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St. Paul's Letter to the Romans 5:1-10

Prokeimenon. Mode 2. Psalm 117.14,18

The Lord is my strength and my song. Verse: The Lord has chastened me sorely.

The reading is from St. Paul's Letter to the Romans 5:1-10

BRETHREN, since we are justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ. Through him we have obtained access to this grace in which we stand, and we rejoice in our hope of sharing the glory of God. More than that, we rejoice in our sufferings, knowing that suffering produces endurance, and endurance produces character, and character produces hope, and hope does not disappoint us, because God's love has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit which has been given to us. While we were still weak, at the right time Christ died for the ungodly. Why, one will hardly die for a righteous man -- though perhaps for a good man one will dare even to die. But God shows his love for us in that while we were yet sinners Christ died for us. Since, therefore, we are now justified by his blood, much more shall we be saved by him from the wrath of God. For if while we were enemies we were

reconciled to God by the death of his Son, much more, now that we are reconciled, shall we be saved by his life.

3rd Sunday of Matthew The Gospel According to Matthew 6:22-33

The Lord said, "The eye is the lamp of the body. So, if your eye is sound, your whole body will be full of light; but if your eye is not sound, your whole body will be full of darkness. If then the light in you is darkness, how great is the darkness! No one can serve two masters; for either he will hate the one and love the other, or he will be devoted to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and mammon. Therefore I tell you, do not be anxious about your life, what you shall eat or what you shall drink, nor about your body, what you shall put on. Is not life more than food, and the body more than clothing? Look at the birds of the air: they neither sow nor reap nor gather into barns, and yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not of more value than they? And which of you by being anxious can add one cubit to his span of life? And why are you anxious about clothing? Consider the lilies of the field, how they grow; they neither toil nor spin; yet I tell you, even Solomon in all his glory was not arrayed like one of these. But if God so clothes the grass of the field, which today is alive and tomorrow is thrown into the oven, will he not much more clothe you, O men of little faith? Therefore do not be anxious, saying, 'What shall we eat?' or 'What shall we drink?' or 'What shall we wear? For the Gentiles seek all these things; and your heavenly Father knows you need them all. But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things shall be yours as well."

Μάτια - πίστι - νοῦς

«Ό λύχνος τοῦ σώματός ἐστιν ὁ όφθαλμός» (Ματθ. 6.22)

Απλα, άγαπητοί μου, άπλα μιλούν οἱ πατέρες καὶ διδάσκαλοι τῆς Ἐκκλησίας, άπλα
μιλάει αὐτὸς ὁ Κύριος ἡμῶν Ἰησοῦς Χριστός,
ἀπλα θὰ μιλήσουμε κ' ἐμεῖς. Τὸ Εὐαγγέλιο δἐν
εἶνε φιλοσοφίες. Στὸ ζήτημα π.χ. τῆς ψυχῆς ὁ
Χριστὸς ἔδωσε τὴν ἀπάντησι μὲ δυὸ λόγια ἡ
ψυχή, λέει, εἶνε ἀθάνατη [β. Μεκ. 8,3837]. "Ετσι καὶ
στ' ἄλλα θέματα ὁ Κύριος μᾶς μίλησε μὲ ἀπλότητα, μὲ εἰκόνες καὶ παραδείγματα ἀπ' τὴ φύσι.

Σήμερα τὸ εὐαγγέλιο ὡς πρῶτο παράδειγμα τῆς διδασκαλίας τοῦ Χριστοῦ ἔχει τὸ μάτι τοῦ ἀνθρώπου [ἔ]. Μπὶ 6,22]. Τί εἶνε τὸ μάτι; "Ενα ἀπὸ τὰ λεπτότερα ὅργανα: μιὰ φωτογραφικὴ μηχανή, ποὺ ἐργάζεται αὐτομάτως ἐπὶ χρόνια ὀλόκληρα χωρὶς μπαταρία. Ποιός τὴν ἔφτειαξε; 'Ο Θεός. Καὶ μόνο γιὰ τὰ μάτια θά 'πρεπε νὰ τὸν εὐχαριστοῦμε μέρα καὶ νύχτα.

Καὶ γιατί μᾶς τά 'δωσε τὰ μάτια: "Όχι γιὰ νὰ ίκανοποιούμε τὴν ἀμαρτωλὴ περιέργεια, νὰ βλέπουμε τὰ αἰσχρὰ καὶ ἀκατονόμαστα. Μᾶς τά 'δωσε γιὰ ἕνα μεγάλο σκοπό· νὰ βλέπης τὸ πανόραμα τῆς δημιουργίας, τὸν ἥλιο τὸ πρωὶ ν' άνατέλλη καὶ νὰ λὲς *«Δόξα σοι τῶ δείξαντι* τὸ φῶς» [Μελ]: νὰ βλέπης τὸ βραδάκι νὰ κάνη βουτιὰ στὸ πέλαγος καὶ νὰ λὲς «Φῶς ίλαρὸν άγίας δόξης ... Ἰησοῦ Χριστέ, ἐλθόντες ἐπὶ τὴν ήλίου δύσιν...»[επερ]· νὰ βλέπης τὴ νύχτα τ' άναρίθμητα άστέρια, τὰ καντηλάκια τῆς Παναγίας, νὰ τὰ βλέπης ὅλα αὐτὰ καὶ νὰ λὲς «Oi οὐρανοί διηγούνται δόξαν Θεού, ποίησιν δὲ χειρῶν αὐτοῦ ἀναγγέλλει τὸ στερέωμα» (Ψόμ 18,2). Στὸ σημερινὸ εὐαγγέλιο ὁ Χριστὸς λέει, ὅτι «ὁ λύχνος τοῦ σώματός ἐστιν ὁ ὀφθαλμός» Μπε.ε.22. "Όπως τὴ νύχτα, ὅταν δὲν ὑπάρχη φῶς, κρατάς φανάρι γιὰ νὰ μὴ σκοντάψης, ἔτσι καὶ γιὰ νὰ βαδίζης μὲ ἀσφάλεια στὴ ζωή σου στὸν κόσμο αὐτὸν σοῦ 'δωσε καὶ κάποια ἄλλα μάτια.

Ή φυσική ὄρασι δὲν εἶνε καὶ τόσο σπουδαῖο πράγμα· τὴν ὄρασι αὐτὴ τὴν ἔχουν καὶ τὰ ζῷα· μερικά μάλιστα, ὅπως π.χ. ὁ ἀετός, ἔχουν ἰσχυρότερη ὅρασι ἀπὸ τὸν ἄνθρωπο. Άλλὰ ἐδῶ δὲν ἐννοοῦμε τὴν ὅρασι αὐτή: ἐννοοῦμε κάποια ἄλλη ὅρασι, ποὺ ἡ ἀξία της εἶνε ἀπείρως μεγαλύτερη καὶ τὴν ὁποία πολὺ λίγοι διαθέτουν. Ποιά εἶνε ἡ ὅρασις αὐτή, γιὰ τὴν ὁποία κυρίως ὁμιλεῖ ὁ Κύριος; Ἡ πίστι.

"Ας φέρουμε παράδειγμα. Εἵμαστε μαζεμένοι μέσα στὴν ἐκκλησία καὶ ὅλοι ἔχουμε μάτια. Καὶ τί βλέπουμε; Βλέπουμε κολῶνες, εἰκόνες, στασίδια, άναλόγια, δεσποτικό θρόνο, τέμπλο, άγία τράπεζα, άνθρώπους ποὺ ἐκκλησιάζονται, ἐπιτρόπους, ψαλτάδες, παπάδες ντυμένους μὲ ἄμφια... Σᾶς ἐρωτῶ· μόνο αὐτὰ ὑπάρχουν μέσα στὸ ναό; "Αχ, ἀδελφοί μου, δὲν ύπάρχουν μόνο αὐτά ὑπάρχουν κι ἄλλα πράγματα, ποὺ δὲν τὰ βλέπουμε γιατὶ δὲν ἔχουμε τὰ κατάλληλα μάτια, δὲν ἔχουμε τὴν ὅρασι ποὺ λέγεται πίστι: ἄν εἵχαμε τὴν ὄρασι αὐτή, πολλὰ θὰ βλέπαμε. Τώρα ἔχουμε μάτια ζωώδη, μάτια λύκου, μάτια γερακιού, μάτια άρκούδας, μάτια χοίρου... γιατί ὁ ἕνας εἶνε ἄσπλαχνος, ό ἄλλος σκληρόκαρδος, ό ἄλλος ἄρπαγας, ό άλλος θυμώδης, ὁ άλλος ἀσελγής, καὶ ὅλοι όλιγόπιστοι. "Αν είχαμε **πίστι –αὐτὴ είνε ἡ ἄλ**λη όρασι-, θὰ βλέπαμε πολλὰ ἄλλα.

Διαβάζετε τοὺς βίους τῶν άγίων; Ἐκεῖ θὰ δῆτε ὅτι, ὅποιοι εἶχαν πίστι καὶ καθαρὴ καρδιά, στὴν ἐκκλησία αἰσθάνονταν τὸ θαῦμα ποὺ τελεῖται, ἄκουγαν άγγελικοὺς ὕμνους, ἔβλεπαν πάνω στὴν ἀγία τράπεζα τὸ Χριστὸ νὰ ἀκτινοβολῆ, τὴν ὑπεραγία Θεοτόκο καὶ τοὺς ἀγίους, ἔβλεπαν ἀγγέλους καὶ ἀρχαγγέλους. Τὸ ἀπολυτικίο τοῦ ἀγίου Σπυρίδωνος λέει: «... καὶ ἐν τῷ μέλπειν τὰς ἀγίας σου εύχὰς ἀγγέλους ἔσχες συλλειτουργοῦντάς σοι» ὅταν δηλαδὴ λειτουργοῦσε ὁ ἄγιος Σπυρίδων, οἱ Χριστιανοὶ ἔβλεπαν νὰ συλλειτουργοῦν μαζί του ἄγγελοι. "Αν ἔχουμε κ' ἐμεῖς πίστι, διὰ τῆς πίστεως θὰ δοῦμε τὰ μεναλεῖα τοῦ Θεοῦ.

• Άλλὰ ἐγώ, άδελφοί μου, θὰ ἔλεγα· ἄς μὴν ἔχουν οἱ ἄνθρωποι σήμερα τὴν ὅρασι τὴν πνευματικὴ ποὺ εἴχαν οἱ ἄγιοι· νὰ ἔχουν τοὐλάχιστον τὴ φυσικὴ ἰκανότητα νὰ διακρίνουν, τὴν καθαρότητα ὅηλαδὴ τοῦ νοῦ, νὰ ἔχουν τοὐλάχιστον τὸ μυαλό τους ὑγιὲς ὥστε νὰ σκέπτεται λογικά. –Μά, θὰ πῆτε, δὲν σκέπτονται ὅλοι οἱ ἄνθρωποι λογικά; "Αν νομίζετε ἔτσι, κάνετε λάθος· μακάρι νὰ σκέπτονταν λογικά.

"Εδωσε ὁ Θεὸς τὰ μάτια, νὰ βλέπης τὴ φύσι, ὅ,τι ὑπάρχει γύρω σου ἔδωσε τὴν πίστι ὡς ἔκτη αἴσθησι, νὰ βλέπης τὸν παράδεισο, τὰ οὐράνια. 'Αλλ' ἐκτὸς ἀπὸ τὰ δύο αὐτά, ὑπάρχει καὶ κάποιο ἄλλο φανάρι, ποὺ τὸ ἔδωσε σὲ ὅλους, τό 'χουν καὶ οἱ ἄγριοι ἀκόμα. Ποιό εἶν' αὐτό; ὁ νοῦς - τὸ μυαλὸ τοῦ ἀνθρώπου.

"Αχ αὐτὸ τὸ μυαλό, τί θαῦμα εἶνε! "Αν ἀνοίξης τὸ κρανίο τοῦ ἀνθρώπου, ὁ ἐγκέφαλος εἴνε μιὰ λάστη, κάτι σὰν ἀσβέστης. Καὶ ὅμως ἐκεῖ μέσα τί δὲν ὑπάρχει! Εἶνε ἀνώτερο ἀπ' ὅλες τὶς μηχανές. Καὶ τὸ πιὸ τέλειο ἐργοστάσιο μηδὲν εἶνε μπροστά του. "Ο ἐγκέφαλος ἔχει ἐκατομμύρια τῶν ἐκατομμυρίων μικρὰ - μικρὰ «καλώδια». Εἶνε τόσο λεπτεπίλεπτος καὶ εὐπαθής, πού, μιὰ σταγόνα αἶμα νὰ πέση μέσα στὰ ἀγγεῖα του, ὁ ἄνθρωπος τελείωσε.

Γιατί λοιπὸν τό 'δωσε ὁ Θεὸς αὐτὸ τὸ μυαλό; Σοῦ τό 'δωσε, γιὰ νὰ σκέπτεσαι λογικά, γιὰ νὰ γίνης βασιλιᾶς ὅλης τῆς κτίσεως, νὰ προοδεύσης καὶ νὰ εὐτυχήσης, νὰ διακρίνης τὸ ψέμα ἀπὸ τὴν ἀλήθεια, νὰ προχωρῆς νὰ προχωρῆς καὶ νὰ φτάσης μέχρι τὰ ἄστρα τοῦ οὐρανοῦ. Φαίνεται ὅμως ὅτι κάποτε τὸ μυαλὸ τὸ χάνουμε. Γιατὶ ἄν δὲν τὸ χάναμε, δὲν θὰ εἴχαμε φτάσει στὸ σημεῖο ποὺ φτάσαμε.

Τρελλοκομεῖο καὶ κάτι χειρότερο καταντήσαμε. Σήμερα ἡ ἀνθρωπότης κινδυνεύει ἀπὸ τὶς ἐφευρέσεις τῶν «ἐπιστημόνων», αὐτῶν μὲ τὰ μεγάλα μυαλά, ποὺ μπορεῖ ν' ἀνεβοῦν στὰ οὐράνια κι ἀπὸ 'κεῖ νὰ ρίξουν κάτω στὴ γῆ βόμβες. Τὸ μυαλό, ἀντὶ νά 'νε καθαρό, σκοτίζεται. "Όπως ἔνας ποὺ πίνει κρασὶ ζαλίζεται καὶ δὲν ξέρει τί λέει καὶ τί κάνει, ἔτσι εἶνε σήμερα ὁ ἄνθρωπος δὲν ξέρει τί κάνει. "Ας ἔχη μάτια καὶ τηλεσκόπια" ἐφ' ὅσον μέσα του ὑπάρχει ἡ ἀμαρτία, τὸ κακό, ὁ ἄνθρωπος ζῆ στὸ σκοτάδι, στὸν «ζόφον τοῦ σκότους» ποὺ λέει ὁ ἀδελφόθεος Ἰούδας στὴν Ἐπιστολή του |π. ۱3|.

"Αν θέλης νὰ δῆς σὲ τί σκοτάδι φτάνει ὁ ἄνθρωπος, δὲς τὸν ἄλλο "Ιούδα, τὸν προδότη, γιὰ τὸν ὁποῖο τὴ Μεγάλη Πέμπτη ἀκοῦμε: «"Ότε οἱ ἔνδοξοι μαθηταὶ ἐν τῷ νιπτῆρι τοῦ δείπνου ἐφωτίζοντο, τότε Ἰούδας ὁ δυσσεβὴς φιλαργυρίαν νοσήσας ἐσκοτίζετο». Καὶ τὸ Εὐαγγέλιο λέει ὅτι, ὅταν ὁ σατανᾶς εἰσῆλθε στὴν καρδία τοῦ Ἰούδα καὶ βγῆκε ἀπὸ τὸ μυστικὸ δεῖπνο νὰ προδώση τὸ Χριστό, ἦταν «νύξ» (μ. 133.27).

Ή φιλαργυρία είνε τὸ πάθος ποὺ σκοτίζει περισσότερο ἀπ' ὅλα. Κάθε ἀμαρτωλὸς μυαλὸ δὲν ἔχει, πρὸ παντὸς ὅμως ὁ φιλάργυρος. Τὸν βλέπεις καὶ μαζεύει μαζεύει. Τί θὰ τὰ κάνη: Αὐτὰ ποὺ ἔχει τὸν φτάνουν νὰ ζήση χίλια χρόνια. Οὔτε τὶς δικές του λογικὲς ἀνάγκες ξέρει νὰ σταθμίση, οὖτε τὸν φτωχὸ σκέπτεται ποὺ δὲν ἔχει νὰ ζήση οὖτε μιὰ μέρα. Μαζεύει συνεχῶς, λὲς κ' ἔκανε συμβόλαιο μὲ τὸ θάνατο ὅτι θὰ ζήση χιλιάδες χρόνια. Τὸ εὐαγγέλιο σήμερα λέει, ὅτι δὲν μπορεῖς νὰ προσθέσης στὴ ζωή σου ούτε μία μέρα (βλ. Μπί.6,27). "Όταν ἔρθη ὁ χάρος, δὲν σοῦ δίνει οὕτε ἔνα λεπτὸ διωρία-«"Αφρον, ταύτη τῆ νυκτὶ τὴν ψυχήν σου ἀπαιτοῦσιν ἀπὸ σοῦ· ἃ δὲ ἡτοίμασας τίνι ἔσται;» (Λαικ 12,20). Μυαλό δὲν ἔχει, γι' αὐτό τὸν ὀνομάζει «ἄφρονα». Ὁ δὲ ἀπόστολος Παῦλος γιὰ ἀνάλογες περιπτώσεις λέει, ὅτι *«παρέδωκεν αὐ*τοὺς ὁ Θεὸς ε**ίς ἀδόκιμον νοῦν»** (Pu<u>u</u> 128).

Σήμερα ὁ ἄνθρωπος ἔχει χαλασμένο μυαλό. Κρίμα στὰ σχολεῖα, στὰ πανεπιστήμια καὶ στὶς γλῶσσες. "Ενας ἀγράμματος σκέπτεται καλύτερα ἀπὸ ἔναν ἐπιστήμονα, ἀπ' αὐτοὺς ποὺ έτοιμάζονται νὰ κάνουν τρίτο παγκόσμιο πόλεμο. Χαλασμένα εἶνε τὰ μυαλὰ τῶν φιλαργύρων, φιλοδόξων καὶ ἀρχομανῶν, ξεκουρδισμένα ρολόγια ποὺ τὰ ξεκούρδισε ὁ διάβολος νὰ μὴ δουλεύουν. Μπορεῖ ἄπειρα πράγματα νὰ σκέπτωνται: ἕνα δὲν σκέπτονται, τὸ Θεὸ καὶ τὸ θάνατο. Γι' αὐτὸ μᾶς λέει ὁ Κύριος, νὰ προσέξουμε τὸ μυαλό μας νά 'νε καθαρό.

Προτοῦ τελειώσω, ἀγαπητοί μου, θὰ θυμίσω μία εἰκόνα ἀπὸ τὴν ὕπαιθρο. "Όπως ὁ περιβολάρης δένει τὸ γαϊδουράκι στὸ μαγγανοπήγαδο μὲ κλειστὰ τὰ μάτια, γιὰ νὰ γυρίζη καὶ νὰ τοῦ βγάζη νερό, ἔτσι ὁ διάβολος μᾶς ἔχει δέσει στὰ καταραμένα μαγγανοπήγαδά του (τῆς μοιχείας, τῆς πορνείας, τῆς χαρτοπαιξίας, τῆς βλαστήμιας, τῆς ἀτιμίας, τῆς κλοπῆς, τῆς ἀθείας κ.λπ.)· μᾶς ἔβαλε τυφλοπάνι, κ' ἐμεῖς τρέχουμε κάνοντας τὸ θέλημά του.

"Ας βγάλουμε τὰ τυφλοπάνια – ὁ καθένας τὸ δικό του –, νὰ δοῦμε τὸ Θεό, νὰ πιστέψουμε στὸ Χριστό, νὰ γίνουμε ἄνθρωποι. Γιατὶ μᾶς ἔδωσε τρία πράγματα· μάτια νὰ βλέπουμε τὰ ὡραῖα πράγματα, πίστι νὰ τὸν λατρεύουμε, καὶ μυαλὸ νὰ τὸν σκεπτώμαστε. "Αν ζήσουμε καὶ πολιτευθοῦμε ἔτσι, θὰ ἔχουμε τὴ χάρι καὶ εὐλογία τοῦ Κυρίου ἡμῶν Ἰησοῦ Χριστοῦ- ἀμήν.

The Illustrious and Pre-Eminent Apostles Peter and Paul

The New Testament clearly shows Peter as the leader of the Apostles, chosen by Jesus to have a spe-cial relationship with him. With James and John he was privileged to witness the Transfiguration, the raising of a dead child to life and the agony in Gethsomane. His mother-in-law was cured by Jesus. He was sent with John to prepare for the last Passover before Jesus' death. Hls name is first on every list of apostles. But the Gospels prove their own veracity by the unflattering details they include about Peter. He clearly had no public relations person. It is a great comfort for ordinary mortals to know that Peter also has his human weakness, even in the presence of Jesus. After Jesus' Ascension, Peter presided in Jerusalem, was bishop of Antioch, and finally prosided over the Church in Rome where on the Vatican Hill he was martyred, head downwards according to tradition, in the Circus of Nero.

Paul had been the most Pharisaic of Pharisees, the most legalistic of Mossic lawyers. Following his

conversion, he suddenly appears to other Jews as a heretical welcomer of Gentiles, a traitor and apostate. Paul's central conviction was simple and absolute: Only God can save humanity. No human effort - even the most scrupulous observance of law - can create a human good which we can bring to God as reparation for sin and payment for grace. To be saved from itself, from sin, from the devil and from death, humanity must open itself completely to the saving power of Jesus. Paul never lost his love for his Jewish brothers and sisters, though he carried on a lifelong debate with them about the uselessness of the Law without Christ. He reminded the Gentiles that they were grafted on the parent stock of the Jews, who were still God's chosen people, the children of the promise. According to tradition, Paul was beheaded in Rome near the Ostian Way where the church of Tre Fontane now stands.

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
