

Prokeimenon. Mode 4. Psalm 103.24,1

O Lord, how manifold are your works. You have made all things in wisdom.

Verse: Bless the Lord, O my soul.

The reading is from St. Paul's First Letter to the Corinthians 16:13-24

Brethren, be watchful, stand firm in your faith, be courageous, be strong. Let all that you do be done in love. 13th Sunday of Matthew The Gospel According to Matthew 21:33-42

The Lord said this parable, "There was a householder who planted a vineyard, and set a hedge around it, and dug a wine press in it, and built a tower, and let it out to tenants, and went into another country. When the season of fruit drew near, he sent his servants to the tenants, to get his fruit; and the tenants took his servants and beat one, killed another, and stoned another. Again he sent other servants, more than the first; and they did the same to them. Afterward he sent his son to them, saying 'They will respect my son.' But when the tenants saw the son, they said to themselves, 'This is the heir; come, let us kill him and have his inheritance.' And they took him and cast him out of the vineyard and killed him. When therefore the owner of the vineyard comes, what will he do to those tenants?" They said to him, "He will put those wretches to a miserable death, and let out the vineyard to other tenants who will give him the fruits in their seasons." Jesus said to them, "Have you never read in the scriptures: 'The very stone which the builders rejected has become the head of the corner; this was the Lord's doing, and it is marvelous in our eyes?""

However, there are specific dates such as Lent, PASCHA (Easter) and subsequent holy days that are MOVEABLE from year to year depending upon the calculations of the moon and seasons. Are you aware of YOUR patronal feast day (NAME-DAY). It maybe a fixed or a moveable date..... check with the clergy for affirmation.

SAINT PHANOURIOS' CAKE PHANOUROPITA

Ingredients

1 c. orange juice
½ c. brandy
2 Tbsp. unsalted butter
2c. golden raisins
½ c. sugar
½ c. honey
½ c. salt
1 Tbsp. ground cinnamon

½ tsp. ground cloves
2 c. all – purpose flour
2 tsp. double –acting baking powder
½ tsp. baking soda
2 Tbsp. grated orange peel
½ c. sesame seeds (optional)

Preheat oven to 325 degrees F.

Combine orange juice, brandy, butter, raisins, sugar, honey, salt, cinnamon, and cloves in a large heavy – bottomed sauce pan. Bring to a boil, reduce heat, and simmer for 10 minutes, or until thick and syrupy. Set pot in cold water to cool mixture completely.

1/2 c. brandy

Sift flour, baking powder, and baking soda into cooled syrup. Beat vigorously for 8 to 10 minutes, or until batter is smooth and bubbly. Stir in grated orange peel.

Turn into well-buttered 7 inch fluted tube pan or 8 inch loaf pan. Sprinkle with sesame seeds. Bake for 1 – 1-1/2 hours, or until knife inserted in the center comes out clean. Sprinkle with brandy and cool cake in pan. Makes 12 to 16 servings.





His Sacred Icon Will Be In Procession For Veneration.

SAINT PHANOURIOS

August 27th,

Saint Phanourios who lived during Roman times, was in conflict with an idolatrous world because his Christian belief in Jesus Christ would not permit him to deny His indisputable virtuous beginning. As a result, the twelve martyrdoms St. Phanourios suffered comprise for us, as Christians, a motivating strength to endure and adhere to an ethical Christian worthiness. Presently, Saint Phanourios is a constant inspiration for us to emerge victorious from an unceasing struggle against those who lack faith as well as modern day injustices. This Saint teaches us through practical sacrifices, that, though we are not fighting a Roman army or sinister ruler, we must today confront the clever traps of materialism and secular



atheism that collectively attempt to destroy the ranks of Christianity. There is one story about the saint that inspires us. It is said that his mother was a great pagan sinner who refused to accept Christianity. Saddened by her decision to deny Christ, St. Phanourios prayed fervently for his mother's salvation. While he was being tortured and about to surrender his soul to God, St Phanourios prayed: "For the sake of these my sufferings, Lord, help all those who will pray to You for the salvation of Phanourios sinful mother". Lost and forgotten for many years, the recovery of his icon in Rhodes by the monks of a monastery revealed twelve scenes depicting the persecution that the saint had suffered. This is the reason that St. Phanourios is known as the patron saint of the lost things. He is depicted holding a candle searching for his mother's lost soul! The Pita is made so that the Saint will reveal to someone a lost object, or direct an unemployed person to a job, reveal action to be taken, restore health to someone who is sick and other similar situations. It is offered after vespers to approximately forty persons expressing the characteristic phrase: "May God grant rest to the soul of Saint Phanourios 'mother".

Κακοί καὶ καλοί γεωργοί

«Κακοὺς κακῶς ἀπολέσει αὐτούς, καὶ τὸν ἀμπελῶνα ἐκδώσεται ἄλλοις γεωργοῖς, οἵτινες ἀποδώσουσιν αὐτῷ τοὺς καρποὺς ἐν τοῖς καιροῖς αὐτῶν» (Ματθ. 21.41)

Γερὶ γεωργών, άγαπητοί μου, περὶ γεωργῶν ὁμιλεῖ σήμερα τὸ εὐαγγέλιο. Οἱ γεωργοί, ποὺ ὁ Θεὸς τοὺς ἐμπιστεύθηκε τὸ ἀμπέλι του, ἀποδείχθηκαν κακοί δὲν ἀπέδωσαν
τοὺς καρποὺς ποὺ περίμενε. Γι' αὐτὸ στὸ τέλος τῆς παραβολῆς λέει, ὅτι τοὺς κακοὺς γεωργοὺς θὰ τοὺς τιμωρήση ὅπως τοὺς ἀξίζει,
καὶ θὰ παραδώση τὸ ἀμπέλι σὲ ἄλλους γεωργούς, καλοὺς γεωργούς, ποὺ θ' ἀποδώσουν
τοὺς καρποὺς στὸν οὐράνιο ἰδιοκτήτη.

Στό άμπέλι λοιπόν τοῦ Θεοῦ, δηλαδή στὴν Έκκλησία, ἄλλοι εἶνε κακοὶ γεωργοὶ καὶ ἄλλοι καλοί. Καὶ ποιοί εἶνε οἱ γεωργοί; Γεωργοὶ εἶνε οἱ ἐργάτες τῆς Ἐκκλησίας, οἱ κληρικοί. Γι' αὐτὸ κ' ἐμεῖς θὰ μιλήσουμε γιὰ τοὺς κληρικούς πρῶτα γιὰ τοὺς κακούς, καὶ ἐν συνεχεία γιὰ τοὺς καλοὺς κληρικούς.

Υπάρχει, ἀγαπητοί μου, μία τρομερὴ προφητεία, ποὺ τὴν εἶπε ὁ ἄγιος Κοσμᾶς ὁ Αἰτω-λός, καὶ στὶς μέρες μας ἐκπληρώνεται. Τὸν ρώτησαν: -Ποιά εἶνε τὰ σημάδια ὅτι ἔρχεται ἡ καταστροφὴ τοῦ κόσμου; Κ' ἐκεῖνος ἀπήντησε: -Ἦταν ἐποχὴ ποὺ οἱ κληρικοὶ ζοῦσαν σὰν ἄγγελοι: δὲν ἀγαποῦσαν τὰ λεφτά, δὲν ἀγαποῦσαν τὴ δόξα, δὲν εἶχαν πάθη, στέκονταν ψηλὰ μέσα στὴν κοινωνία: καὶ τότε οἱ λαϊκοὶ ζοῦσαν σὰν ἄνθρωποι. Θὰ ἔρθουν ὅμως, λέει, χρόνια κατηραμένα, ποὺ θὰ πέση καὶ θὰ ἐξευτελισθῆ ὁ κλῆρος. Καὶ τότε, ὅταν οἱ παπάδες θὰ ζοῦν σὰν τοὺς λαϊκούς, οἱ λαϊκοὶ θὰ ζοῦν σὰν τὰ κτήνη: καὶ τότε θὰ ἔρθη τὸ τέλος τοῦ κόσμου.

Τί έννοεϊ όταν λέει, ότι οἰ παπάδες θὰ ζοῦν σὰν τοὺς λαϊκούς; Δηλαδή· πάει στὸ καφφενεῖο ὁ λαϊκός, θὰ πάη καὶ ὁ κληρικός. Πάει στὸν κινηματογράφο ὁ λαϊκός, θὰ πάη καὶ ὁ κληρικός. Κουρεύει τὰ μαλλιά του ὁ λαϊκός, θὰ τὰ κουρέψη καὶ ὁ κληρικός. Παίζει φουτ μπὼλ ὁ λαϊκός, θὰ παίξη καὶ αὐτός. Παίζει χαρτιὰ ὁ λαϊκός, θὰ παίξη καὶ αὐτός. Καὶ στὸ χορὸ ἀκόμα πᾶνε. Βγάζουν τὸ ῥάσο καὶ τὸ καλυμμαύχι τους καὶ χορεύουν. Αὐτοὶ εἶνε οί μοντέρνοι παπάδες, ποὺ θέλουν νὰ πνεύση ἔνα νέο ῥεῦμα στὴν Ἐκκλησία. Άλλ' ὁ ὁρθόδοξος κόσμος τοὺς ἔχει σιχαθή.

Τὰ εἶπε ὁ ἄγιος Κοσμᾶς, καὶ τώρα γίνονται. Μείναμε δυστυχῶς λίγοι νὰ διαμαρτυρώμαστε. Δὲν ξέρω τί θὰ γίνη ᾶν αῦριο ἔρθη ἄλλη κατάστασι ἐμεῖς, ὅσο μποροῦμε, θὰ κρατήσουμε τὴν τιμὴ τῆς Ὀρθοδοξίας, καὶ ἀδιαφοροῦμε τί λένε καὶ κάνουν οἱ νεωτερισταί.

Ό ἄγιος Κοσμᾶς ὁ Αἰτωλὸς λέει "Όταν οἰ παπάδες θὰ ζοῦν σὰν τοὺς λαϊκούς, τότε οἱ λαϊκοὶ θὰ γίνουν σὰν τὰ κτήνη, καὶ τότε θὰ ἔρθη τὸ τέλος τοῦ κόσμου. Καὶ τώρα ἀκοῦς πλέον τοὺς λαϊκοὺς νὰ λένε "Ε, κι ὁ παπάς τὸ κάνει αὐτό... Ὁ παπᾶς πάει στὸ θέατρο, ὁ παπᾶς πάει στὸ γήπεδο, ὁ παπᾶς πάει ἐδῶ, ὁ παπᾶς πάει ἐκεῖ. Ἡ παπαδιά του φοράει μίνι, τὰ κορίτσια του γυρίζουν δεξιὰ κι ἀριστερά, τὰ ἀγόρια του ἔχουν γίνει τεντυμπόηδες. Τί διαφέρει, σοῦ λέει, ὁ παπᾶς ἀπὸ τὸ λαϊκό; "Επάγγελμα καὶ μαγαζί εἶνε ἡ ἐκκλησία... Γι' αὐτὸ καὶ ὁ λαὸς ἔχει ἀποκτηνωθῆ.

Λέγοντας βέβαια αὐτὰ γιὰ τὸν κλῆρο δὲν παίρνουμε σβάρνα ὅλους τοὺς κληρικούς.
 Ξέρουμε πολὺ καλά, ὅτι ὑπάρχουν καὶ κληρικοὶ ποὺ εἴνε καλοὶ γεωργοὶ καὶ τηροῦν τὴν ἀξιοπρέπειά τους. Μπορεῖ οἱ περισσότεροι νὰ ἔχουν ξεφύγει, ἀλλὰ ὑπάρχει καὶ ἕνα μικρὸ ποσοστὸ εὐλαβῶν ἱερέων.

μας ό παπάς πρέπει νὰ εἶνε σὰν ἄγγελος μέσα στὸν κόσμο αὐτόν. Παλαιότερα ἔνας "Αγγλος περιηγητής πῆγε στὴν Κύπρο, κι ὅταν ἐπέστρεψε στὴν Άγγλία εἶπε. Εἶδα στὴν Κύπρο ἄγγελο! "Όταν τὸν ρώτησαν, ποιός εἶνε ὁ άγγελος, λέει: 'Ο Κυπριανός' άγιος άνθρωπος, ἀφιλάργυρος, νὰ τὸν ἔψαχνες δὲν εἶχε ούτε ένα γρόσι άνθρωπος τής προσευχής καὶ τῆς νηστείας... Ποιός ἦταν αὐτὸς ὁ Κυπριανός: "Όταν τὸ 1821 κηρύχθηκε ή ἐπανάστασι, ξεσηκώθηκαν καὶ οί Κύπριοι. Έλευθεριά! φώναξαν. Τότε οί Τουρκαλάδες πήρανε μαχαίρια, γεμίσανε καράβια, βγήκαν στὴν Κύπρο καὶ ἐημάξανε τὸ νησί. Πιάσανε τὴ νύχτα τὸν Κυπριανὸ καὶ τὸν κρεμάσανε -τρεῖς μέρες ήταν κρεμασμένος ὁ ἄνιος Κυπριανός-καὶ μαζί του σκοτώσανε τριακόσους παπάδες καὶ ἄλλους προύχοντες τοῦ νησιοῦ.

Νάτος ὁ καλὸς γεωργός! σὰν ἄγγελος στέκει πάνω ἀπὸ τὸ νησὶ αὐτὸ καὶ τὸ εὐλογεῖ.

Καὶ ὄχι μόνο τότε ὁ Κυπριανὸς στὴν Κύπρο, ἀλλὰ καὶ σ' ὅλη τὴν Ὀρθόδοξο Ἐκκλησία σὲ κάθε ἐποχὴ ὅὲν λείπουν οἱ καλοὶ γεωργοί, οἱ φύλακες ἄγγελοι τῆς ἀμπέλου. Ἄγγελοι καὶ καλοὶ γεωργοὶ εἶνε οἱ τόσοι μαρτυρικοὶ ποιμένες τῆς Ὀρθοδοξίας, εἶνε ὁ κάθε καλὸς ἐπίσκοπος καὶ ὁ κάθε καλὸς παπᾶς.

Μπορεί τότε οἱ παπάδες νὰ ἤταν ἀγράμματοι, ἀλλὰ εἴχαν στὴν καρδιά τους τὸ Χριστὸ καὶ τὴν Ἑλλάδα. "Αχ, ποῦ εἴνε αὐτοὶ οἱ παπαδες! Τώρα, μορφωμένοι, σὲ σχολὲς καὶ πανεπιστήμια, μὲ τὰ γαλλικά τους καὶ τὰ ἀγγλικά τους, μὲ τοὺς σβέρκους τους ξυρισμένους, μὲ τὰ μαλλιά τους κομμένα, μὲ τὰ ῥασάκια τους σιδερωμένα… 'Απὸ άγιωσύνη ὅμως; Έκεῖνοι τότε εἴχαν ἀξία' θυσιάζονταν γιὰ τὸ ποίμνιο.

Τὸν καιρὸ τῆς τουρκοκρατίας στὸ χωριὸ Άκρίτας - Φλωρίνης ήταν ένας παπάς λεβέντης, καλὸς γεωργός, ἄγγελος προστάτης. Εἶχαν στὸ χωριὸ ενα ὅμορφο κορίτσι. Οἱ Τουρκαλάδες νύχτα, σὰν τὸ γεράκι, ἄρπαξαν τὸ κορίτσι καὶ τὸ πήγανε στὸ χαρέμι. Ποιός νὰ μιλήση; Ό παπᾶς ἔκλαιγε δυὸ μέρες. Ό ντελὴ παπᾶς –ἔτσι τὸν λέγανε (δηλαδὴ ὁ τρελλὸς παπάς, γιατὶ εἶνε τρελλὸς γιὰ τὸν κόσμο ὅποιος βγαίνει ἀπὸ τὴν πεπατημένη ὁδό)- μιὰ νύχτα πηδάει τοὺς φράχτες καὶ τὰ ντουβάρια, μπαίνει μέσα στὸ χαρέμι, ἄρπάζει τὴ Χριστιανοπούλα, τὴ φέρνει πίσω, καὶ μετὰ φεύγει στὴ Ῥωσία γιὰ νὰ γλυτώση... Τέτοιοι ἦταν οί ίερεῖς. Προστάτες τῶν χηρῶν καὶ ὀρφανῶν, φιλάνθρωποι καὶ ἐλεήμονες, μὲ ἀπέραντη πατρική ἀγάπη στὴν καρδιά τους.

"Ας μνημονεύσουμε δμως καὶ τὸν ἐπίσκοπο Φλωρίνης Πολύκαρπο. "Αν δὲν ἦταν αὐτός, δὲν θά 'ταν ἐλεύθερη ἡ Φλώρινα. Τὸ λένε τὰ ἐπίσημα χαρτιὰ τοῦ ἐπιτελείου. "Εβλεπε, ὅτι οἱ Σέρβοι κατεβαίνουν. Πῆραν τὸ Μοναστήρι, κι ἀπὸ ὥρα σὲ ὥρα θά 'παιρναν καὶ τὴ Φλώρινα. Τότε στέλνει ἔνα παπὰ τὰ μεσάνυχτα· πέρασε τὰ φυλάκια, βρῆκε τὸ στρατὸ καὶ τοὺς εἶπε· «"Αν δὲν τρέξετε, ἡ Φλώρινα πέφτει στὰ χέρια τῶν Σέρβων». Νύχτα τότε, μὲ κρύο καὶ βροχή, μὲ μεγάλο καλπασμὸ τοῦ ἱππικοῦ, μόλις πρόλαβαν. Τοὺς περίμενε ἔξω ἀπὸ τὴ Μητρόπολι. Τοὺς ἀσπάσθηκε καὶ ὑψώθηκε ἡ ἐλληνικὴ σημαία. Ποιός τὸν θυμᾶται σήμερα;

"Αγγελοι προστάτες καὶ καλοὶ γεωργοὶ τοῦ βασανισμένου λαοῦ μας εἶνε οἱ κληρικοἱ, ποὺ μὲ τὸ λόγο τοῦ Θεοῦ κρατοῦνε τὸ λαό μας. Πῶς ἔμεινε ἡ Κύπρος τρεῖς χιλιάδες χρόνια; Πέρασαν κατακτηταὶ καὶ κατακτηταί. Δὲν κατώρθωσαν νὰ σβήσουν τὴ φλόγα. Ποιός τὴν κράτησε ἀναμμένη; 'Ο παπᾶς. Αὐτὸς βάζει λάδι καὶ μένει ἄσβηστη ἡ καντήλα τῆς Ἑλλάδος. Μάλιστα, αὐτή εἶνε ἡ Ἑκκλησία μας μὲ τοὺς καλοὺς γεωργούς της.

Τὸ Ἑλληνικὸ κράτος ἐν τούτοις ἀπέναντι στὴν Ἐκκλησία ἔδειξε αἰσχρὴ διαγωγή. Θέλετε νὰ σᾶς πῶ μιὰ ἱστορία; "Όταν ἐλευθερώθηκε ὁ τόπος, στὴ Μητρόπολι Φλωρίνης συνέβη τὸ ἐξῆς. "Ηρθαν, ἀπὸ κάτω, διοικηταί, νομάρχες (οἰ περισσότεροι μασόνοι). Καὶ τί ἔκαναν; "Α, λένε, τώρα δὲν θέλουμε ἐκκλησιὲς καὶ παπάδες. Καὶ πῆγαν μιὰ μέρα νὰ κατασχέσουν τὴ Μητρόπολι, νὰ βγάλουν ἔξω τὸ δεσπότη, γιὰ νὰ κάνουν τὸ κτήριο σχολεῖο!... "Ετσι περιφρονεῖται τὸ ῥάσο.

Άλλα σας το λέω έγώ, που ξέρω την πατρίδα ή Έλλαδα είνε καλό περιβόλι, έχει καλό χῶμα. "Άμα ὅμως τ' ἀφήσης, θὰ γεμίση ἀγκάθια. Καὶ αὐτοὶ ποὺ καλλιεργοῦν τὸ περιβόλι είνε οἱ κληρικοί. Αὐτοὶ είνε οἱ καλοὶ γεωργοί. "Αν τὸ σκάψουμε, ἄν τὸ ποτίσουμε μὲ τὰ δάκρυά μας, ᾶν τὸ καλλιεργήσουμε, αὐτὸ τὸ περιβόλι θὰ τινάξη ῥόδα καὶ θὰ γίνη ἡ πιὸ ώραία χώρα τοῦ κόσμου.

Άγαπητοί μου! "Όλοι ν' άγωνισθοῦμε, γιὰ νὰ γίνη ή πατρίδα μας κράτος Θεοῦ. "Αν ἀρχίση μία ήθική καὶ θρησκευτική ἐπανάστασι, ή Έλλάδα θὰ ἀναγεννηθῆ, θὰ γίνη βασιλεία Θεοῦ, ἀστέρι φωτεινό, καὶ ὅλοι θὰ δοξάζουμε τὸν Χριστό ὄν, παϊδες Έλλήνων, ὑμνεῖτε καὶ ὑπερυψοῦτε εἰς πάντας τοὺς αἰῶνας ἀμήν.

His Body, His Blood

Because we are composed of a dual nature, soul and body, we need a dual birth and dual nourishment. We receive our birth by means of water and Spirit, that is, by Holy Baptism. We find our nourishment in the bread of life, that is, in Jesus Christ himself. When the moment arrived for Him to undergo death for us of His own free will, on the night in which He was to be handed over to His enemies, He established a new covenant with His disciples, and through them with all those who believe in Him. He washed his disciples' feet, offering in this a symbol of Holy Baptism. Then, breaking the bread, He gave it to them saying: Take and eat; this is my body which will be broken for you for the forgiveness of sins.' In the same way He gave them the cup with the wine and the water saying: 'Drink, this is my blood.' If sky, earth, water,

iron and air have been created by the Word of God, so much more certainly this noble being called humanity has been formed by Him. And if the Word himself became flesh by the pure blood of the Virgin, will He not be able to make the bread His body and the wine and water His blood? In the beginning God mid: Let the earth bring forth green grass." And so after that the earth, watered by the rain, in obedience to God's command, brings forth its fruits. Then God said: This is my body, this is my blood," adding: 'Do this in memory of me,' After that, all the myetery takes place, thanks to His allpowerful Word, and proclaims its faith in the Lord. It is a new kind of planting. The rain comes down on it, that is to say, the power of the Spirit comes down, and overshadows it.
