

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Prokeimenon. Mode 4. Daniel 3.26,27

Blessed are you, O Lord, the God of our fathers. Verse: For you are just in all you have done.

The reading is from Acts of the Apostles 20:16-18, 28-36

IN THOSE DAYS, Paul had decided to sail past Ephesos, so that he might not have to spend time in Asia; for he was hastening to be at Jerusalem, if possible, on the day of Pentecost. And from Miletos he sent to Ephesos and called to him the elders of the church. And when they came to him, he said to them: "Take heed to yourselves and to all the flock, in which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers, to care for the church of God which he obtained with the blood of his own Son. I know that after my departure fierce wolves will come in among you, not sparing the flock; and from among your own selves will arise men speaking perverse things, to draw away the disciples after them. Therefore be alert, remembering that for three years I did not cease night or day to admonish every one with tears. And now I commend you to God and to the word of his grace, which is able to build you up and to give you the inheritance among all those who are sanctified. I coveted no one's silver or gold or apparel. You yourselves know that these hands ministered to my necessities, and to those who were with me. In all things I have shown you that by so toiling one must help the weak, remembering the words of the Lord Jesus, how he said, 'it is more blessed to give than to receive.' " And when he had spoken thus, he knelt down and prayed with them all.

Εν ταῖς ἡμεραῖς ἐκείναις, ἔκρινεν ὁ Παῦλος παραπλεῦσαι τὴν Ἡρεσον, ὅπως μὴ γένηται αὐτῷ χρονοτριβῆσαι ἐν τῇ Ἀσίᾳ· ἔσπευδεν γάρ, εἰ δυνατὸν ἦν αὐτῷ, τὴν ἡμέραν τῆς Πεντηκοστῆς γενέσθαι εἰς Ἱεροσόλυμα. Ἀπὸ δὲ τῆς Μιλήτου πέμψας εἰς Ἡρεσον μετεκαλέσατο τοὺς πρεσβυτέρους τῆς ἐκκλησίας. Ὠς δὲ παρεγένοντο πρὸς αὐτόν, εἶπεν αὐτοῖς, προσέχετε οὖν ἑαυτοῖς καὶ παντὶ τῷ ποιμνίῳ, ἐν ῷ ὑμᾶς τὸ πνεῦμα τὸ ἄγιον ἔθετο ἐπισκόπους, ποιμαίνειν τὴν ἐκκλησίαν τοῦ κυρίου καὶ θεοῦ, ἣν περιεποιήσατο διὰ τοῦ ἰδίου αἴματος. Ἡνὰρ οἶδα τοῦτο, ὅτι εἰσελεύσονται μετὰ τὴν ἄφιξίν μου λύκοι βαρεῖς εἰς ὑμᾶς, μὴ φειδόμενοι τοῦ ποιμνίου· καὶ ἐξ ὑμῶν αὐτῶν ἀναστήσονται ἄνδρες λαλοῦντες διεστραμμένα, τοῦ ἀποσπᾶν τοὺς μαθητὰς ὀπίσω αὐτῶν. Διὸ γρηγορεῖτε, μνημονεύοντες ὅτι τριετίαν νύκτα καὶ ἡμέραν οὐκ ἐπαυσάμην μετὰ δακρύων νουθετῶν ἕνα ἕκαστον. Καὶ τὰ νῦν παρατίθεμαι ὑμᾶς, ἀδελφοί, τῷ θεῷ καὶ τῷ λόγῳ τῆς χάριτος αὐτοῦ, τῷ δυναμένῳ ἐποικοδομῆσαι, καὶ δοῦναι ὑμῖν κληρονομίαν ἐν τοῖς ἡγιασμένοις πᾶσιν. Ἁργυρίου ἢ χρυσίου ἢ ἱματισμοῦ οὐδενὸς ἐπεθύμησα. Αὐτοὶ γινώσκετε ὅτι ταῖς χρείαις μου καὶ τοῖς οὖσιν μετ' ἐμοῦ ὑπηρέτησαν αὶ χεῖρες αὖται. Πάντα ὑπέδειξα ὑμῖν, ὅτι οὕτως κοπιῶντας δεῖ ἀντιλαμβάνεσθαι τῶν ἀσθενούντων, μνημονεύειν τε τῶν λόγων τοῦ κυρίου Ἰησοῦ, ὅτι αὐτὸς εἶπεν, Μακάριόν ἐστιν μᾶλλον διδόναι ἢ λαμβάνειν. Fathers of the 1st Council The Gospel According to John 17:1-13

At that time, Jesus lifted up his eyes to heaven and said, "Father, the hour has come; glorify your Son that the Son may glorify you, since you have given him power over all flesh, to give eternal life to all whom you have given him. And this is eternal life, that they know you the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom you have sent. I glorified you on earth, having accomplished the work which you gave me to do; and now, Father, you glorify me in your own presence with the glory which I had with you before the world was made.

"I have manifested your name to the men whom you gave me out of the world; yours they were, and you gave them to me, and they have kept your word. Now they know that everything that you have given me is from you; for I have given them the words which you gave me, and they have received them and know in truth that I came from you; and they have believed that you did send me. I am praying for them; I am not praying for the world but for those whom you have given me, for they are mine; all mine are yours, and yours are mine, and I am glorified in them. And now I am no more in the world, but they are in the world, and I am coming to you. Holy Father, keep them in your name, which you have given me, that they may be one, even as we are one. While I was with them, I kept them in your name, which you have given me; I have guarded them, and none of them is lost but the son of perdition, that the scripture might be fulfilled. But now I am coming to you; and these things I speak in the world, that they may have my joy fulfilled in themselves."



Χριστιανέ, εἶσαι ὑπλισμένος;

«Τῷ καιρῷ ἐκείνῳ ἐπάρας ὁ Ἰησοῦς τοὺς ὀφθαλμοὺς αὐτοῦ εἰς τὸν οὐρανὸν εἶπε· Πάτερ, ἐλήλυθεν ἡ ὥρα...» (Ἰω. 17,1)

λόκληρη, άγαπητοί μου, ή σημερινή περικοπή τοῦ εὐαγγελίου εἶνε προσευχή. Είνε ένα μέρος -γιὰ τὴν ἀκρίβεια ἀποτελεῖ τὴν ἀρχή- τῆς προσευχῆς ἐκείνης, ἡ ὁποία ἀπὸ τοὺς θεολόγους τῆς Ἐκκλησίας μας ἀνομάστηκε *ἀρχιερατική προσευχή* τοῦ Κυρίου. Πῶς πῆρε τὸ ὄνομα αὐτό; Άπὸ τὴν δογματικὴ διδασκαλία τῆς Ἐκκλησίας μας μαθαίνουμε, ὅτι τρία εἶνε τὰ ἀξιώματα τοῦ Χριστοῦ· τὸ άρχιερατικό, τὸ προφητικὸ καὶ τὸ βασιλικό. "Άλλες ἐνέργειές του τὶς ἔκανε ὡς ἀρχιερεύς. άλλες τὶς ἔκανε ώς προφήτης, καὶ ἄλλες τὶς ἔκανε ὡς βασιλεύς. Σ' αὐτὰ ποὺ ὁ Κύριός μας ἐνήργησε ὡς ἀρχιερεὺς ἀνήκει καὶ ἡ προσευχή. Πολλὲς φορὲς ἀναφέρουν τὰ Εὐαγγέλια ότι προσευχήθηκε ό Χριστὸς κατὰ τὸν ἐπίγειο βίο του. Καὶ ἐπειδὴ ἡ προσευχὴ αὐτὴ τῆς σημερινής εύαγγελικής περικοπής είνε ή πιὸ σημαντική ἀπ' ὅλες τὶς προσευχές του, ώνομάστηκε κατ' έξοχὴν ἀρχιερατική προσευχή.

Ό μέγας ἀρχιερεύς μας Χριστὸς ἀπηύθυνε τὴν προσευχὴ αὐτὴ πρὸς τὸν οὐράνιο Πατέρα του κατὰ τὴν τελευταία νύχτα τῆς ἐπιγείου ζωῆς του, τὸ βράδυ τῆς Μεγάλης Πέμπτης. Στὸ τέλος τοῦ Μυστικοῦ Δείπνου, ἀφοῦ παρέδωσε στοὺς μαθητάς του τὰ φρικτὰ
μυστήρια, τὸ μυστήριο τῆς θείας εὐχαριστίας,
σὲ στιγμὲς μοναδικές καὶ ἀνεπανάληπτες, εἴπε
τὴν προσευχὴ αὐτή. Σὲ λίγο μαζὶ μὲ τοὺς ἀποστόλους του ἐπρόκειτο ν' ἀφήσῃ πλέον τὸ ὑπερῷο τῶν Ἱεροσολύμων, γιὰ νὰ βγῆ ἔξω καὶ
νὰ βρεθῃ πέραν τοῦ χειμάρρου τῶν Κέδρων,
στὸν κῆπο τῆς Γεθσημανῆ.

Ή άρχιερατική προσευχή του ήταν τὸ ἐπιστέγασμα τῆς τελευταίας παρατεταμένης διδασκαλίας τοῦ Κυρίου στοὺς μαθητάς του – εἶνε ἐκείνη ποὺ ἀκοῦμε τὴ Μεγάλη Ἑβδομάδα στὸ πρῶτο καὶ μεγαλύτερο ἀπὸ τὰ δώδεκα εὐαγγέλια τῆς ἀκολουθίας τῶν Άχράντων

Παθών. Ή μακρὰ αὐτὴ διδασκαλία τοῦ Κυρίου, ποὺ περιέχει τὶς πιὸ σημαντικὲς παραγγελίες του, τὴν πολύτιμη διαθήκη ποὺ ἀφήνει πρὶν ἀπὸ τὸν ζωοποιὸ θάνατό του, περιέχεται σὲ τέσσαρα κεφάλαια τοῦ κατὰ Ἰωάννην Εὐαγγελίου (τὸ 13ο, τὸ 14ο, τὸ 15ο καὶ τὸ 16ο).

"Αν τώρα μὲ τὴ διδασκαλία αὐτὴ ὁ Χριστὸς έρριξε τὴ νύχτα ἐκείνη φῶς οὐράνιο στὴ διάνοια τῶν μαθητῶν, μὲ τὴν προσευχὴ ποὺ άκολούθησε στὸ τέλος τῆς διδασκαλίας θέρμανε τὴν καρδιά τους καὶ ἄνοιξε μέσα της βαθύτερα τὰ αὐλάκια γιὰ νὰ δεχτοῦν τὸν θεῖο σπόρο. Πρὸ παντὸς ὅμως ἡ προσευχὴ αὐτὴ ῶπλισε μὲ δύναμι, θάρρος καὶ ἐλπίδα τοὺς άγίους ἀποστόλους, οἱ ὁποῖοι σὲ λίγο θὰ μείνουν μόνοι καὶ θὰ σκορπίσουν, καὶ ἐν συνεχεία θὰ κληθοῦν νὰ βαδίσουν κι αὐτοὶ μὲ τὴ σειρά τους τὴν ὁδὸ τοῦ μαρτυρίου. Γιατὶ οἰ τελευταΐες φράσεις τής διδασκαλίας τοῦ Κυρίου ήταν λόγια ποὺ προμήνυαν θυέλλες καὶ καταιγίδες. «Έν τῷ κόσμω», τοὺς προεῖπε ὁ Θεῖος Διδάσκαλος, «θλῖψιν ἔξετε (στὸν κόσμο θὰ δοκιμάσετε θλῖψι) άλλὰ θαρσεῖτε, έγὼ νενίκηκα τὸν κόσμον (ἀλλὰ νά 'χετε θάρρος, ἐγὼ ἔχω νικήσει τὸν κόσμο)» 🗓 16.33].

Καὶ ἀμέσως μετὰ ἀπὸ τὰ λόγια αὐτὰ ὁ Διδάσκαλος ὑψώνει τὰ μάτια του στὸν οὐρανὸ καὶ προσεύχεται! Μ' αὐτὸ τὸν τρόπο διδάσκει τοὺς μαθητάς του μεταξὺ τῶν ἄλλων, ὅτι στὸν καιρὸ τῶν θλίψεων, ποὺ θὰ συναντήσουν στὴν πορεία τους, πρέπει κι αὐτοὶ νὰ καταφεύγουν μὲ τὴν προσευχή τους στὸ οὐράνιο Πατέρα.

Ή προσευχή, άγαπητοί μου! Νά τὸ ὅπλο τὸ ὁποῖο πρέπει νὰ μεταχειρισθοῦν οἱ ἀπόστολοι, ὅταν βρεθοῦν ἀντιμέτωποι μὲ τὸν κόσμο, ποὺ μὲ ὅλα τὰ δικά του ὅπλα θὰ ζητοῦσε νὰ τοὺς ἐξαφανίση ἀπὸ τὸ πρόσωπο τῆς γῆς.

Καὶ πράγματι τὸ ὅπλο αὐτὸ τὸ χρησιμοποί-

ησαν πολύ άποτελεσματικά οἱ ἄγιοι ἀπόστολοι, ὅπως βλέπουμε στὶς Πράξεις καὶ στὶς Έπιστολές τους. Μιμήθησαν τὸ παράδειγμα τοῦ Διδασκάλου τους, ὁ ὁποῖος πρὶν δώση τὶς ἀποτελεσματικὲς μάχες του κατὰ τοῦ διαβόλου προσευχόταν. Προσευχήθηκε στὴν ἔρημο τῶν πειρασμῶν ἀμέσως μετὰ τὴ βάπτισί του ἀπὸ τὸν Ἰωάννη στὸν Ἰορδάνη. Προσευχήθηκε τώρα στὸ Μυστικὸ Δεῖπνο. Θὰ προσευχηθῆ μετὰ ἀπὸ λίγο στὸν κῆπο τῆς Γεθσημανῆ. Καὶ προτοῦ νὰ κλείση τὰ μάτια του ἐπάνω στὸ σταυρό, πάλι θὰ προσευχηθῆ. Μέχρι τὴν τελευταία ἀναπνοή του συνεχῶς ἐπικοινωνοῦσε μὲ τὸν οὐράνιο Πατέρα του.

Τὸ παράδειγμα αὐτὸ τοῦ Κυρίου μιμήθηκαν καὶ οἱ μαθηταί του. Στὶς κρίσιμες καὶ τρομερὲς περιστάσεις, μέσα στὶς ὁποῖες βρέθηκαν, οἱ ἄγιοι ἀπόστολοι δὲν λησμόνησαν τὴν προσευχή. "Αοπλοι αὐτοὶ κατὰ κόσμον, νίκησαν τὸν κόσμο μὲ τὴν προσευχή τους" μιὰ προσευχὴ ὅχι ὅπως οἱ δικές μας ἀδύναμες προσευχές, ἀλλὰ προσευχὴ γεμάτη πίστι, ἀγάπη καὶ ἐλπίδα στὸν Κύριο, προσευχὴ ποὺ κατέβαζε τὸν οὐρανὸ στὴ γῆ.

Καὶ ἀκριβῶς διότι οἱ ἄγιοι ἀπόστολοι γνώριζαν ἐξ ἱδίας πείρας τὴ δύναμι τῆς προσευχῆς, γι' αὐτό, ὅπως ὁ Διδάσκαλός τους, συνιστοῦν τώρα κι αὐτοὶ θερμὰ τὴν προσευχὴ στοὺς Χριστιανούς. "Οποιος διαβάζει τἰς ἐπιστολές τους, ἰδίως τὶς ἐπιστολὲς τοῦ ἀποστόλου Παύλου, βλέπει ὅτι εἶνε γεμᾶτες ἀπὸ προσευχὲς καὶ προτροπὲς γιὰ προσευχή. Νὰ τἰς ἐπαναλάβουμε ἐδῶ; Εἴνε τόσο πολλές, ποὺ οὖτε ὁ χρόνος οὖτε ὁ χῶρος ἐπαρκεῖ.

Μήπως καὶ τὸ σημερινὸ ἀποστολικὸ ἀνάγνωσμα, ἀπὸ τὶς Πράξεις τῶν ἀποστόλων, δὲν τελειώνει μὲ προσευχή; "Αφηνε ἐκεῖ στὴ Μίλητο τῆς Μικρᾶς 'Ασίας καὶ ὁ ἀπόστολος Παῦλος, ὅπως ὁ Κύριός του, τὶς τελευταῖες του ὑποθῆκες, τὴν διαθήκη του μποροῦμε νὰ ποῦμε, στοὺς κληρικοὺς τῆς Ἐφέσου, γιατὶ δὲν ἐπρόκειτο πιὰ νὰ τοὺς ξαναδῆ. Κι ἀφοῦ τελειώνει τὸ λόγο του, προσέξατε τί λέει τὸ ἱερὸ κείμενο, πῶς κλείνει σήμερα ὁ ἀπόστολος; «Καὶ ταῦτα εἰπών, θεὶς τὰ γόνατα αὐτοῦ σὺν πᾶσιν αὐτοῖς προσηύξατο» ([μίξ 25]). Νά πῶς οἱ ἀπόστολοι ἀκολούθησαν τὰ ἵχνη τοῦ Κυρίου.

Άπὸ ὅλες τώρα τὶς προτροπές τους στοὺς πιστοὺς γιὰ προσευχή, ᾶς σημειώσουμε ἐδῶ μία μόνο προτροπὴ τοῦ ἀποστόλου Παύλου. Γράφοντας στοὺς Χριστιανοὺς τῆς Ἑφέσου τοὺς συνιστᾳ, νὰ ἐφοδιαστοῦν ἀπαραιτήτως μὲ τὰ ὅπλα ἐκεῖνα, ποὺ θὰ τοὺς βοηθήσουν νὰ βγοῦν νικηταὶ ἀπὸ τοὺς πειρασμούς. Μεταξὺ τῶν ὅπλων αὐτῶν, ποὺ ἀπαρτίζουν τὴν πνευματική πανοπλία κάθε πιστοϋ, ὁ θεόπνευστος ἀπόστολος συγκαταλέγει καὶ τὴν προσευχή. Άκοῦστε πῶς ἀκριβῶς τὸ λέει: «Άναλάβετε τὴν πανοπλίαν τοῦ Θεοῦ, ἵνα δυνηθῆτε ἀντιστῆναι ἐν τῆ ἡμέρα τῆ πονηρᾶ καὶ ἄπαντα κατεργασάμενοι στῆναι... διὰ πάσης προσευχής καὶ δεήσεως, προσευχόμενοι έν παντί καιρῷ ἐν Πνεύματι, καὶ εἰς αὐτὸ τοῦτο ἀγρυπνοῦντες έν πάση προσκαρτερήσει καὶ δεήσει περὶ πάντων τῶν ἀγίων, καὶ ὑπὲρ ἐμοῦ...» (Εφ.6,13,18-19). Όπλισθήτε! φωνάζει ὁ Παῦλος. Ὁ ἐχθρὸς έτοιμάζεται νὰ σᾶς ἐπιτεθῆ. Όπλισθῆτε μὲ ὅλα τὰ ὅπλα τοῦ Θεοῦ καὶ πρὸ παντὸς μὲ τὴν προσευχή! μὲ κάθε εἶδος προσευχῆς (δέησι, έξομολόγησι, εύχαριστία, δοξολογία). προσευχή κάθε στιγμή, άδιάλειπτα, καρτερικά, μὲ χάρι ἀγίου Πνεύματος προσευχή γιὰ όλους τοὺς πιστοὺς ἀδελφούς σας, προσευχὴ καὶ γιὰ μένα ποὺ ἔχω ἀνάγκη.

Ζούμε, ἀγαπητοί μου, σὲ ἡμέρες πονηρές. Ποιός δὲν τὸ βλέπει; Ὁ σατανᾶς, ἀφοῦ φόρτισε τὶς ψυχὲς τῶν ἀνθρώπων μὲ ἄγριο μῖσος, έξοπλίζει ήδη καὶ τὰ κράτη μὲ τρομερούς έξοπλισμούς. Άπέναντι σ' αὐτὴ τὴν ἐμπαθῆ μανία οἰ Χριστιανοί, ὁπουδήποτε στὴ Γῆ κι ἄν βρισκώμαστε, ας αντιτάξουμε την πανοπλία τοῦ Θεοῦ. "Ας πάρουμε στὰ χέρια μας τὸ ὅπλο τής προσευχής κι ας πολεμήσουμε μ' αὐτό. όπως λέει ο ἀπόστολος Παῦλος, «τὰς ἀρχάς, τὰς έξουσίας, τοὺς κοσμοκράτορας τοῦ σκότους τοῦ αἰῶνος τούτου» [ἐἰ ξί]. "Ας παρακαλοϋμε τὸν ούράνιο Πατέρα, νὰ διαλύση τὰ σύννεφα τοῦ μίσους καὶ νὰ χαρίση στὴ Γῆ τὴν εἰρήνη, τὴν ἀγάπη, τὴν ἐνότητα ἐκείνη τῶν ψυχῶν, τὴν ὁποία μὲ τόση θερμότητα καὶ κατ' ἐπανάληψιν ζήτησε ό Κύριος ἀπὸ τὸν οὐράνιο Πατέρα του γιὰ τοὺς μαθητάς του. Καὶ ὁ οὐράνιος Πατέρας θὰ μᾶς δώση ὅ,τι τοῦ ζητοῦμε «ἐν τῷ ὀνόματι» τοῦ Χριστοῦ. Γιατὶ ὁ Κύριος τὴ νύχτα τοῦ Μυστικοῦ Δείπνου μᾶς βεβαίωσε· «Άμὴν άμὴν λέγω ύμῖν (σᾶς βεβαιώνω μὲ τὸν πιὸ ἐπίσημο τρόπο) ὅτι ὅσα ἄν αἰτήσητε τὸν πατέρα ἐν τῷ ὀνόματί μου, δώσει ύμῖν. "Εως ἄρτι ούκ ἠτήσατε οὐδὲν ἐν τῷ ὀνόματί μου**· αίτεῖτε καὶ λήψεσθε**, ἵνα ή χαρὰ ύμῶν ή πεπληρωμένη» (№ 1623-24).

Χριστιανέ, σὲ ἐρωτῶ καὶ πάλι· εἶσαι ώπλισμένος μὲ τὸ ὅπλο τῆς προσευχῆς; Ἐὰν ὅχι, τότε πῶς θὰ ἀντιμετωπίσης τὶς θλίψεις καὶ τοὺς πειρασμοὺς τοῦ κόσμου τούτου; Ποῦ θὰ βρῆς ἀσφαλισμένο καταφύγιο;

Knowledge of the True God Nurtures Us to Eternal Life

Are we saying that knowledge is eternal life? Are we saying that to know the one true and living God will suffice to give us complete security for the future without need of anything else? Then how is "faith apart from works dead?" When we speak of faith, we mean the true knowledge of God and nothing else, since knowledge comes by faith. The prophet Isaiah tells us this: "If you do not believe, neither shall you understand." But he is not talking about a knowledge that consists in barren speculations, which is entirely worthless. For one of the holy disciples said, "You believe that God is one; you do well. Even the demons believe and shudder." What then shall we say to this? How is it that Christ speaks the truth when He says that eternal life is the knowledge of God the Father, the one true God, and with Him of the Son? I think, indeed, we must answer that the saying of the Savior is completely true. For this knowledge is life, laboring as it were in birth of the whole meaning of the mystery and

granting to us participation in the mystery of the Eucharist, whereby we are joined to the living and life-giving Word. And for this reason, I think, Paul says that the Gentiles are made fellow members of the body and fellow partakers of Christ, inasmuch as they partake in His Blessed Body and Blood. And our members may in this sense be conceived. of as being members of Christ. This knowledge, then, which also brings to us the Eucharist by the Spirit, is life. For it dwells in our hearts, reshaping those who receive it into son-ship with Him and molding them into incorruption and piety toward God through life, according to the Gospel. Our Lord Jesus Christ, then, knowing that the knowledge of the one true God brings to us and promotes our union with the blessings of which we have spoken, says that it is eternal life. It is the mother and nurse of eternal life, being in its power and nature pregnant with those things that cause life and lead St. Cyril of Alexandria

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
