

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The Sunday of All Saints **Prokeimenon. Mode 4. Psalm 67.35,26**

God is wonderful among his saints. Verse: Bless God in the congregations.

The reading is from St. Paul's Letter to the Hebrews 11:33-40; 12:1-2

Brethren, all the saints through faith conquered kingdoms, enforced justice, received promises, stopped the mouths of lions, quenched raging fire, escaped the edge of the sword, won strength out of weakness, became mighty in war, put foreign armies to flight. Women received their dead by resurrection. Some were tortured, refusing to accept release, that they might rise again to a better life. Others suffered mocking and scourging, and even chains and imprisonment. They were stoned, they were sawn in two, they were tempted, they were killed with the sword; they went about in skins of sheep and goats, destitute, afflicted, ill-treated of whom the world was not worthy - wandering over deserts and mountains and in dens and caves of the earth. And all these, though well attested by their faith, did not receive what was promised, since God had foreseen something better for us, that apart from us they should not be made perfect. Therefore, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us also lay aside every weight, and sin which clings so closely, and let us run with perseverance the race that is set before us, looking to Jesus the pioneer and perfecter of our faith.

The Lord said to his disciples, "Every one who acknowledges me before men, I also will acknowledge before my Father who is in heaven; but whoever denies me before men, I also will deny him before my Father who is in heaven. He who loves father or mother more than me is not worthy of me; and he who loves son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me; and he who does not take his cross and follow me is not worthy of me." Then Peter said in reply, "Lo, we have left everything and followed you. What then shall we have?" Jesus said to them, "Truly, I say to you, in the new world, when the Son of man shall sit on his glorious throne, you who have followed me will also sit on twelve thrones, judging the twelve tribes of Israel. And every one who has left houses or brothers or sisters or father or mother or children or lands, for my name's sake, will receive a hundredfold, and inherit eternal life. But many that are first will be last, and the last first."



«Νέφος μαρτύρων»

(Έβρ. 12,1)

Ο πρώτοι Χριστιανοί, άγαπητοί μου, καὶ μάλιστα ὅσοι προέρχονταν ἀπὸ τὴν Ἰουδαϊκὴ θρησκεία, ὑπέφεραν πολὺ ἐκ μέρους τῶν
ἄλλων ποὺ δὲν εἶχαν πιστέψει στὸ Χριστό. Ἑκεῖνοι ποὺ δὲν εἴχαν γνωρίσει τὸ φῶς τοῦ Εὐαγγελίου, οἱ ἄνθρωποι τοῦ σκότους, δίωκαν
ἀγρίως τοὺς «υἱοὺς τοῦ φωτός» № ½¾ № % ½½
τὰ πιὸ σατανικὰ μέσα χρησιμοποιοῦσαν γιὰ
νὰ ἐξοντώσουν τὰ τέκνα τῆς Ἑκκλησίας.

Καὶ οἱ περισσότεροι μὲν ἀπὸ τοὺς Χριστιανοὺς ἔμεναν πιστοὶ καὶ ἀφωσιωμένοι στὸν «ἀρχηγὸν τῆς πίστεως», ποὺ λέει σήμερα ὁ ἀπόστολος [ἔμ 12], τὸν Κύριον ἡμῶν Ἰησοῦν Χριστόν μερικοὶ ὅμως, μπροστὰ στὴν ἄγρια θύελλα τῶν διωγμῶν, ἄρχισαν νὰ κάμπτωνται, ἔδειχναν σημάδια λιποψυχίας.

Οί Χριστιανοὶ αὐτοὶ εἶχαν ἀνάγκη ἀπὸ παρηγορία καὶ ἐνίσχυσι. Καὶ ὁ ἀπόστολος Παῦλος, ποὺ ἡ μεγάλη καρδιά του λυπόταν γιὰ τὴν ἀπώλεια καὶ ἐνὸς ἀκόμη Χριστιανοῦ, ἐνδιαφέρεται νὰ τονώση τὶς ψυχές τους, ὥστε κανείς νὰ μὴν ἐγκαταλείψη τὸν ἀγῶνα τῆς πίστεως καὶ τῆς ἀρετῆς, ἀλλὰ ὅλοι νὰ μείνουν πιστοὶ στὸ Χριστὸ μέχρι θανάτου. Γράφει λοιπὸν πρὸς ὅλους αὐτοὺς τὴν πρὸς Ἑβραίους ἐπιστολή του καὶ ἡ φωνή του, σὰν ἐγερτήριος σάλπιγγα, ἀκούγεται παντοῦ. Καὶ τί λέει; Καὶ τί δὲν λέει!

Άδελφοί μου, λέει, μείνετε όλοι στὶς θέσεις σας! Κανείς σας μὴν πετάξη τὰ ὅπλα τοῦ Χριστιανοῦ, κανείς σας μὴ ντροπιάση τὴν παράταξι τοῦ Κυρίου. Κάντε ὑπομονή. 治γωνιστῆτε, κ' ἐτοιμαστῆτε γιὰ νὰ δώσετε μάχες ἀκόμη πιὸ σκληρὲς ἀπ' ὅ,τι μέχρι τώρα. 'Ο ἐχθρὸς εἶνε ὕπουλος, θὰ πετάγεται μπροστά σας σὲ κάθε βῆμα. 'Αλλ' ὅ,τι καὶ ἄν συμβῆ, σᾶς παρακαλῶ νὰ μείνετε στὶς θέσεις σας. Καὶ γιὰ νὰ ἔχετε μία δυνατὴ ἐνίσχυσι μέσα σὲ ὅλους τοὺς διωγμούς σας, σᾶς συμβουλεύω καὶ σᾶς συνιστῶ τὸ ἑξῆς.

Μὴ λησμονεῖτε τὶς θυσίες καὶ τὸ αἶμα ποὺ ἔχυσαν τόσοι καὶ τόσοι ἀδελφοί σας, ποὺ προηγήθηκαν καὶ ἀναδείχθηκαν ἤδη μάρτυρες τῆς πίστεώς μας. Δεῖξτε τὴν ὑπομονὴ καὶ τὴν ἀνδρεία ποὺ ἔδειξαν ὅλοι αὐτοί. Μισῆστε τὴν ἀμαρτία, τὴν προδοσία, τὸ συμβιβασμό· ζηλῶστε τὸ θάρρος καὶ τὴν παρρησία τους, μιμηθῆτε τὴ συνέπεια καὶ τὴν ἀκεραιότητά τους, μὴ καμφθῆτε. Στὸ δρόμο σας προπορεύονται οἱ μάρτυρες ἀδελφοί σας καὶ ἰδίως ὁ βασιλεὺς τῶν μαρτύρων, ὁ ἴδιος ὁ Χριστός...

Αὐτή τήν ἔννοια ἔχει, νομίζω, ή θαυμάσια περικοπή τοῦ ἀποστόλου ποὺ ἀκούσαμε σήμερα στούς ναούς μας καὶ ποὺ τελειώνει –καὶ συνεχίζει παρακάτω– μὲ τὰ λόγια· *«Τοιγαροῦν* καὶ ήμεῖς (=Κ' ἐμεῖς λοιπόν), τοσοῦτον ἔχοντες περικείμενον ήμῖν νέφος μαρτύρων (=ἔχοντας γύρω μας τόσο μεγάλο σύννεφο ἀπὸ μάρτυρες), ὄγκον ἀποθέμενοι πάντα καὶ τὴν εύπερίστατον άμαρτίαν (=πετώντας ἀπὸ πάνω μας κάθε βάρος καὶ τὴν άμαρτία ποὺ εὖκολα μπορεῖ νὰ μᾶς νικήση), δι' ὑπομονῆς τρέχωμεν τὸν προκείμενον ἡμῖν ἀγῶνα (=ας τρέχουμε μὲ ὑπομονὴ τὸν ἀγῶνα δρόμου ποὺ ἔχουμε μπροστά μας), άφορῶντες είς τὸν πίστεως άρχηγὸν καὶ τελειωτὴν Ἰησοῦν (=ἔχοντας τὸ βλέμμα μας στραμμένο στὸν ἀρχηγὸ τῆς πίστεώς μας ποὺ μᾶς ὀδηγεῖ στὴν τελειότητα), ὂς άντὶ τῆς προκειμένης αὐτῷ χαρᾶς ύπέμεινε σταυρόν, αίσχύνης καταφρονήσας (=ὁ ὁποῖος, ἀντὶ ν' ἀπολαμβάνη τὴ χαρὰ ποὺ τοῦ ἀνῆκε, ὑπέμεινε σταυρικὸ θάνατο περιφρονώντας τὴ ντροπή), ἐν δεξιᾶ τε τοῦ θρόνου τοῦ Θεοῦ κεκάθικεν (=καὶ τώρα ἔχει καθίσει στὰ δεξιὰ τοῦ θρόνου τοῦ Θεοῦ). Άναλογίσασθε γάρ τὸν τοιαύτην ὑπομεμενηκότα ύπὸ τῶν ἀμαρτωλῶν εἰς αὐτὸν ἀντιλογίαν (='Αναλογιστήτε λοιπὸν αὐτὸν ποὺ ἔχει ύπομείνει τέτοια ἀντιλογία ἀπ' τοὺς ἁμαρτωλοὺς ποὺ τὸν βασάνισαν), ἵνα μὴ κάμητε ταῖς ψυχαῖς ὑμῶν ἐκλυόμενοι (=γιὰ νὰ μὴν κουραστοῦν οἱ ψυχές σας κ' ἐξαντληθήτε)» હἱ 1213.

«Νέφος μαρτύρων»! Δηλαδή, δὲν εἶνε λίνοι οί μάρτυρες: είνε πολλοί, αναρίθμητοι, αποτελοῦν νέφος ὀλόκληρο.

"Αν ήταν δύο ή τρεῖς, θὰ μποροῦσε κανεὶς νὰ φέρη καὶ ἀντίρρησι λέγοντας. Λίγοι μόνο κατώρθωσαν νὰ μείνουν πιστοὶ στὸ Χριστό, συνεπώς δὲν εἶνε δίκαιο νὰ ζητήται ἀπὸ μᾶς κάτι ποὺ ἐλάχιστοι τὸ πέτυχαν. Έν τούτοις ούτε ή άντίρρησι αύτή στέκει, δὲν εἶνε σοβαρή· διότι, ἀκόμη καὶ ἔνας ἀπ' τὰ ἐκατομμύρια τῶν ἀνθρώπων ἄν βρισκόταν νὰ μείνη μέχρι τέλους πιστός στό Χριστό καὶ νὰ ἐφαρμόση στή ζωή του τὸ Εὐαγγέλιο, θὰ ἔφτανε αὐτὸς καὶ μόνο ὁ ἔνας νὰ δείξη, ὅτι ἡ χριστιανικὴ πίστις καὶ ζωὴ δὲν εἶνε κάτι τὸ ἀκατόρθωτο. Νά δμως ότι όχι ένας άλλά πολλοί, «έκ πάσης φυλής καὶ γλώσσης καὶ λαοῦ καὶ ἔθνους» [٨. 59, πιστεύουν στὸν Κύριο, ζοῦν ἐν Κυρίω καὶ πεθαίνουν γιὰ τὸν Κύριο.

Τὸ φωτεινὸ αὐτὸ νέφος τῶν μαρτύρων, ποὺ δὲν διαλύεται ἀλλ' ἀντιθέτως κάθε μέρα πυκνώνει μὲ νέους μάρτυρες τῆς πίστεως καὶ τῆς ἀρετῆς, εἶνε τὸ καύχημα τοῦ Χριστιανισμοῦ, ή λύπη τῶν δαιμόνων, ἀλλὰ –ἐκεῖνο ποὺ κυρίως μᾶς ἐνδιαφέρει ἐδῶ– εἶνε ὁ τρομερὸς έλεγχος τῶν ἀμελῶν καὶ ἀδιαφόρων ψυχῶν.

Τί προφασίζονται οἱ ψυχὲς αὐτές: Θέλουμε, λένε, νὰ ζήσουμε καὶ νὰ πεθάνουμε ώς πιστοί Χριστιανοί, άλλὰ χίλια έμπόδια δὲν μᾶς άφήνουν. Σήμερα οί περιστάσεις είνε δύσκολες τὸ ἐπάγγελμά μας εἶνε πολυάσχολο, οί πειρασμοί πολλοί καὶ διάφοροι... Αὐτὰ καὶ άλλα τέτοια προφασίζονται οἱ πολλοί, γιὰ νὰ δικαιολογήσουν τὴν ἀμέλεια, τὴν ὀκνηρία καὶ

τὴ δειλία τῶν ψυχῶν τους.

Νά ὅμως οἱ μάρτυρες! "Εζησαν κάτω ἀπὸ τὶς χειρότερες συνθῆκες. Ἡ θλῖψι μὲ ὅλα τὰ εΐδη της ώρμησε λυσσαλέα έναντίον τους, γιὰ νὰ τοὺς ἀπογοητεύση καὶ τοὺς καταβάλη: ὁ σατανᾶς ἔρριξε πάνω τους ὅλους τοὺς πειρασμούς ό κόσμος ξεσηκώθηκε σύσσωμος. Καὶ δμως αὐτοὶ ἔμειναν σταθεροὶ μέχρι τέλους. "Αν τολμάμε, ας συγκρίνουμε τὰ δικά μας «μαρτύρια» μὲ τὰ μαρτύρια τῶν ἀγίων, καὶ θὰ δοῦμε ὅτι οὕτε τὸ ἔνα χιλιοστὸ τῶν ὄσων ὑπέφεραν έκεῖνοι δὲν ὑποφέρουμε ἐμεῖς, οἱ περισσότεροι ἀπὸ μᾶς. Λέω οἱ περισσότεροι ἀπὸ μάς, γιατί δὲν ἀρνοῦμαι ὅτι ὑπάρχουν καὶ σήμερα σὲ διάφορες ἀντιχριστιανικὲς χῶρες Χριστιανοί ποὺ ἀνανεώνουν καὶ στὸν αίῶνα αύτὸν τὰ μαρτύρια τῶν παλαιῶν μαρτύρων.

Άλλ' αὐτοὶ εἶνε οἱ ἐκλεκτοί. Οἱ ἄλλοι ἐμεῖς τί κάνουμε; Τί ἔχουμε ν' ἀναφέρουμε ἀπὸ τοὺς πειρασμούς μας ἄξιο νὰ συγκριθῆ μὲ τοὺς πειρασμούς τῶν μαρτύρων; Γιὰ μᾶς, ποὺ δὲν πέσαμε άκόμη στούς μεγάλους πειρασμούς καί δὲν δοκιμάσαμε τὸ βάθος τῆς θλίψεως, καὶ δὲν παλέψαμε στήθος μὲ στήθος ἐναντίον τής άμαρτίας τοῦ αἰῶνος τούτου, γιὰ μᾶς ποὺ τόσο εὔκολα ἀπογοητευόμαστε κ' ἐγκαταλείπουμε ἄνανδρα τὰ τιμημένα πεδία τῶν ἀγώνων, τὸ μέτωπο τῆς στρατευομένης Έκκλησίας, ναί, γιὰ μᾶς τούς σημερινούς Χριστιανούς θὰ μποροῦσε ὁ άπόστολος Παϋλος νὰ ξαναπῆ τὰ μεγάλα του έκεΐνα άφυπνιστικά λόγια 🖼 1247 «Οὔπω μέχρις αἵματος άντικατέστητε πρὸς τὴν άμαρτίαν ἀνταγωνιζόμενοι (=Δὲν ἀντισταθήκατε ὡς τώρα μέχρι αἵματος άγωνιζόμενοι κατά τῆς άμαρτίας), καὶ ἐκλέλησθε τῆς παρακλήσεως, ἥτις ὑμῖν ώς υίοῖς διαλέγεται (=καὶ ξεχάσατε τὸν παρηγορητικό λόγο ποὺ ἀπευθύνει ὁ Κύριος σ' ἐσᾶς σὰν σὲ παιδιά του)· "Υἶέ μου, μὴ ὀλιγώρει παιδείας Κυρίου, μηδὲ ἐκλύου ὑπ' αὐτοῦ ἐλενχόμενος (=Γυιέ μου, μὴν ἀμελεῖς νὰ δέχεσαι τὴν παιδαγωγία τοῦ Κυρίου, μήτε νὰ παραλύης ὅταν ἐλέγχεσαι ἀπὸ αὐτόν). ὅν νὰρ ἀναπᾶ Κύριος παιδεύει, μαστιγοῖ δὲ πάντα υίὸν ὃν παραδέχεται (=γιατὶ ὁ Κύριος ὅποιον ἀγαπᾳ τὸν παιδεύει, καὶ μαστιγώνει ὅποιον τὸν ἀναγνωρίζει ώς δικό του παιδί). εί παιδείαν" ύπομένετε, ώς "υίοῖς" ύμῖν προσφέρεται ὁ Θεός... (=ἂν ὑποφέρετε τὴν παιδαγωγία, αὐτὸ δείχνει ὅτι ὁ Θεὸς σᾶς συμπεριφέρεται σὰν σὲ υίούς του...)».

«Νέφος μαρτύρων»! Άδελφέ μου, σοῦ δίνω μιὰ ταπεινὴ συμβουλή, ἢ μᾶλλον σοῦ τὴ δίνει ό ἀπόστολος Παῦλος. Στοὺς πειρασμοὺς καὶ τὶς θλίψεις σου, ποὺ ἀσφαλῶς θὰ σὲ βροῦν ἐφ' ὄσον βαδίζεις τὸ δρόμο τοῦ Χριστοῦ, θὰ αὶσθάνεσαι μεγάλη ψυχική ἀνακούφισι, θὰ ἐμπνέεσαι καὶ θὰ παίρνης θάρρος γιὰ νὰ συνεχίσης μέχρι τέλους τὸν ἀγῶνα, ἂν θυμᾶσαι τί ἔπαθαν καὶ τί ὑπέφεραν γιὰ τὴ δόξα τοῦ Χριστοῦ έκατομμύρια μάρτυρες. "Έτσι θ" ἀποδιώχνης άπ' τὴν ψυχή σου τὴ δειλία, τὴν ἀπελπισία καὶ τὴν ἀπογοήτευσι, καὶ γεμᾶτος πίστι θὰ βαδίζης πρὸς τὰ ἔμπρός, ἔως ὅτου φθάσης στὸ τέρμα τῆς νικηφόρου πορείας σου, στὸν ούρανό, ὅπου μὲ ἀπερίγραπτη χαρὰ θὰ σὲ ὑποδεχθοῦν τὰ πλήθη τῶν μαρτύρων καὶ τῶν ἀγγέλων καὶ θὰ ποῦν καὶ γιὰ σένα· Ὁ ἀδελφός μας αύτὸς ἔρχεται «έκ τῆς θλίψεως τῆς μεγάλης. καὶ ἔπλυνε τὴν στολὴν αύτοῦ καὶ ἐλεύκανεν αὐτὴν ἐν τῷ αἵματι τοῦ ἀρνίου» (λτ.7,14).

Their Death is More like Dreaming

We ought to honor the saints. They are Christ's friends, children and heirs of God. This is the teaching of the theologian and evangelist John: 'To all who received him ... the Word gave power to become children of God' (John 1:12). The Creator of all things is called in Scripture Lord of lords, King of kings, God of gods. The saints are precisely lords, kings and gods, not in their own nature but because they have become lords over themselves, they have ruled their passions, they have kept intact that image of God in which they were created. Indeed, the saints of their own choice are united to God, they have welcomed Him as a guest in their hearts, and by sharing with Him have become what He is by nature.

They have become God's servants, friends and children. The honor given to His faithful servants of which they are the witness is a test of our love for our Lord and theirs. He has found in them a spotless dwelling place and has performed his promise: I will make my abode among you ... and I will walk among you and will be your God' (Lev. 26:11-12).
