

#### Prokeimenon. Grave Mode. Psalm 28.11,1

The Lord will give strength to his people.

Verse: Bring to the Lord, O sons of God, bring to the Lord honor and glory.

The reading is from St. Paul's Letter to the Hebrews 6:13-20

BRETHREN, when God made a promise to Abraham, since he had no one greater by whom to swear, he swore to himself, saying, "Surely I will bless you and multiply you." And thus Abraham, having patiently endured, obtained the promise. Men indeed swear by a greater than themselves, and in all their disputes an oath is final for confirmation. So when God desired to show more convincingly to the heirs of the promise the unchangeable character of his purpose, he interposed with an oath, so that through two unchangeable things, in which it is impossible that God should prove false, we who have fled for refuge might have strong encouragement to seize the hope set before us. We have this as a sure and steadfast anchor of the soul, a hope that enters into the inner shrine behind the curtain, where Jesus has gone as a forerunner on our behalf, having become a high priest for ever after the order of Melchizedek.

Αδελφοί, τῷ Άβραὰμ ἐπαγγειλάμενος ὁ θεός, ἐπεὶ κατ' οὐδενὸς εἶχεν μείζονος ὀμόσαι, ὅμοσεν καθ' ἑαυτοῦ, λέγων, Ἦ μὴν εὐλογῶν εὐλογήσω σε, καὶ πληθύνων πληθυνῷ σε. Καὶ οὕτως μακροθυμήσας ἐπέτυχεν τῆς ἐπαγγελίας. Ἄνθρωποι μὲν γὰρ κατὰ τοῦ μείζονος ὀμνύουσιν, καὶ πάσης αὐτοῖς ἀντιλογίας πέρας εἰς βεβαίωσιν ὁ ὅρκος. St. John Climacus - 4th Sunday of Lent

Gospel: Mark 9:17-31

Then one of the crowd answered and said, "Teacher, I brought You my son, who has a mute spirit. And wherever it seizes him, it throws him down; he foams at the mouth, gnashes his teeth, and becomes rigid. So I spoke to Your disciples, that they should cast it out, but they could not." He answered him and said, "O faithless generation, how long shall I be with you? How long shall I bear with you? Bring him to Me." Then they brought him to Him. And when he saw Him, immediately the spirit convulsed him, and he fell on the ground and wallowed, foaming at the mouth. So He asked his father, "How long has this been happening to him?" And he said, "From childhood. And often he has thrown him both into the fire and into the water to destroy him. But if You can do anything, have compassion on us and help us." Jesus said to him, "If you can believe, all things are possible to him who believes." Immediately the father of the child cried out and said with tears, "Lord, I believe; help my unbelief!" When Jesus saw that the people came running together, He rebuked the unclean spirit, saying to it: "Deaf and dumb spirit, I command you, come out of him and enter him no more!" Then the spirit cried out, convulsed him greatly, and came out of him. And he became as one dead, so that many said, "He is dead." But Jesus took him by the hand and lifted him up, and he arose. And when He had come into the house, His disciples asked Him privately, "Why could we not cast it out?" So He said to them, "This kind can come out by nothing but prayer and fasting." Then they departed from there and passed through Galilee, and He did not want anyone to know it. For He taught His disciples and said to them, "The Son of Man is being betrayed into the hands of men, and they will kill Him. And after He is killed, He will rise the third day."

Καὶ εἰσελθόντα αὐτὸν εἰς οἶκον οὶ μαθηταὶ αὐτοῦ ἐπηρώτων αὐτὸν κατ΄ ἰδίαν, ὅτι ἡμεῖς οὑκ ἡδυνήθημεν ἐκβαλεῖν αὐτό. καὶ εἶπεν αὐτοῖς· τοῦτο τὸ γένος ἐν οὐδενὶ δύναται ἐξελθεῖν εἰ μὴ ἐν προσευχῆ καὶ νηστεία. Καὶ ἐκεῖθεν ἐξελθόντες παρεπορεύοντο διὰ τῆς Γαλιλαίας, καὶ ούκ ἤθελεν ἴνα τις γνῷ· ἐδίδασκε γὰρ τοὺς μαθητὰς αὐτοῦ καὶ ἔλεγεν αὐτοῖς ὅτι ὁ υὶὸς τοῦ ἀνθρώπου παραδίδοται εἰς χεῖρας ἀνθρώπων, καὶ ἀποκτενοῦσιν αὐτόν, καὶ ἀποκτενοῦσιν αὐτόν, καὶ ἀποκτενοθεὶς τῆ τρίτη ἡμέρα ἀναστήσεται.



## Γιατί δυσπιστοῦμε;

«Πιστεύω, κύριε· βοήθει μου τῆ ἀπιστία» (Μαρκ. 9,24)

Δαιμόνιο, ἀγαπητοί μου, δαιμόνιο ἐξαιρετικὰ κακοποιὸ ἦταν τὸ δαιμόνιο ποὺ βασάνιζε τὸν δυστυχισμένο νέο τοῦ σημερινοῦ εὐαγγελίου ἀπὸ τὴν παιδική του ἡλικία.

Πώς νὰ παρομοιάσουμε, μὲ ποιά εἰκόνα νὰ παραστήσουμε τὴν φρικτὴ κατάστασι τοῦ δαιμονισμοῦ; "Όταν -μὴ γένοιτο, Κύριε-, ὅταν τὸ δαιμόνιο ἐπιτρέψῃ ὁ Θεός, γιὰ διαφόρους λόγους ποὺ εἶνε δύσκολο νὰ ὁρίσουμε, νὰ καταλάβη τὸν ἄνθρωπο, τότε αὐτὸς ξέρεις πῶς γίνεται; Γίνεται ὅπως ἔνα ὑποζύγιο ποὺ ὁ ἀναβάτης του δὲν εἶνε ἔνας συνετὸς καὶ λογικὸς ἄνθρωπος, ἀλλὰ εἶνε ἕνας παράφρων, ἕνας ἀσύνετος καὶ τρελλός, ἱκανὸς νὰ τὸ ὁδηγήση καὶ στὸ χειρότερο γκρεμό.

"Όπως λοιπὸν ἔνας τρελλὸς καβαλλάρης μπορεῖ νὰ ὁδηγήση τὸ ἄλογό του στὸ βάραθρο καὶ τὴν καταστροφή, κατὰ παρόμοιο τρόπο καὶ τὸ δαιμόνιο, ἀφοῦ ἔγινε κυρίαρχο ἐπάνω στὴν ὕπαρξι τοῦ ταλαίπωρου ἐκείνου νέου, δοκίμαζε ἱδιαίτερη χαρά, χαιρεκακία, διεστραμμένη χαρά, νὰ ταλαιπωρῆ καὶ νὰ βασανίζη τὸ νέο. "Αν μποροῦσε, θὰ ἤθελε καὶ νὰ τὸν θανατώση" ἡ κακία του αὐτὸ ἐπιδίωκε, ἀλλὰ δὲν τοῦ τὸ ἐπέτρεπε ὁ Θεός.

Μαζί ὅμως μὲ τὸ παιδὶ τὸ δαιμόνιο χαιρόταν νὰ βασανίζη καὶ τὸν πατέρα του. Μόνο ὅσοι εἶστε γονεῖς μπορεῖτε νὰ νιώσετε τὴ θλῖψι καὶ τὸν πόνο αὐτοῦ τοῦ ἀνθρώπου. Πόσες φορὲς αὐτὸς ὁ πατέρας δὲν θὰ ἀντίκρυσε ἀνατριχιαστικὰ θεάματα καὶ δὲν θὰ ἔζησε τρομερὲς σκηνές, πόσες φορὲς δὲν θὰ εἴδε τὸ παιδί του στὶς καταστάσεις ποὺ ἀκοῦμε νὰ περιγράφει ὁ ἴδιος καὶ διαβάζουμε στὸ κείμενο τοῦ ἱεροῦ εὐαγγελιστοῦ! τὸ δαιμόνιο, λέει, «ὅπου ἄν αὐτὸν καταλάβῃ, ῥήσσει αὐτόν, καὶ ἀφρίζει καὶ τρίζει τοὺς ὀδόντας αὐτοῦ, καὶ ξηραίνεται» ὅπου δηλαδὴ τὸν πιάση τὸ δαιμόνιο, τὸν ῥίχνει καταγῆς, καὶ βγάζει ἀφροὺς ἀπὸ τὸ στόμα καὶ τρίζει τὰ δόντια του

καὶ μένει ξερός Μίμι (ΙΙ). Δυστυχισμένο τὸ παιδί, μὰ πιὸ δυστυχισμένος ὁ πατέρας.

Ποιός τώρα θὰ μποροῦσε νὰ έλευθερώση τὸ ταλαίπωρο αὐτὸ παιδὶ ἀπὸ τὸ δαιμόνιο ἐκεῖνο, ποὺ σὰν ἀόρατος δράκοντας, σὰν πανίσχυρο φίδι τὸ περιτύλιγε, τὸ ἔσφιγγε καὶ τὸ ἔπνιγε, καὶ σὰν καταραμένη βδέλλα ἀπομυζοῦσε τὴ σωματικὴ ὕπαρξι τοῦ νέου; Κανένας γιατρὸς δὲν μποροῦσε νὰ κάνη τίποτα, γιατὶ μὲ φάρμακα καὶ μὲ τὰ ἄλλα μέσα τῆς ἱατρικῆς ἐπιστήμης δὲν ἐξαναγκάζεται ὁ σατανὰς νὰ παραδοθῆ. Γιὰ νὰ ἐκδιωχθῆ ὁ τρομερὸς δαίμονας ἀπὸ τὸν ἄνθρωπο, χρειάζονται φάρμακα ἄλλης φύσεως, χρειάζεται θεία ἐπέμβασις. Γι' αὐτὸ ὁ πατέρας τοῦ νέου καταφεύγει στὴ δύναμι τοῦ Θεοῦ.

Πλησιάζει αὐτοὺς ποὺ ἀποτελοῦν τὸ ἄμεσο περιβάλλον - τὴ συνοδεία τοῦ Χριστοῦ (ὁ όποῖος τὴν ὤρα ἐκείνη ἔλειπε), ζητάει τὴ βοήθεια τῶν μαθητῶν τοῦ Κυρίου. Ἐνωρίτερα, δπως βλέπουμε στὸ κατά Μᾶρκον Εὐαννέλιο. οί δώδεκα μαθηταί, μὲ έξουσία ποὺ τοὺς ἔδωσε ό θεῖος Διδάσκαλος, ἐνεργοῦσαν κατὰ «Τῶν πνευμάτων τῶν ἀκαθάρτων»[ἐἰξῆ, ἔβγαζαν δαιμόνια. Άλλ' αὐτὴ τὴ φορὰ καὶ οἶ μαθηταὶ δὲν κατορθώνουν νὰ φέρουν ἀποτέλεσμα· ἀποδεικνύονται ἀδύνατοι, ἀνίκανοι νὰ έλευθερώσουν τὸ νέο ἀπὸ τὸ δαιμόνιο. Ἐπιχειροῦν μὲν νὰ τὸ ἐκδιώξουν, ἀλλὰ τὸ δαιμόνιο δὲν φαίνεται νὰ ἐνοχλῆται ἀπὸ τὶς ἐπικλήσεις καὶ τοὺς ἐξορκισμοὺς τῶν μαθητῶν. Παραμένει μέσα στὸ παιδὶ ἐμπαίζοντας ἔτσι τοὺς ἀποστόλους τοῦ Χριστοῦ γιὰ τὴν ἀδυναμία τους, σὰν κάποιος τρομερὸς ληστής πού παρά τὰ κακουργήματά του μένει ἄσύλληπτος άπὸ τὴν ἀστυνομία καὶ στὰ μάτια τῆς κοινής γνώμης έμπαίζει τὰ ὄργανα τῆς τάξεως ποὺ δὲν κατορθώνουν νὰ τὸν συλλάβουν.

Ό πατέρας, ποὺ κατέφυνε στοὺς ἀποστό-

λους μὲ τὴν ἐλπίδα νὰ βρῇ βοήθεια καὶ τώρα βλέπει τὴν ἀδυναμία τους, κλονίζεται καὶ ἀρχίζει ν' ἀπογοητεύεται. Ἡραγε, σκέπτεται, ἀφοῦ οὕτε αὐτοὶ ἔχουν τὴ δύναμι νὰ μὲ βοηθήσουν, κανείς δὲν θὰ μπορέσῃ νὰ θεραπεύσῃ τὸ παιδί μου;...

Μὲ τέτοιους λογισμοὺς ὀλιγοπιστίας, ἀποκαρδιωμένος καὶ ἀπορώντας γιὰ τὴν ἀδυναμία τῶν ἀποστόλων, πλησιάζει τὸν Κύριο (ὁ ὁποῖος ἐκείνη τὴν ὥρα μόλις εἶχε κατεβῆ ἀπὸ τὸ ὄρος Θαβώρ, ὅπου εἶχε μεταμορφωθῆ μπροστὰ στοὺς τρεῖς μαθητάς του. Τοῦ διηγεῖται τὴ συμφορά του, καὶ ζητάει πλέον τὴ δική του ἐπέμβασι, ὅχι ὅμως μὲ ἀπόλυτη ἐμπιστοσύνη. «Άλλ' εἴ τι δύνασαι», λέει, «βοήθησον ἡμῖν σπλαγχνισθεἰς ἐφ' ἡμᾶς» ἄν μπορῆς νὰ κάνης κάτι, λυπήσου μας. Ὁ Κύριος τοῦ ἀπαντῷ λέγοντας «Εἰ δύνασαι πιστεῦσαι, πάντα δυνατὰ τῶ πιστεύοντι» ἔἰ 92-20.

Μὲ τὴν παρατήρησί του αὐτὴ ὁ Κύριος βάζει τὰ πράγματα στὴ θέσι τους. Μὲ τὰ λόγια του εἶνε σὰν νὰ λέῃ στὸν πατέρα τοῦ παιδιοῦ·

Δυστυχισμένε πατέρα! Παραπονιέσαι εναντίον τῶν μαθητῶν μου, γιατὶ δὲν μπόρεσαν νὰ θεραπεύσουν τὸ παιδί σου. Καὶ ἄρχισες τώρα νὰ ἐκφράζεσαι μὲ μεγάλη ἄμφιβολία καὶ γιὰ τὴ δική μου δύναμι. Μάθε λοιπόν, ὅτι αἶτία ὅλης αὐτῆς τῆς καταστάσεως, τοῦ ὅτι δηλαδὴ ὁ γυιός σου δὲν ἔχει ἀκόμη θεραπευθῆ, εἶσαι σὰ ὁ ἴδιος. Ἡ όλιγοπιστία σου στὴ δύναμί μου, νά ἡ αἰτία. Πιστεύεις σ' ἐμένα; τὸ παιδί σου θὰ θεραπευθῆ· δὲν πιστεύεις σ' ἐμένα; τὸ παιδί σου θὰ μένη ἔτσι, ἀθεράπευτο. Ὑπὸ σένα ἐξαρτᾶται νὰ πάρης στὰ χέρια σου τὸ μυστικὸ καὶ παντοδύναμο κλειδὶ τῆς πίστεως καὶ ν' ἀνοίξης μ' αὐτὸ ὅλες τὶς θύρες τοῦ θεῖκοῦ ἐλέους.

Άκούγοντας τὴν ἀπάντησι τοῦ Χριστοῦ ὁ πατέρας κατάλαβε καλὰ καὶ ἔνιωσε βαθειὰ τὴν παρατήρησι αὐτὴ τοῦ Κυρίου. Άνέκρινε τὸν ἑαυτό του καὶ εἶδε, ὅτι ἡ πίστι του στὸν Σωτῆρα Χριστὸ εἶνε τόσο μικρή, ὥστε κινδυνεύει νὰ σβήση τελείως. Ἡρθε σὲ συναίσθησι, πόνεσε καὶ τότε «μετὰ δάκρύων» φωνάζει στὸν Κύριο· «Πιστεύω, κύριε· βοήθει μου τῃ ἀπιστία» πιστεύω, ἀλλὰ ἡ πίστι μου εἶνε ἀσθενική, βοήθα με στὴν ὀλιγοπιστία μου ἔλιβων. Μετὰ ἀπὸ αὐτὴ τὴν ταπεινὴ αἴτησι τὸ ἀποτέλεσμα ἦρθε ἀμέσως· τὸ δαιμόνιο ἐκδιώχθηκε καὶ τὸ παιδὶ θεραπεύθηκε.

"Αχ πόσες φορὲς κ' ἐμεῖς, ἀγαπητοί μου, δἐν βρισκόμαστε σὲ κατάστασι παρόμοια μὲ τὴν κατάστασι τοῦ πατέρα τοῦ δαιμονιζομένου παιδιού! Πάσχουμε κ' έμεῖς ὅπως ἐκεῖνος. 'Υποφέρουμε βαθειά. Θλίψεις, ἀτομικὲς καὶ οἰκογενειακές, πιέζουν σὰν ἐφιάλτες τὰ στήθη
μας. Ἐνάντιες περιστάσεις φράζουν τὸ δρόμο
τῆς ζωῆς μας σὰν ἀμετακίνητοι ὀγκόλιθοι. Κ'
ἐμεῖς κάτω ἀπὸ τὴν πίεσι τῶν γεγονότων καταφεύγουμε στὸν Κύριο, ὅχι ὅμως μὲ τὴν ἀπόλυτη ἐμπιστοσύνη. Καταφεύγουμε δυστυχῶς
μὲ τὴν ὀλιγοπιστία αὐτὴ ποὺ εἴδαμε στὸν πατέρα τοῦ δαιμονιζομένου νέου. Ἡ διψυχία,
ποὺ ἐκφράζει ἐκεῖνο τὸ «εἴ τι δύνασαι...», χαρακτηρίζει καὶ τὰ δικά μας αἰτήματα. Σὰν νὰ
λέμε: "Ε, ἃς δοῦμε τί μπορεῖ νὰ μᾶς κάνη κι
ὁ Χριστός!

Μὲ τέτοια ὀλιγοπιστία, ποὺ λίγο διαφέρει ἀπὸ τὴν ἀπιστία, πλησιάζουμε οἱ πολλοὶ τὸν Κύριο, κ' ἔπειτα ἔχουμε τὴν ἀξίωσι νὰ μᾶς ἀκούση.

Έὰν εἴνε ὑποτιμητικὸ γιὰ ἔνα πανίσχυρο ἄρχοντα τῶν ἡμερῶν μας νὰ ἐκφραζώμαστε μὲ κάποια ἀμφιβολία γιὰ τὴ δύναμί του, ἐὰν δηλαδὴ καὶ κατὰ πόσον εἶνε σὲ θέσι νὰ πραγματοποιήση κάθε τι ποὺ ὑπόσχεται, ἀσυγκρίτως πιὸ προσβλητικὸ εἶνε γιὰ τὸν ἀληθινὰ παντοδύναμο Κύριο νὰ ἔχουμε μέσα μας ἀμφιβολίες γιὰ τὴ δύναμί του, ποὺ εἶνε ἀνεξάντλητη σὲ τρόπους καὶ σὲ μέσα νὰ βοηθήση τὸν ἄνθρωπο. "Όχι λοιπὸν «εἴ τι δύνασαι», ὅπως ὁ πατέρας τοῦ νέου, ἀλλὰ Κύριε, «αἴδα ὅτι πάντα δύνασαι, ἀδυνατεῖ δέ σοι οὐδέν», γνωρίζω ὅτι μπορεῖς τὰ πάντα καὶ τίποτα δὲν εἶνε ἀδύνατο σ' ἐσένα Νέθιλ \$2.

Τέτοια πίστι όμως δὲν ὑπάρχει σὲ ὅλους μας. Γι' αύτὸ καὶ εὕκολα ἀπογοητευόμαστε καὶ γογγύζουμε κατά τῆς Θείας Προγοίας. Καὶ πάνω στὴν ἀφροσύνη τῆς ὀλιγοπιστίας μας -γιατὶ άφροσύνη είνε ή όλιγοπιστία- νομίζουμε ὅτι ὁ Κύριος μᾶς ἄφησε καὶ δὲν ἐνδιαφέρεται πιὰ γιὰ μᾶς. Ένῷ Ἐκεῖνος εἶνε πάντοτε ὁλοπρόθυμος νὰ μᾶς βοηθήση σὲ κάθε περίστασι. άρκεϊ έμεῖς μὲ θερμή καὶ ἀκλόνητη πίστι νὰ χτυπήσουμε την θύρα τοῦ ἐλέους του. Έμπιστοσύνη, έμπιστοσύνη ἀπόλυτη σ' Αὐτὸν ζητάει ἀπὸ κάθε δοῦλο του, καὶ τότε αὐτὸς ὑπόσχεται νὰ τὸν ὁδηγήση στὴ λύτρωσι. Χωρὶς έμπιστοσύνη στὸν στρατηγὸ τίποτα δὲν μποροῦν νὰ κάνουν οἱ στρατιῶτες: ἀλλὰ καὶ χωρίς ἐμπιστοσύνη στὸ πρόσωπο τοῦ Κυρίου μας Ίησοϋ Χριστοϋ, χωρὶς ἀκράδαντη πίστι σ' αὐτόν, δὲν θὰ μπορέσουμε κ' ἐμεῖς νὰ κατορθώσουμε τίποτα γενναῖο, νὰ λάβουμε βοήθεια καὶ νὰ πᾶμε μπροστά. Γι' αὐτὸ ἄς προσευχώμαστε μὲ δάκρυα στὸν Κύριο λέγοντας: «*Πιστεύω*, Κύριε· βοήθει μου τῆ ἀπιστία» Νέρι. 924.
