

6th Sunday of Matthew

The Gospel according to Matthew 9:1-8

At that time, getting into a boat Jesus crossed over and came to his own city. And behold, they brought to him a paralytic, lying on his bed; and when Jesus saw their faith he said to the paralytic, "Take heart, my son; your sins are forgiven." And behold, some of the scribes said to themselves, "This man is blaspheming." But Jesus, knowing their thoughts, said, "Why do you think evil in your hearts? For which is easier, to say 'Your sins are forgiven,' or to say 'Rise and walk?' But that you may know that the Son of man has authority on earth to forgive sins" he then said to the paralytic -- "Rise, take up your bed and go home." And he rose and went home. When the crowds saw it, they were afraid, and they glorified God, who had given such authority to men.




Today July 31st We Honor St. Joseph Of Arimathea

The supreme religious Council as well as the highest court in the ancient Jewish nation bore the name of Sanhedrin. It bears a close resemblance to the Greek word "synedrion" which has similar meaning, literally :sitting together. The Sanhedrin appears as the body which voted to condemn Jesus to death. Although Joseph of Arimathea is remembered as the leading Council member he abstained in the voting. Chapter 23, Verse 50 of St. Luke

And behold there was a man named Joseph, a councilor and he was a good man, and just; he was of Arimathea, a city of Jews, who also waited for the Kingdom of God.

This man went unto Pilate and begged for the body of Jesus





When Joseph had taken the body, he wrapped it in a clean linen cloth and laid it in his own new tomb, which he had hewn out of a rock.

Joseph of Arimathea joined with St Philip and a dozen other apostles in an arduous and dangerous journey to the far away island now known as England.

The missionaries were at first eyed with suspicion, but they made steady progress in the Christianization of the people.

A chapel was erected in the name of the Archangel Gabriel, a favorite patron saint of Joseph of Arimathea's. He lived out his remaining days there and was buried in what is now Avlon, thousands of miles from the tomb he gave to Jesus years before.

This Saturday August 6 The Holy Transfiguration of Christ.


The transfiguration of Jesus is a miracle.

Apostles Peter, John and James accompany Jesus to the top of Mt. Tabor for a personal glimpse of the power of God the Father.

Here Jesus is bathed in a dazzling glow of radiating glorious light and hears God declare

<< This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased>> .

The apostles witness to the divine vocal declaration and the apparition of Moses and Elijah in conversation with Jesus.



The two prophets represent the Law of God (Commandments) and the Prophecies of the Old Testament referring to the Messiah.

Here, both prophets encourage the "son of man" Jesus to endure the forthcoming **PASSION OF THE CROSS**

Τὸ χειρότερο κακὸ

 ὰ μιλήσουμε, ἀγαπητοί μου, ὅπως πάντοτε, ἀπλᾶ.

Ένα κακὸ ποὺ φοβοῦνται ὅλοι εἶνε ἡ ἀσθένεια. Ἐὰν ἀρρωστήσουν οἱ ἄνθρωποι, ἀνησυχοῦν, τρέχουν στὸ γιατρό, ἀγοράζουν φάρμακα, προσπαθοῦν νὰ γίνουν καλά. Ὑπάρχει ἄραγε ἄλλο κακὸ μεγαλύτερο ἀπὸ τὴν ἀρρώστια; Σ' αὐτὸ τὸ ἐρώτημα θ' ἀπαντήσουμε.

"Ένας δάσκαλος ρώτησε μιὰ μέρα τοὺς μαθητάς. Άπὸ τὰ δυσάρεστα ποὺ συμβαίνουν στὸν κόσμο ἐσᾶς ποιό σᾶς κάνει πιὸ μεγάλη εντύπωσι; Οἱ μαθηταὶ ἀπήντησαν. "Ένας εἶπε· Έμένα μοῦ φαίνεται μεγάλο κακὸ νὰ τρακάρουν δυὸ αὐτοκίνητα καὶ νὰ σκοτωθῆ ἄνθρωπος. "Αλλος εἶπε" Κακὸ εἶνε νὰ περνάη λεωφορεῖο ἀπὸ μιὰ γέφυρα, ξαφνικὰ ή γέφυρα νὰ πέση, τὸ λεωφορεῖο καὶ βρεθῆ μέσ' στὸ ποτάμι καὶ νὰ πνιγοῦν οἱ ἐπιβάτες. "Άλλος ἀπήντησε: Κακὸ εἶνε νὰ γίνη ναυάγιο, νὰ καταποντισθή τὸ καράβι καὶ ὅλοι οἱ ἐπιβάτες νὰ χαθοῦν. "Αλλος εἶπε: Κακὸ εἶνε νὰ πετᾶς καὶ ξαφνικά τὸ ἀεροπλάνο νὰ πέση καὶ νὰ γίνη κομμάτια. "Αλλος εἶπε· Έγὼ θεωρῶ φοβερὸ νὰ πέση πεῖνα καὶ νὰ μὴν ἔχουν οἱ ἄνθρωποι ψωμὶ νὰ φᾶνε. "Άλλος εἶπε· Κακὸ μεγάλο εἶνε νὰ γίνη σεισμός, νὰ γκρεμιστοῦν τὴ νύχτα ὅλα τὰ σπίτια, καὶ νὰ πλακωθοῦν χιλιάδες ἄνθρωποι. "Άλλος είπε: Κακὸ είνε νὰ γίνη πυρκαῖά. Καὶ ἄλλος εἶπε· Κακὸ εἶνε νὰ γίνη πόλεμος. -Τελειώσατε; ρώτησε ὁ δάσκαλος. "Εχετε κάτι ἄλλο νὰ πῆτε; Κακὰ εἶνε ὅλα αὐτά- μὰ παραπάνω ἀπ' αὐτὰ ὑπάρχει ἔνα ἄλλο κακὸ πολύ μεγαλύτερο... Θεέ μου, φώτισέ μας νὰ τὸ καταλάβουμε. Τὸ μεγαλύτερο ἀπ' ὅλα τὰ κακὰ εἶνε μιὰ λέξι, ποὺ δὲν τὴν προσέχουμε. Τὴν ἀκοῦμε στὴν ἐκκλησία, στὰ ἰερὰ βιβλίατὸ μεγαλύτερο κακὸ είνε ή άμαρτία. Ποιός τὸ λέει αὐτό; Τὸ λέει τὸ εὐαγγέλιο σήμερα.

Σὲ κάποιο χωριὸ ζοῦσε ἔνα παλληκάρι. "Η-

ταν γερός, μὲ μπράτσα καὶ πόδια δυνατά. "Ετρεχε σὰν τὸ ζαρκάδι, πήγαινε ὅπου ἤθελε, ἔκανε δουλειές – χαρά στὸ σπίτι του. Μὰ ξαφνικὰ ἔνα βράδυ μούδιασε τὸ πόδι του τὸ δεξιό, τὸ ἀριστερό, μούδιασε ὅλο τὸ κορμί του κ' ἔπεσε στὸ κρεβάτι. Δὲν μπόρεσε πιὰ νὰ σηκωθῆ. Αὐτός, ποὺ ἔτρεχε χιλιόμετρα, δὲν μποροῦσε νὰ κάνη ἔνα βῆμα, οὔτε τὸ κουτάλι του νὰ σηκώση· ἡ μάνα του τὸν τάῖζε. Πόδια εἶχε, καὶ πόδια δὲν εἶχε· χέρια εἶχε, καὶ χέρια δὲν εἶχε. Ἡπλῶς μόνο ἀνέπνεε, τίποτα περισσότερο. Οἱ γονεῖς του ἀσφαλῶς θὰ ἔκαναν ὅ,τι ἔλεγε ἡ ἐπιστήμη. Ἡλλὰ τοῦ κάκου· ὁ παράλυτος ἔμενε ἀθεράπευτος, σὰν νεκρὸς πάνω στὸ κρεβάτι.

Πέρασαν χρόνια ἔτσι. Κάποτε ἀκούστηκε, ὅτι ἦρθε στὸ χωριὸ κάποιος ξένος. Ἡταν πάμπτωχος, δὲν εἶχε δραχμὴ στὴν τσέπη, δὲν εἶχε σπίτι νὰ κοιμηθῆ· ὅταν ὅμως μιλοῦσε τὰ λόγια του ἦταν γλυκύτερα ἀπ' τὸ μέλι, κι ὅπου ἄπλωνε τὸ ἄγιό του χέρι ἔκανε θαύματα. Ὅλοι γι' αὐτόν μιλοῦσαν. Ἡταν ὁ Χριστός. Ὅταν ἄκουσε γι' αὐτὸν τὸ παλληκάρι, εἶπε· Ὁ Χριστὸς θὰ μὲ κάνῃ καλά! Παρακάλεσε φίλους καὶ συγγενεῖς, τὸν σήκωσαν καὶ τὸν πῆγαν στὸ Χριστό.

Τί περίμενε τώρα ὁ παράλυτος ἀπὸ τὸ Χριστό; Ν' ἀπλώση τὸ ἄγιό του χέρι ἐπάνω του καὶ νὰ τὸν κάνη καλά. Αὐτὸ ἔκανε ὁ Χριστός; Δὲν ἔκανε αὐτό. "Η μάλλον τὸ ἔκανε κι αὐτό, ἀλλὰ προηγουμένως τοῦ λέει: «Θάρσει, τέκνον ἀφέωνταί σοι αί άμαρτίαι σου» παιδί μου ἔχε θάρρος, σοῦ συγχωροῦνται τὰ άμαρτήματά σου (Μπί! 92). Γιατί ἄραγε, ἐνῷ πῆγε γιὰ νὰ θεραπευθῆ ἀπὸ τὴν ἀσθένεια τοῦ σώματος, ὁ Χριστὸς πρῶτα εἴπε «Τέκνον ἀφέωνταί σοι αί άμαρτίαι σου»; Τί ἤθελε νὰ δείξη μ' αὐτό;

Δὲν ἀδιαφορεῖ ὁ Χριστὸς γιὰ τὸ σῶμα. "Όχι. Γιατὶ καὶ τὸ σῶμα ὁ Θεὸς τὸ ἔφτειαξε, κ' εἶνε ἔνα ἀριστούργημα. Καὶ ἡ καρδιὰ καὶ τὰ πνευμόνια καὶ οἱ ἀρτηρίες καὶ τὰ νεῦρα, ὅλα εἶνε ἀξιοθαύμαστα. "Ένδιαφέρεται ὁ Χριστὸς γιὰ τὸ σῶμα. Άλλὰ παραπάνω ἀπὸ τὸ σῶμα, ποὺ μιὰ μέρα θὰ σαπίση μέσ' στὸν τάφο, ὁ Χριστὸς ἐνδιαφέρεται γιὰ κάτι ἄλλο ἀπείρως ἀνώτερο· καὶ αὐτὸ εἶνε ἡ ψυχή. Καὶ ἀκριβῶς γιὰ τὴν ψυχὴ τοῦ νέου, ποὺ ἦταν κι αὐτὴ ἄρρωστη, φρόντισε ὁ Χριστός, Γι' αὐτὸ τοῦ εἶπε «Τέκνον· ἀφέωνταί σοι αἱ ἀμαρτίαι σου».

"Ηθελε νὰ δείξη, ὅτι κακό μεγαλύτερο ἀπὸ τὴν ἀρρώστια εἶνε ἡ άμαρτία. Αὐτὴ εἶνε ἡ πηγὴ ἀπὸ τὴν ὁποία προέρχονται ὅλα τὰ κακὰ στὸν κόσμο. "Ο,τι κακὸ νὰ φανταστῆς, ἀπὸ 'κεῖ πηγάζει. Καὶ ἄν κλείσης τὴν πηγὴ αὐτή, θὰ σταματήσουν ὅλα τὰ κακά. Γι' αὐτὸ ὁ Χριστὸς θεραπεύει πρῶτα τὴν ψυχὴ τοῦ παιδιοῦ, ποὺ ἦταν καὶ αὐτὴ ἀμαρτωλή. Γιατὶ αὐτὸ ποὺ ἔπαθε τὸ παιδί, ἡ παραλυσία, προερχόταν ἀπὸ ἀμάρτημα. "Εκανε κάποια ἁμαρτία, καὶ ἐξ αἰτίας τῆς ἀμαρτίας παρέλυσε.

Τὸ σημερινὸ εὐαγγέλιο, ἀγαπητοί μου, μᾶς διδάσκει, ὅτι χειρότερη ἀπὸ τὴν ἀρρώστια τοῦ σώματος εἶνε ἡ ἀρρώστια τῆς ψυχῆς, ἡ ἀμαρτία. Αὐτὴ σκοτίζει τὸ μυαλό, μολύνει τὰ εὐγενέστερα αἰσθήματα, χαυνώνει καὶ παραλύει τὴ θέλησι. Εἶνε ἡ πιὸ μεγάλη ἀσθένεια στὸν κόσμο. Καὶ ὅποιος δὲν προσέξῃ, θὰ ἔχῃ τὸ κατάντημα τοῦ παραλύτου τοῦ σημερινοῦ εὐαγγελίου. Σᾶς ἀναφέρω μερικὰ παραδείγματα, νὰ ὅῆτε ποῦ καταντοῦν, ἰδίως τὰ παιδιὰ καὶ οἱ νέοι, ὅταν ἀφήνουν τὸν ἑαυτό τους νὰ παρασυρθῆ ἀπὸ τὸ φοβερὸ ἐρῦμα τῆς διαφθορᾶς.

- *Ήταν ἔνα λαμπρὸ καὶ εὐφυὲς κορίτσι στὴν 'Αθήνα. Πρώτη στὸ σχολεῖο, περνοῦσε τὶς τάξεις καὶ ἀρίστευε, τὴν καμάρωναν γονεῖς καὶ καθηγηταί. Ξαφνικὰ στόπ! 'Άρχισε νὰ καθυστερῆ στὰ μαθήματα, καὶ τέλος ἔμεινε στὴν ἴδια τάξι. Καὶ μόνο αὐτό; 'Ενῷ ἦταν παιδὶ ὅλο χαρά, τὴν ἔπιασε μελαγχολία· φαγητὸ δὲν ἔτρωγε, τὴ νύχτα δὲν κοιμόταν, σηκωνόταν ἐπάνω, φώναζε, ώρυόταν. Τὴν πῆγαν σὲ γιατρούς. 'Έκρυβε κάποιο μυστικό· εἶχε μπλέξει μὲ κακὲς παρέες κι αὐτὲς τὴν κατέστρεψαν. Καὶ ἀπὸ τὴν ἡμέρα ἐκείνη δὲν εἶχε πιὰ ἡσυχία. Νά τ' ἀποτελέσματα τῆς άμαρτίας.
- Θέλετε ἄλλο παράδειγμα; Στὴν Πτολεμαίδα ὁδοκαθαριστὴς τῆς πόλεως βρῆκε τὶς πρωινὲς ὧρες ἔξω ἀπὸ ἔνα νυκτερινὸ κέντρο ξαπλωμένη σὲ ἐλεεινὴ κατάστασι, μὲ σκισμένα τὰ ροῦχα καὶ μελανιασμένο τὸ πρόσωπο, μιὰ κοπέλλα δεκάξι - δεκαεπτὰ χρονῶν. Τὴ σκουντάει· δὲν κουνιόταν. Εἰδοποιεῖ τὴν ἀστυνομία καὶ τὴν πῆρε τὸ «ἐκατό». Εἰδαν κ' ἔπαθαν νὰ τὴν ἀναγνωρίσουν. "Ηταν μιὰ φτωχὴ κοπέλ-

λα, ποὺ ξεκίνησε ἀπὸ ἔνα χωριὸ νὰ κατέβη στὴν πόλι νὰ δουλέψη νὰ βοηθήση τὸν πατέρα της, κ' ἔπεσε σὲ μαφία, σὲ κακοὺς ἀνθρώπους· αὐτοὶ τὴν κατέστρεψαν, καὶ τὸ πρωὶ τὴν ἄφησαν ἔτσι.

Θέλετε κι ἄλλα; Πρῶτα στὴν πατρίδα μας οὔτε ἕνας νέος δὲν ἔπαιρνε ναρκωτικά· ἄγνωστο ἦταν τὸ χασίς. Τώρα; Κάθε μέρα βρίσκουν ναρκομανεῖς πεσμένους στὸ δρόμο σὲ ἀθλία κατάστασι. Βλέπεις νέους χαυνωμένους, κοιμισμένους, ἀποβλακωμένους. Καὶ εἴνε πολλοί, πάρα πολλοὶ οἰ ναρκομανεῖς.

Νά λοιπὸν τ' ἀποτελέσματα τῆς ἀμαρτίας. Εἶνε ἀρρώστια χειρότερη ἀπ' τὸν καρκίνο.

Καὶ τὸ συμπέρασμα; Δὲν θὰ ἡσυχάση ἡ νῆ. έὰν μέσα ἀπὸ τὶς καρδιές μας δὲν ξερριζωθῆ αύτὴ ἡ λερναία ὕδρα. Μία εἶνε ἡ λύσις: μακριά ἀπ' τὴν άμαρτία! "Έτσι συμβούλευαν παλαιότερα οί μανάδες καὶ οί γιαγιάδες. Γνώρισα έναν ἀνώτατο ὑπάλληλο τοῦ κράτους καὶ μοῦ ἔλεγε· Πέρασα ἀπὸ πολλὰ σχολεῖα, πῆγα στὸ ἐξωτερικό, μορφώθηκα, ἔμαθα γλῶσσες. Άλλὰ τώρα τὰ ξέχασα ὅλα σχεδόν. "Ένα θυμάμαι. Είχα μιὰ γιαγιὰ ἀγράμματη. Έγώ, μικρὸ άγοράκι τεσσάρων χρονών, βγήκα στή γειτονιά. "Όταν γύρισα, εἶπα μιὰ κακιὰ λέξι ποὺ ἄκουσα ἔξω, μιὰ βλαστήμια. Μόλις μ' ἄκουσε ή γιαγιά, παίρνει μὲ τὴ τσιμπίδα ἕνα κάρβουνο, μοῦ ἀνοίγει τὸ στόμα καὶ μοῦ καίει τὴ γλῶσσα. Άπὸ τότε δὲν ξαναεῖπα κακὴ λέξι... Ποιά μάνα, ποιά γιαγιὰ τὸ κάνει σήμερα αὐτό:

"Ω καὶ νά 'δινε ό Θεὸς νὰ σβήση ἀπὸ τὸν κόσμο ή άμαρτία! Ή γη θὰ γινόταν παράδεισος. Θὰ μοῦ πῆτε. Εἶνε δυνατὸν ἔνας ἄνθρωπος νὰ μείνη ἀναμάρτητος; "Όχι βέβαια. Άλλὰ γι' αὐτὸ ὁ Χριστὸς ἔδωσε τὴ μετάνοια, ποὺ συγχωρεῖ τὰ άμαρτήματα. Καὶ ὅποιος ἄνθρωπος στὸν κόσμο αὐτὸν γλιστρήση, ὄχι ἀπελπισία! Τί νὰ κάνουμε: Σὰν τὸν παράλυτο νὰ τρέξουμε στὸ Χριστό, σὰν τὴν πόρνη νὰ κλάψουμε, σὰν τὸ ληστή νὰ μετανοήσουμε. Νὰ ποῦμε· Χριστέ, συχώρεσέ μας! Κι ἄμα τὸ ποῦμε ἀπ' τὴν καρδιά μας, τότε ἀπὸ τὰ οὐράνια θ' ἀκουστῆ-«Θάρσει, τέκνον· ἀφέωνταί σοι αί άμαρτίαι σου». Παιδί μου, παίρνω σφουγγάρι καὶ σβήνω τ' άμαρτήματά σου· καὶ πρόσεξε ἀπὸ 'δῶ κ' ἐμπρός νὰ μὴν ἀμαρτάνης· νὰ φυλάνεσαι ἀπὸ τὴν άμαρτία ὅπως φυλάγεσαι ἀπὸ τὸ φίδιϢ.Σ. Σω 212). «Φεύγε καὶ σώζου».

Seeing God

If you say, "Show me your God," I will say to you, "Show me what kind of person you are, and I will show you my God." Show me then whether the eyes of your mind can see, and the ears of your heart hear. ... Those who can see with the eyes of their bodies are aware of what is happening in this life on earth. ... So it is with the ears of our heart and the eyes of our mind in their capacity to hear or see God.

God is seen by those who have the capacity to see Him, provided that they keep the eyes of their mind open. All have eyes, but some have eyes that are shrouded in darkness, unable to see the light of the sun. Because the blind cannot see it, it does not follow that the sun does not shine. The blind must trace the cause back to themselves and their eyes. In the same way, you have eyes in your mind that are shrouded in darkness because of your sins and evil deeds.

A person's soul should be clean, like a mirror reflecting light. If there is rust on the mirror his face cannot be seen in it. In the same way, no one who has sin within him can see God.

But if you will you can be healed. Hand yourself over to the doctor, and he will open the eyes of your mind and heart. Who is to be the doctor? It is God, who heals and gives life through His Word and wisdom. Through His Word and wisdom He created the universe, for "by his Word the heavens were established, and by his Spirit all their array." (Psalm 32:6)

If you understand this, and live in purity and holiness and justice, you may see God. But, before all, faith and the fear of God must take the first place in your heart, and then you will understand all this. When you have laid aside mortality and been clothed in immortality, then you will see God according to your merits. God raises up your flesh to immortality along with your soul, and then, once made immortal, you will see the Immortal One, if you believe in Him now.
