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Prokeimenon. Mode 2. Psalm 117.14,18

The Lord is my strength and my song. Verse: The Lord has chastened me sorely.

The reading is from St. Paul's Letter to the Romans 5:1-10

Brethren, since we are justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ. Through him we have obtained access by faith to this grace in which we stand, and we rejoice in our hope of sharing the glory of God. More than that, we rejoice in our sufferings, knowing that suffering produces endurance, and endurance produces character, and character produces hope, and hope does not disappoint us, because God's love has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit which has been given to us. While we were still weak, at the right time Christ died for the ungodly. Why, one will hardly die for a righteous man -- though perhaps for a good man one will dare even to die. But God shows his love for us in that while we were yet sinners Christ died for us. Since, therefore, we are now justified by his blood, much more shall we be saved by him from the wrath of God. For if while we were enemies we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son, much more, now that we are reconciled, shall we be saved by his life.

3rd Sunday of Matthew The Gospel According to Matthew 6:22-33

The Lord said, "The eye is the lamp of the body. So, if your eye is sound, your whole body will be full of light; but if your eye is not sound, your whole body will be full of darkness. If then the light in you is darkness, how great is the darkness! No one can serve two masters; for either he will hate the one and love the other, or he will be devoted to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and mammon. Therefore I tell you, do not be anxious about your life, what you shall eat or what you shall drink, nor about your body, what you shall put on. Is not life more than food, and the body more than clothing? Look at the birds of the air: they neither sow nor reap nor gather into barns, and yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not of more value than they? And which of you by being anxious can add one cubit to his span of life? And why are you anxious about clothing? Consider the lilies of the field, how they grow; they neither toil nor spin; yet I tell you, even Solomon in all his glory was not arrayed like one of these. But if God so clothes the grass of the field, which today is alive and tomorrow is thrown into the oven, will he not much more clothe you, O men of little faith? Therefore do not be anxious, saying, 'What shall we eat?' or 'What shall we drink?' or 'What shall we wear? For the Gentiles seek all these things; and your heavenly Father knows you need them all. But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things shall be yours as well."

θὰ γίνουμε; Τί θὰ φᾶμε; Τί θὰ πιοῦμε; Τί θὰ ντυθοῦμε; Τί θὰ ...; Νά, ἀγαπητοί μου, σκέψεις ποὺ δὲν ἀφήνουν νὰ ἡρεμήση ὁ ψυχικός κόσμος τοῦ ἀνθρώπου. Νά σκέψεις οί όποῖες σὰν κύματα, ποὺ διαδέχονται ἀδιάκοπα τὸ ἔνα τὸ ἄλλο, δημιουργοῦν ζάλη, ζάλη σοβαρή, στὰ κεφάλια τῶν ἀνθρώπων. Νά σκέψεις, ποὺ σὰν ἀγκάθια συμπνίγουν τὸν σπόρο τοῦ λόγου τοῦ εὐαγγελίου καὶ δὲν τὸν άφήνουν να καρποφορήση (β), Nurtl. 13.7, Nijox, 4.7,18-19. /ωκ.&7). Νά σκέψεις ποὺ σὰν μαῦρα καὶ ἀπαίσια φτερωτά ὄρνεα πετᾶνε στὸν πνευματικό όρίζοντα τοῦ ἀνθρώπου, καὶ ὁ ταλαίπωρος προσπαθεΐ νὰ τὰ διώξη, ἀλλ' αὐτὰ ἔρχονται μέρα μὲ τὴν ἡμέρα ὅλο καὶ περισσότερα καὶ γίνονται όλο καὶ πιὸ ἐνοχλητικά.

Τὸ αῦριο γιὰ τὸν ἑαυτό του, τὴν οἰκογένειά του, τὴν κοινωνία, τὸ ἔθνος, τὴν ἀνθρωπότητα τοῦ φαίνεται σκοτεινό. -Τί θὰ γίνουμε;... ἀκούγεται ἀπὸ τὰ στόματα ὅλων μας. Κι ἄν ἀκόμα δὲν τὸ λέῃ ἡ γλῶσσα μας, πάντως ἡ καρδιά μας εἶνε ταραγμένη, ταραγμένη περισσότερο ἀπ' ὅ,τι εἶνε ὁ ὼκεανὸς ὅταν ἄνεμοι ὁρμητικοὶ σηκώνουν ἐκεῖνα τὰ τεράστια κύματα.

Σὰν νὰ μὴν ἔφταναν οἱ φροντίδες καὶ οἱ κόποι, στοὺς ὁποἱους ὁ ἄνθρωπος τῆς ἐποχῆς μας ὑποβάλλεται κάθε μέρα γιὰ ν' ἀντιμετωπίση τὰ διάφορα ζητήματα τοῦ σήμερα, προστίθεται ἐπὶ πλέον σ' αὐτὰ καὶ ἡ μέριμνα γιὰ τὸ αὕριο, ἡ άγωνία πῶς θὰ λύσουμε προβλήματα τοῦ μέλλοντος, ποὺ ἀκόμα δὲν ἔχουν ἔρθει μπροστά μας. Τὸ παρὸν μᾶς καλεῖ σὲ ἐργασία

έντατική καὶ συνεχή, κ' έμεῖς ἀσχολούμεθα διαρκῶς μὲ τὸ μέλλον. Ξέρετε πῶς μοιάζουμε; εἵμαστε σὰν ἔνα πλοίαρχο πού, ἀντὶ νὰ κοιτάζη πῶς θὰ ξεπεράση τὸ κῦμα ποὺ εἴνε ἐμπρὸς στὴν πλώρη τοῦ πλοίου του, αὐτὸς σκέπτεται πῶς θὰ ἀντιμετωπίση τὰ κύματα ποὺ μόλις διακρίνονται στὸ βάθος τοῦ ὁρίζοντος.

Ποιός ό λόγος νὰ ταράζεσαι ἀπὸ τώρα γιὰ κάτι ποὺ ἀκόμα δὲν ἀνέκυψε; Δὲν ἀκοῦς τί λέει ὁ Χριστός; Φτάνουν, λέει, οί φροντίδες καὶ ὁ βασανισμὸς ποὺ ἔχετε γιὰ τὴ σημερινή ήμέρα, μή φορτωθήτε καὶ βάσανα τῆς ήμέρας ποὺ ἀκόμη δὲν ἦρθε. Τὴ στιγμὴ ποὺ είστε ήδη πιεσμένοι ἀπὸ ἀρκετή δυσκολία, είνε παράλογο νὰ προσθέτετε καὶ ἄλλη δυσκολία πρὶν τὴν ὧρα της. Ἡ θεία πρόνοια ἀναθέτει σὲ κάθε ἄνθρωπο τὴν κάθε ἡμέρα τῆς ζωής του νὰ σηκώση ἔνα ώρισμένο βάρος. Εἶνε άρκετὸ αὐτό, δὲν χρειάζεται νὰ προστεθή κι άλλο. Έσεῖς περιορισθήτε νὰ σηκώσετε αύτὸ ποὺ σᾶς ἔχει ἀνατεθή σήμερα μὲ τὰ αύριανὰ βάρη θὰ ἀσχοληθῆτε αὔριο. «Μή μεριμνήσητε είς τὴν αῦριον· ἡ γὰρ αῦριον μεριμνήση τὰ ἐαυτῆς ἀρκετὸν τῆ ἡμέρα ἡ κακία αὐτῆς» (Μαή, 6.34),

Άλλὰ γιατί ταράζεται τόσο πολὺ ὁ ἄνθρωπος; γιατί τόσο πολὺ φοβᾶται τὸ μέλλον; γιατί ἡ μέριμνα γιὰ τὴν αὐριανὴ ἡμέρα πιέζει τὰ στήθη τῆς ἀνθρωπότητος σὰν ἐφιάλτης;

Νά γιατί. Διότι ὁ ἄνθρωπος δὲν πιστεύει στὴν Θεία Πρόνοια: εἶνε ἢ ἄπιστος ἢ ὀλιγόπιστος. Δὲν εἶνε ὡπλισμένος μὲ τὸ ὅπλο τῆς πίστεως. Γι' αὐτό, μόλις σκεφτῇ τὸ μέλλον, τὸν κυριεύει ὁ πανικός. Νομίζει πὼς εἶνε ἔρημος στὸν κόσμο καὶ δὲν ὑπάρχει δύναμις ἰκανὴ νὰ τὸν προστατεύσῃ. Αὐτὴ ἡ ἀπιστία ἢ ὀλιγοπιστία του είνε άδικαιολόγητη. Τοῦ είνε τόσο δύσκολο νὰ τὴν ὑπερνικήση;

√ Δὲν ἀκούει τὸ Χριστὸ ποὺ μᾶς λέει: «Μὴ ταρασσέσθω ὑμῶν ἡ καρδία πιστεύετε εἰς τὸν Θεὸν καὶ εἰς ἐμὲ πιστεύετε» μὴν ἀφήνετε τὴν καρδιά σας νὰ ταράζεται ἔχετε πίστι στὸ Θεὸ καὶ σ' ἐμένα ⋈ 14,11;

√ Δὲν μελετὰ τὸ Εὐαγγέλιο, νὰ δἢ ὅτι μέσα στὶς σελίδες του ὁ Κύριος δίνει τόσες πολύτιμες ὑποσχέσεις καὶ βεβαιώσεις, ὅτι παρακολουθεῖ μὲ ἀγάπη καὶ ἐνδιαφέρον πατρικὸ τὴ ζωὴ τοῦ ἀνθρώπου καὶ σ' αὐτὲς ἀκόμη τὶς ἐλάχιστες λεπτομέρειες;

√ Δὲν ἐμπιστεύεται τὴ ζωή του σ' Ἐκεῖνον ποὺ τρέφει τὰ πουλιὰ τοῦ οὐρανοῦ καὶ ντύνει τὰ κρίνα τοῦ ἀγροῦ μὲ στολὲς ποὺ τὴ μεγαλοπρέπειά τους θὰ ζήλευαν καὶ βασιλιᾶδες;

√ Δὲν βλέπει ὅτι πάνω ἀπὸ τὰ ἀνθρώπινα πράγματα ἀπλώνεται κάποιο μεγάλο χέρι· τὸ χέρι τοῦ παντοδύναμου καὶ πάνσοφου καὶ πανάγαθου Δημιουργοῦ, ποὺ μοιράζει ἀκατάπαυστα τὶς δωρεές του (τροφή, νερό, φῶς, ἀέρα...) στὰ ζῷα καὶ δὲν ἀφήνει νὰ πεθάνουν ἀπὸ τὴν πεῖνα οὕτε αὐτὰ τὰ νεογέννητα πουλάκια τῶν κοράκων;

"Αν λοιπὸν ὁ Πλάστης φροντίζη γιὰ τὰ νεογέννητα κοράκια, πῶς θ' ἀφήση ἔξω ἀπ' τὴ
φροντίδα του τὸν ἄνθρωπο, τὸν ὁποῖο ἔπλασε καὶ τὸν ὥρισε βασιλέα τῆς Γῆς; Καὶ ἐὰν παρέχη στὰ ζῷα τὰ μέσα γιὰ νὰ ἐκπληρώνουν
αὐτὰ τὸν προορισμό τους, πῶς θ' ἀφήση ἀπροστάτευτο τὸν ἄνθρωπο; Ἡ άπλῆ λογική, ἡ
καθημερινὴ πεῖρα, ἡ φύσι γύρω μας, καὶ πρὸ
παντὸς ὁ γραπτὸς λόγος τοῦ Θεοῦ, τὸ ἄγιο
Εὐαγγέλιο, στηρίζουν τὴν πίστι καὶ ἀποκρούουν τὰ αὐθαίρετα συμπεράσματα κατὰ τῆς
θείας προνοίας, στὰ ὁποῖα μόνο μιὰ ἄπιστη
καρδιὰ κ' ἔνα χαλασμένο μυαλὸ μποροῦν νὰ
καταλήξουν.

Άκούσαμε σήμερα τὸ Χριστὸ στὸ εὐαγγέλιο νὰ λέη: «Μὴ μεριμνᾶτε τῆ ψυχῆ ὑμῶν τί φά-γητε καὶ τί πίητε, μηδὲ τῷ σώματι ὑμῶν τί ἐν-δύσησθε», δηλαδή: μὴ φροντίζετε μὲ ἀγωνία γιὰ τὴ ζωή σας τί θὰ φᾶτε καὶ τί θὰ πιῆτε, μήτε γιὰ τὸ σῶμα σας τί θὰ ντυθῆτε (Νπ. 625). Τὰ λόγια αὐτὰ κάποιοι τὰ παρεξηγοῦν.

-Τί λοιπόν, θὰ μᾶς ποῦν ἀμέσως αὐτοί, δὲν πρέπει δηλαδὴ ὁ ἄνθρωπος νὰ ἔργάζεται; μὰ τότε, αν ὅλα τὰ περιμένη ἀπὸ τὴ βοήθεια τοῦ Θεοῦ, αὐτὸ δὲν εἶνε μοιρολατρία;...

Τοὺς ἀπαντοῦμε μὲ συντομία τὰ ἐξῆς.

Δὲν ἔχετε δίκιο. Παρεξηγεῖτε ἢ μἄλλον διαστρέφετε τὴν ἔννοια τῶν λόγων τοῦ Εὐαγγελίου. Ὁ Χριστὸς δὲν καταδικάζει τὴν ἐργασία: ἀντιθέτως, αὐτὸς τὴν διέταξε, τὴν δίδαξε καὶ τὴν καθαγίασε μὲ τὸ ἔμπρακτο παράδειγμά του, δπως γνωρίζουμε. Έκεϊνο ποὺ καταδικάζει ο Χριστός είνε μόνο ή ανχώδης μέριμνα για την αύριανη ήμέρα και ή έναγώνιος φροντίδα, ή όποία κατατρώει τὴν καρδιὰ τοῦ άνθρώπου ὅπως τὸ σκουλήκι τρώει τὸ ξύλο. Δὲν είπε τὸ Εὐαγγέλιο, «"Όλα, ἄνθρωπε, νὰ τὰ περιμένης ἀπὸ τὸ Θεό» – ποὺ εἶνε μοιρολατρικό· οὔτε ὅμως ἐπιδοκιμάζει τὸ ἀντίθετο έκεϊνο «Γιὰ ὅλα, ἄνθρωπε, στηρίξου ἀποκλειστικά στὸν έαυτό σου, στὶς δικές σου δυνάμεις, στὴ δική σου εὐφυία καὶ δραστηριότητα» – ποὺ εἶνε ἐγωιστικό. Γιατὶ ὅσο κι ἃν κοπιάση ὁ ἄνθρωπος, ὅλες αί προσπάθειές του. όλοι οί κόποι του, όλοι οί ἀγῶνες του θ' ἀποτύχουν, ἄν ἔχη τὸ Θεὸ ἀντιμέτωπο. Καὶ θὰ τὸν έχη ἀντιμέτωπο, ἐὰν νομίζη ὅτι ὁ ἄνθρωπος είνε τὸ πᾶν, ἐὰν δὲν βαδίζη σύμφωνα μὲ τὶς θεοδίδακτες άρχὲς τοῦ Εὐαγγελίου, ἐὰν σὲ κάθε ἔργο του, καὶ στὸ ἐλάχιστο, δὲν ὑψώνῃ μὲ ταπείνωσι τὰ μάτια τῆς ψυχῆς του πρὸς τὰ άνω, ἐπικαλούμενος τὴ βοήθεια Ἐκείνου ποὺ έχει τὴ δύναμι νὰ διαλύη τὶς βουλὲς τῶν έθνῶν καὶ τὰ σχέδια τῶν ἀρχόντων τους σὰν άσθενικά συννεφάκια. Γι' αὐτὸ τὸ Εὐαγγέλιο προτρέπει έργάζεσθε μέν, άλλα «μή μεριμνάτε» ναὶ μὲν μὴ μένετε ἀργοί, ἀλλὰ καὶ μὴ γίνεστε ἄπληστοι. Ό συνδυασμός αὐτὸς καὶ ή ισορρροπία βρίσκεται στὸν ἄλλο λόγο τοῦ Χριστοῦ· «Ζητεῖτε πρῶτον τὴν βασιλείαν τοῦ Θεοῦ καὶ τὴν δικαιοσύνην αὐτοῦ, καὶ ταῦτα πάντα προστεθήσεται ύμῖν»(ἐἰ.६૩).

Άγαπητοί μου! Ή ταραχή, ή ἀνησυχία, ή άγωνία, ὁ φόβος καὶ ὁ τρόμος γιὰ τὸ μέλλον. δλα αὐτά, εἶνε καρποὶ τῆς ὀλιγοπιστίας μας στὴν θεία Πρόνοια. Ταραζόμαστε, γιατὶ δὲν ἔχουμε βαθειὰ πίστι στὸ Θεό, τὸν Κύριο τῶν δυνάμεων. Άγωνιούμε, νιατί τη ζωή μας, τὶς ύποθέσεις μας, τὰ ἔργα μας, ὅλα τὰ ἔχουμε ἐξαρτήσει ἀπὸ τὴν ἀνθρώπινη δύναμι, ἡ ὁποία άποδεικνύεται ότι είνε μία λεπτή - λεπτή κλωστή: ή κλωστή αὐτή κόβεται, κ' ἐμεῖς πέφτουμε στὸ κενὸ μὲ φωνὲς ἀλλοφροσύνης. Κι ὅτι αύτή είνε ή βαθύτερη αίτία όλης τῆς ταραχῆς καὶ τῆς δικῆς μας ζωῆς καὶ τῆς ζωῆς τῶν ἄλλων, θὰ πεισθοῦμε, ἐὰν «έαυτοὺς καὶ ἀλλήλους καὶ πᾶσαν τὴν ζωὴν ἡμῶν Χριστῷ τῷ Θεῷ παραθώμεθα» (θ. λαι.). Τότε θὰ δοῦμε, ὅτι τὴν ταραχή μας θὰ διαδεχθή εἰρήνη βαθειά, ἡ εἰρήνη τοῦ Χριστοῦ!
