. Δὲν τιμωρεῖ, λέει, κεραυνοβόλως τὸ κακὸ ὁ Θεὸς – γιατί; Διότι περιμένει τὴ μετάνοια ὅλων καὶ μακροθυμεῖ.

Περὶ μακροθυμίας λοιπὸν εἶνε ὁ λόγος. Kai ὡς παράδειγμα μακροθυμίας τοῦ Θεοῦ ποιό ἀναφέρει ὁ ἀπόστολος Παῦλος; Πολλὰ μποροῦσε ν' ἀναφέρῃ· τὸν τελώνῃ, τὸ λῃστή, τὴν πόρνῃ, τὸ Δαυίδ, τὸ Μανασσῆ.... Ἀφήνει τοὺς ἄλλους κai ἀναφέρει τὸν ἑαυτό του· λέει, ὅτι εἶνε ὁ πιὸ ἁμαρτωλὸς ἀπ' ὅλους κι ὅτι σ' αὐτὸν ἕδειξε ὁ Θεὸς τὸ ἅπειρό του ἕλεος.

Περίεργα πράγματα! ὁ κορυφαῖος ἀπόστολος Παῦλος ὀνομάζει τὸν ἑαυτό του ἁμαρτωλό; Καὶ τί ἀμαρτία ἔπραξε λοιπόν; Τὸ λέει ὁ ἴδιος. Πρὶν νὰ πιστέψῃ στὸ Χριστό, ἦταν βλάστημος, ὑβριστής, διώκτης: ἀπὸ ἄγνοια βέβαια. Μισοῦσε τὸ Χριστό, κατεδίωκε τοὺς Χριστιανούς, ἔμπαινε στὰ σπίτια, τοὺς ἅρπαζε καὶ τοὺς ὡδηγοῦσε στὶς φυλακές. Ἱστοροῦν μάλιστα οἰ Πράξεις τῶν ἀποστόλων τὸ ἑξῆς ἐπεισόδιο.

Οί Έβραῖοι ἔπιασαν τὸν διάκονο Στέφανο, τὸν δίκασαν καὶ τὸν κατεδίκασαν εἰς θάνατον. Βγῆκαν ἕξω ἀπὸ τὰ Ἱεροσόλυμα, πῆραν ὅλοι πέτρες καὶ τὸν λιθοβολοῦσαν· καὶ γιὰ νὰ εύκολύνωνται στὶς κινήσεις ἔβγαλαν τὰ ροῦχα τους ὅπως οἱ ἀθληταί. Τότε λοιπὸν ποιός φύλαγε τὰ ροῦχα τους; "Ενας νέος, ποὺ φώναζε κι αὐτὸς Χτυπᾶτε τον!... Ποιός ἦταν ὁ νέος αὐτός; Ὁ Παῦλος, ποὺ τότε λεγόταν Σαῦλος β. Βιά 7.58.

<sup>1</sup>Ω μακροθυμία τοῦ Θεοῦ! Σύμφωνα μὲ τὴ θωρία τῶν ἀνυπομόνων, ὁ Θεὸς τὴν ὥρα ἑκείνη θὰ ἔπρεπε νὰ στείλῃ ἕνα κεραυνὸ νὰ τὸν κάψῃ. Δὲν τὸ ἔκανε. Γιατί; Περίμενε τὴ μετάνοιά του. Καὶ ὄντως ἦρθε ἡ ὥρα ποὺ ὁ διώκτης, ὁ βλάστημος καὶ ὁ ὑβριστὴς μετανόησε, καὶ ἔγινε τὸ μεγάλο θαῦμα· ὁ λύκος αὐτὸς ἔγινε ἀρνί· καὶ ὄχι μόνο ἀρνὶ τοῦ Χριστοῦ ἔγινε, ἀλλὰ καὶ τσοπάνης, ποιμένας καὶ διδάσκαλος καὶ κορυφαῖος ἀπόστολος.

Αὐτὸ λοιπὸν τὸ παρελθὸν τῆς ζωῆς του ἔχει στὸ νοῦ ὁ ἀπόστολος Παῦλος ὅταν λέῃ, «Διὰ τοῦτο ἡλεήθην, ἶνα ἐν ἐμοὶ πρώτῳ ἐνδείξηται Ἰησοῦς Χριστὸς τὴν πᾶσαν μακροθυμίαν»[κ Ἰμ 1,18, Σ' ἐμένα τὸν ἀμαρτωλό, ποὺ ἕπρεπε ν' ἀνοίξῃ ἡ γῆ νὰ μὲ καταπιῇ, ὁ Θεὸς ἔδειξε τὸ μεγάλο του ἕλεος, γιὰ νὰ γίνω παράδειγμα σὲ ὅλους ὅσοι θὰ πιστεύουν.

Ό Θεός, άδελφοί μου, ἕδειξε μακροθυμία στὸν ἀπόστολο Παῦλο. Ἀλλὰ καὶ σ' ἐμᾶς σήμερα δείχνει τὴ μακροθυμία του. Καὶ στὸ σημεῖο αὐτὸ παρακαλῶ νὰ μὲ προσέξετε.

Ποιός μπορεϊ νὰ ἀρνηθῇ ὅτι ἀμαρτάνουμε; Ώκεανὸς τὰ ἀμαρτήματά μας! Μόνο ὅποιος δὲν διάβασε τὸ Εὐαγγέλιο καὶ δὲν πέρασε τὴ ζωή του ἀπὸ τὸ κόσκινο αὐτὸ καὶ δὲν ἑξέτασε βαθειὰ τὸν ἑαυτό του, αὐτὸς νομίζει ὅτι δὲν εἶνε ἀμαρτωλός. Ὅταν βλέπῃς ἕναν ἀπόστολο Παῦλο νὰ πέφτῃ μπροστὰ στὸν Ἐσταυρωμένο καὶ νὰ λέῃ «Εἶμαι ὁ πιὸ ἀμαρτωλὸς ἀπ' ὅλους» [μ.κ Τιμ.1,5], τί νὰ ποῦμε ἑμεῖς τὰ σκουλήκια;

Άμαρτάνουμε. Μήπως ό Θεὸς ἀγνοεῖ τὰ ἀμαρτήματά μας; Τὰ γνωρίζει ὅλα. Μήπως ἀδιαφορεῖ; Ὅχι βέβαια: «βδέλυγμα» εἶνε μπροστά του κάθε ἁμαρτία [β. Πιφμ 15.8.Σ Ιαρ. 15,13 ¾ 1,13 ¾, Μήπως ἀδυνατεῖ νὰ τιμωρήση; – γιατὶ ὑπάρχει κι αὐτὴ ἡ θεωρία. Λάθος κάνετε, ἀγατητοί μου. Οὕτε ἀγνοεῖ, οὕτε ἀδιαφορεῖ, οῦτε ἀδυνατεῖ. Ἐχει τὴ δύναμι νὰ τιμωρήσῃ αὐτοστιγμεί.

Μπορεϊ νὰ πατάξη ἀσέβειες, ἀθεοφοβίες, βλασφημίες, ψεύδη, συκοφαντίες, διαβολές, πορνεῖες, μοιχεῖες, ψευδορκίες: ἡ ἐντολή του μένει<sup>\*</sup> «Οὐ λήψει τὸ ὄνομα Κυρίου τοῦ Θεοῦ σου ἐπὶ ματαίψ» (Ἐ, ಐ, ?. μεπ. 5, ΙΙ). Μπορεῖ νὰ κάνῃ σεισμὸ διαρκείας καὶ νὰ μὴ μείνῃ τίποτα ὄρθιο. Μπορεῖ. "Η πιστεύεις, ἢ δὲν πιστεύεις. "Αν δὲν πιστεύῃς, τότε μὴν πατặς καὶ στὴν ἐκκλησία τὸ «εἰσιτήριο» εἰσόδου εἶνε ἡ πίστις<sup>-</sup> «Υπέρ τοῦ ἀγίου οἶκου τούτου καὶ τῶν με τὰ πίστεως, εὐλαβείας καὶ φόβου Θεοῦ εἰσιόντων ἐν αὐτῷ τοῦ Κυρίου δεηθῶμεν» [ἐ. μεπ.]. "Αν ἔχῃς πίστι, ἕλα. Καὶ ἂν πιστεύῃς ὅτι ὑπάρχει Θεός, τότε τὸ δαχτυλάκι του μόνο νὰ κουνήσῃ ὁ Χριστός, κάρβουνο γίναμε ὅλοι. Δὲν τὸ καταλάβαμε;

Καὶ ὅμως ὁ Χριστὸς δὲν μᾶς καίει, δὲν κάνει σεισμό, δὲν ἀνοίγει τὴ γῆ νὰ μᾶς καταπιῆ. Γιατί; Διότι μᾶς περιμένει νὰ μετανοήσουμε.

Άγαπητοί μου ἀδελφοί. Ὁ Κύριος στὸ Εὐαγγέλιο λέει, τί θὰ προηγηθῃ τῆς συντελείας τοῦ κόσμου. Καὶ τὰ σημάδια τώρα δείχνουν ὅτι ἡ συντέλεια πλησιάζει. Ἡ εἰρήνη κρέμεται ἀπὸ μιὰ κλωστή. Τυφλός, χειρότερος ἀπὸ τὸν τυφλὸ τοῦ σημερινοῦ εὐαγγελίου, ὅποιος δὲν βλέπει «τὰ σημεῖα τῶν καιρῶν» (Μιθ.ἰβ.). Ποιά εἶνε «τὰ σημεῖα τῶν καιρῶν»; δὲν ἔχω καιρὸ νὰ τ' ἀναπτύξω· ἕνα, δύο, τρία, τέσσερα, πέντε.

Οί ἄνθρωποι θὰ ζοῦν ὅπως τὸν καιρὸ τοῦ Νῶε· οἱ τελευταῖες ἡμέρες τῆς ἀνθρωπότητος θὰ εἶνε «ὥσπερ ai ἡμέραι τοῦ Νῶε» Μιτί ¾37). Διαβάστε τί γινόταν τότε· παρὰ τἰς εἰδοποιήσεις αὐτοὶ γλεντοῦσαν, κάγχαζαν, παντρεύονταν, ὡργίαζαν, βλαστημοῦσαν τὸ Θεό. Μέσ' στὰ συμπόσια, τὰ ἐμπόρια καὶ τὴ σαρκολατρία τους, ὁ Νῶε χτύπησε καμπάνα μεγάλη. Θὰ καταστρέψῃ ὁ Θεὸς τὸν κόσμο! τοὺς εἶπε. Γελοῦσαν. Τοὺς περίμενε ὁ Θεός –ὥ μακροθυμία!– πόσο; 120 χρόνια, ὅσο κατασκευαζόταν ἡ κιβωτός. Καμμία σημασία δὲν ἔδιναν. "Εως ὅτου ἄνοιξαν οἱ καταρράκτες τοῦ οὑρανοῦ, τὰ νερὰ κάλυψαν καὶ τἰς πιὸ ψηλὲς κορυφές, καὶ ἕτοι θάφτηκαν οἱ πάντες μέσα στὸν ὑγρὸ τάφο.

Κάτι τέτοιο θὰ συμβῆ καὶ τώρα. Άλλ' αὐτὴ τὴ φορὰ δὲν θὰ πέσῃ βροχούλα· θὰ γίνῃ κατακλυσμὸς πυρός. Θὰ πέσουν «φιάλες», λέει ἡ Ἀποκάλυψις [ΙΙ. ξ]? Ιξ.], πυρηνικὴ ἐνέργεια. "Ερχεται ἡ ῶρα, «ἔρχεται ἡ ὀργὴ τοῦ Θεοῦ ἐπὶ τοὺς υἰοὺς τῆς ἀπειθείας» (Ελ.5& Kol. 38).

Μάς κρατάει ή μακροθυμία τοῦ Θεοῦ. Κρεμόμαστε άπό μιὰ κλωστή, άπό τὴ φιλανθρωπία του. Όπως λένε οἱ πατέρες, ή μακροθυμία τοῦ Θεοῦ εἶνε ἕνα ποτήρι. Κ' ἐμεῖς τί κάνουμε·κάθε μέρα ρίχνουμε μέσα στὸ ποτήρι άμαρτίες ένα ψέμα, μιὰ συκοφαντία, μιὰ ψευδορκία, μιὰ πορνεία, ἕνα ἄτιμο διαζύγιο, μιὰ ἀδικία... "Ετσι γεμίζει τὸ ποτήρι. "Αμα ξεχειλίση, θὰ τελειώση ή μακροθυμία τοῦ Θεοῦ, καὶ τότε - άλλοίμονο- φεύγουμε άπὸ τὴ μακροθυμία καὶ θὰ πέσουμε – ποῦ; στὴ δικαιοσύνη του. Διότι είνε «δίκαιος ό Κύριος καὶ δικαιοσύνας ήγάπησε» (4ωμ 108) καὶ «Δικαιοσύνην μάθετε...» καὶ «Πρόσθες αὐτοῖς κακά.... τοῖς ἐνδόξοις τής γής» (Ha. 36.9.15). Κι όταν πέσουμε στη δικαιοσύνη τοῦ Θεοῦ, τότε θὰ γίνη αὐτὸ ποὺ λένε οι προφητεῖες: θὰ πᾶμε στὰ μνήματα τῶν γονέων μας καὶ θὰ φωνάξουμε· «Βγῆτε, σεῖς οί πεθαμένοι, νὰ μποῦμε ἐμεῖς οί ζωντανοί». Θὰ πᾶμε στὰ σπήλαια καὶ στὰ βράχια καὶ θὰ πούμε Άνοιξτε, βουνά, και κρύψτε μας (πβ). λη 6,15-16) ἀπὸ «τὴν ὀργὴν τὴν ἐρχομένην» (Χ θεα. 1,10), τή μεγάλη όργη του Θεού. Είθε ό Κύριος διά πρεσβειών τῆς Παναγίας Θεοτόκου καὶ πάντων τῶν ἀγίων νὰ ἑλεήσῃ καὶ σώσῃ ἡμᾶς ἀμήν.

### Imitating the Prodigal

Do not lose heart, O soul, do not grieve; pronounce not over yourself a final judgment for the multitude of your sins; do not commit yourself to fire; do not say: The Lord has cast me from his face. Such words are not pleasing to God. Can it be that he who has fallen cannot get up? Can it be that he who has turned away cannot turn back again? Do you not hear how kind the Father is to a predigal?
