

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#### St. Paul's Letter to the Galatians 2:16-20 **Prokeimenon. Mode 4. Psalm 103.24,1**

O Lord, how manifold are your works. You have made all things in wisdom. Verse: Bless the Lord, O my soul.

The reading is from St. Paul's Letter to the Galatians 2:16-20

Brethren, knowing that a man is not justified by works of the law but through faith in Jesus Christ, even we have believed in Christ Jesus, in order to be justified by faith in Christ, and not by works of the law, because by works of the law shall no one be justified. But if, in our endeavor to be justified in Christ, we ourselves were found to be sinners, is Christ then an agent of sin? Certainly not! But if I build up again those things which I tore down, then I prove myself a transgressor. For I through the law died to the law, that I might live to God. I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me; and the life I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me

#### The Gospel According to Luke 8:26-39

At that time, as Jesus arrived at the country of the Gadarenes, there met him a man from the city who had demons; for a long time he had worn no clothes and he lived not in a house but among the tombs. When he saw Jesus, he cried out and fell down before him, and said with a loud voice, "What have you to do with me, Jesus, Son of the Most High God? I beseech you, do not torment me." For he had commanded the unclean spirit to come out of the man. (For many a time it had seized him; he was kept under guard, and bound with chains and fetters, but he broke the bonds and was driven by the demon into the desert.) Jesus then asked him, "What is your name?" And he said, "Legion"; for many demons had entered him. And they begged him not to command them to depart into the abyss. Now a large herd of swine was feeding there on the hillside; and they begged him to let them enter these. So he gave them leave. Then the demons came out of the man and entered the swine, and the herd rushed down the steep bank into the lake and were drowned. When the herdsmen saw what happened, they fled, and told it in the city and in the country. Then people went out to see what had happened, and they came to Jesus, and found the man from whom the demons had gone, sitting at the feet of Jesus, clothed and in his right mind; and they were afraid. And those who had seen it told them how he who had been possessed with demons was healed. Then all the people of the surrounding country of the Gadarenes asked him to depart from them; for they were seized with great fear; so he got into the boat and returned. The man from whom the demons had gone begged that he might be with him; but he sent him away, saying, "Return to your home, and declare how much God has done for you." And he went away, proclaiming throughout the whole city how much Jesus had done for him.

# LIFE OF SAINT DEMETRIOS October 26, Saints Demetrios and Nestor

Demetrios was a native of the city of Thessalonike, the city founded by Alexander the Great. Demetrios honed his keen oratorical power in the public forum. Thessalonike had a reputation for providing the brightest intellectuals and the most fearsome gladiators in the arena. In both the power of Demetios was to find expression . Demetrios was in military service as well as a devout Christian.It came to the attention of the Emperor Maximianus, who had come for an annual exhibition of gladiatorial prowess in the arena. Demetrios met with royal displeasure. Demetrios was stripped of his military rank and cast into prison to await an uncertain fate.

It was at this point that the friendship of Nestor came to light. as great personal risk Nestor visited his friend in prison. One of the favorites of the arena, admired particularly by the emperor, was a giant man named Lyaios, a seven-foot brute.

# Nestor heard from

Demetrios that the power of the Lord could be transmitted through him to any man and him invincible against any foe in the arena.
Buoyed by the assurance of Demetrios, Nestor stepped into the arena and shouted his defiance in the name of the Lord JESUS CHRIST.

The pagan crowd, thinking this some practical joke, roared with laughter. Nestor strode to the royal box of Maximinus and heard the young man invoke the name of Demetrios and the awesome power of God . Lyaios was also brought into the pit. The crowd was brought to their feet in disbelief when the gladiator who had never tasted defeat was killed by Nestor. Nestor scorned the thumbs down signal of the mob who now screamed for death. The young Christian walked away from his prostrated foe...



The frustrated emperor ordered the deaths of both Christian companions Demetrios and young Nestor They were executed without delay by the Roman soldiers. Many who left the Arena converted to JESUS CHRIST.

## Λεγεὼν δαιμονίων

«Τί σοί ἐστιν ὄνομα; ὁ δὲ εἴπε· Λεγεών· ὅτι δαιμόνια πολλὰ εἰσῆλθεν εἰς αὐτόν» (Λουκ. 8,30)

Πολλοὶ νομίζουν σήμερα ὅτι δὲν ὑπάρχουν δαιμόνια. Θὰ ἤθελα κ' ἐγώ, ἀγαπητοί μου, νὰ μὴν ὑπάρχουν ἀλλὰ δυστυχῶς ὑπάρχουν, εἶνε μία σκληρὴ πραγματικότης. Ύπάρχουν πνεύματα ἀκάθαρτα, ποὺ ἐπηρεάζουν μὲ πολλοὺς τρόπους τὸν ἄνθρωπο. Ἡ σελήνη καὶ ὁ ῆλιος ἀσκοῦν ἐπίδρασι ἐπάνω στὴ γῆ· ἐκτὸς ὅμως ἀπὸ τὰ οὐράνια αὐτὰ σώματα ὑπάρχουν κι ἄλλοι κόσμοι, ἀόρατοι, ποὺ ἡ ἐπιστήμη δὲν μπορεῖ νὰ τοὺς ἀντιληφθῆ· ἐκτὸς ἀπὸ τὰ φυσικὰ ὑπάρχουν καὶ ὑπερφυσικὰ φαινόμενα, ποὺ ἡ ἐπίδρασί τους εἶνε μεγάλη στὴ ζωή μας.

Θὰ ἥθελα νὰ συστήσω στοὺς διανοουμένους ποὺ ἀμφιβάλλουν γιὰ τὴν ὅπαρξι δαιμόνων ας μή διαβάσουν το Εὐαγγέλιο, ας διαβά σουν τὸ ἔργο τοῦ Ῥώσου λογοτέχνου Ντοστογιέφσκυ «Δαιμονισμένοι». Θὰ δοῦν ἐκεῖ, ὅτι μερικὰ ἐγκλήματα, ἀσύλληπτα στὴ φαντασία, μία μόνο ἐξήγησι ἔχουν: ὅτι ὁ ἄνθρωπος, καὶ ὁ ἀγιώτερος ἀκόμη, μερικές στιγμές διατελεΐ **ὑπὸ** τὸ κράτος δαιμονικῆς ἐπηρείας. Θεὸς φυλάξοι! «Μή είσενέγκης ήμᾶς είς πειρασμόν» (Μπθ. 6.13). Πρὸ ήμερῶν στὸ κακουργοδικεῖο Θεσσαλονίκης δικαζόταν κάποιος γιὰ ἔγκλημα, ἐνῷ ἡ προηγούμενη ζωή του ήταν άνεπίληπτη. Κλαίγον τας είπε: Πῶς τό 'κανα! δὲν μπορῶ νὰ καταλάβω πῶς ἔφτασα στὸ κακό· θόλωσε τὸ μυαλό. σὰν κάποια ἄλλη δύναμι νὰ μ' ἔσπρωχνε...

Εἶνε λοιπὸν γεγονὸς ἐξακριβωμένο, ὅχι μόνο άγιογραφικῶς άλλὰ καὶ φιλοσοφικῶς καὶ ψυχολογικῶς, ὅτι ἔρχονται στιγμὲς ποὺ οὕτε τὸ λογικὸ οὕτε ἡ συνείδησις άλλὰ μία ἄλλη δύναμις ὧθεῖ τὸν ἄνθρωπο στὸ «γκρεμό».

"Αν κάποιος ἐξακολουθῆ νὰ ἀμφιβάλλη, ᾶς πάη στὴν Κεφαλονιὰ ὅταν γιορτάζει ὁ ἄγιος Γεράσιμος (20 Ὁκτωβρίου). Θὰ ὅῆ ἐκεῖ, ἄνθρωποι ποὺ τοὺς πειράζουν τὰ δαιμόνια, μόλις φανῆ τὸ λείψανο τοῦ ἀγίου, νὰ σπαράζουν σὰν τὸ ψάρι καὶ νὰ κραυγάζουν «Μᾶς ἔκαψες, καψάλη!», καὶ νὰ θεραπεύωνται μὲ τὴ δύναμι τοῦ σταυροῦ τοῦ Κυρίου ἡμῶν Ἰησοῦ Χριστοῦ.

Ύπάρχουν λοιπόν πονηρά πνεύματα. Καὶ ῶς ἐδῶ μὲ ἀκούσατε: θὰ μὲ ἀκούσετε ἄραγε καὶ στὴ συνέχεια;

Έρχόμαστε τώρα, ἀγαπητοί μου, ἀπὸ τὴν περικοπὴ τοῦ σημερινοῦ εὐαγγελίου στὴ σημερινοῦ εὐαγγελίου στὴ σημερινὴ κατάστασι τῆς κοινωνίας μας. Φαντάζομαι τὸν Κύριό μας νὰ ἔρχεται στὴν πατρίδα μας κι ὅπως τότε ρώτησε τὸν ταλαίπωρο ἐκεῖ - νον ἄνθρωπο, «Τί σοί ἐστιν ὄνομα;»(Ιωκ ΕΧΙ), ἔ - τοι τώρα ρωτάει καὶ τὸν καθένα ἀπὸ μᾶς, τοὺς νέους καὶ νέες, μικροὺς - μεγάλους, γέρους καὶ παιδιά, καὶ λέει: «Ποιό εἶνε τὸ ὄνομά σου;».

Έχουμε ἀσφαλῶς ὅλοι ἀπὸ τὸ βάπτισμά μας ονόματα χριστιανικά καὶ έλληνικά, ονόματα άγίων άλλος ονομάζεται Άνδρέας, άλλος Νικόλαος, ἄλλος Κωνσταντῖνος..., καὶ οἱ γυναῖκες ἄλλη Έλένη, ἄλλη Αἰκατερίνη..., καὶ ἄλλη έχει τὸ ὄνομα Μαρία τῆς Παναγίας Παρθένου καί φτάνει μόνο τὸ ὄνομά μας, ὄνομα έλ ληνικό καὶ ὀρθόδοξο, νὰ μᾶς διδάξη, "Εγουμε λοιπὸν καθένας τὸ δικό του ὄνομα. "Όπως ὅ μως τότε ὁ ἄνθρωπος τοῦ εὐαγγελίου δὲν ἀπήντησε λέγοντας τὸ ὄνομά του, ἀλλ' ἀποκρίθηκε «Λεγεών»(tà), φοβάμαι, άναπητοί μου, άν κάνη ὁ Κύριος σήμερα τὸ ἐρώτημα «Ποιό εἶνε τ' ὄνομά σου;», μήπως λάβη παρομοία ἀπάντησι' ὅτι δηλαδή καὶ σ' ἐμᾶς, παρὰ τὴν ἐξωτερική ἐμφάνισι, τὴ μόρφωσι ἢ τὰ πλούτη, ὑ πάρχουν πλήθη δαιμονίων καὶ τότε, ἀνάλογα μὲ τὸν ἀριθμό τους, σὲ γλῶσσα στρατιωτική, θ' ἀκούγεται ή ἀπάντησι ἄλλος θ' ἀπαντήση. Τ' ὄνομά μου εἶνε «Διμοιρία», ἄλλος Τ' ὄνομά μου είνε «Λόχος», άλλος «Διλοχία», άλλος «Τάγμα», ἄλλος «Ταξιαρχία», ἄλλος «Μεραρχία»,

Μάλιστα. "Όχι ενα καὶ δύο άλλὰ πλήθος δαιμόνια φωλιάζουν σήμερα μέσα στοὺς ἀνθρώπους ποὺ φέρουν χριστιανικὰ ὀνόματα. Μὴ ξυπάζεστε, μὴν τρομάζετε. Καὶ ἐξηγοῦμαι.

√ Τὸν βλέπεις ἐκεῖνον: "Απ' τὸ πρωί, πρὶν ν' άνατείλη ὁ ἥλιος, ἀντὶ νὰ πάη στὴ δουλειὰ ἦ στὸν οἶκο τοῦ Θεοῦ, ἡ πρώτη του ἐπίσκεψι εἶνε στὸ καπηλειό - οἰνοπωλεῖο, στὴν ταβέρνα, μαγαζιά ποὺ πλημύρισαν τὴν πατρίδα μας. Τὰ χέρια του τρέμουν, τὰ πόδια του τρικλίζουν, συχνὰ δὲν περπατάει μὲ τὰ δύο πόδια, πέφτει μὲ τὰ τέσσερα, γίνεται τετράποδο ὅπως ὁ χοῖρος τοῦ σημερινοῦ εὐαγγελίου. Εἶνε ἀξιοθρήνητος ἔχει τὸ δαιμόνιο τοῦ ἀλκοολισμοῦ.

√Τον βλέπεις τον ἄλλον ἢ τὴν κυρία τῆς ἀριστοκρατίας; "Όπως οἱ νυχτερίδες, ποὺ κινοῦνται στὰ σκοτεινά, ἔτσι κι αὐτοὶ μόλις νυχτώση βγαίνουν καὶ ἢ πηγαίνουν σὲ καζῖνο μὲ τυχερὰ παιχνίδια, ἢ μαζεύονται σὲ ὡρισμένα σπίτια κ' ἐκεῖ, γύρω ἀπ' τὸ πράσινο τραπέζι μὲ τὸς τράπουλες στὰ χέρια, παίζουν ὡς τὸς πρωινὸς ὡρες, καὶ πολὺ συχνὰ φεύγουν ἀπένταροι. √ "Αλλο δαιμόνιο ποὺ ταλανίζει τὴν ἀγαπητή μας πατρίδα. Τὸν βλέπεις ἐκεῖνο τὸν ἄλλο; Μέσα στὸ κεφάλι του, ἄν τ' ἀνοίξης, δὲν θὰ δῆς οὖτε πατρίδα οὖτε θρησκεία· θὰ δῆς μόνο λεφτὰ καὶ τίποτ' ἄλλο. "Εγινε ἔνας μπεζαχτᾶς, ἔνας ἄνθρωπος ποὺ μετράει μόνο τὰ δολλάρια καὶ χρυσὲς λίρες. Αὐτὸς πάσχει ἀπὸ τὸ δαιμόνιο τῆς φιλαργυρίας, ἡ ὁποία ἐξώθησε ἕνα προδότη νὰ πουλήση τὸν Κύριό του.

√ Βλέπεις κ' ἐκεῖνο τὸ νέο, ποὺ κάποτε ἦταν ἀριστοῦχος στὸ σχολεῖο καὶ στὶς σπουδές; Τώρα πιὰ δὲν προβιβάζεται, μένει καθυστερημένος, αἰώνιος φοιτητής. Τί ἔπαθε; Τὸν ξεμυάλισε ὁ ἔρωτας καὶ ἡ σαρκικὴ ἡδονή. Καὶ ὅχι μόνο ξέχασε τὴν ἐπιστήμη του, ἀλλὰ κινδυνεύει νὰ χάση καὶ τὴν ὑγεία καὶ τὴ ζωή του καὶ νὰ πεθάνη μέσα στὰ ἄσυλα τῶν ἀνιάτων. Τὸ κυρίευσε τὸ δαιμόνιο τῆς ἀκολασίας.

√Νά κ' ἐκεῖνος μὲ τὰ γκρίζα μαλλιά, ποὺ ἔχει παιδιὰ καὶ ἐγγόνια. Τὸν βλέπεις μιὰ μέρα κ' ἐγκαταλείπει τὴν ὑπέροχη τίμια γυναῖκα του καὶ τὰ χαριτωμένα παιδιά του, καὶ σμίγει μὲ ἄλλες γυναῖκες, ἄτιμες. Τί ἔπαθε αὐτός; Τὸν ἔδεσε τὸ δαιμόνιο τῆς πορνείας καὶ μοιχείας.

√Τὴ βλέπεις κ' ἐκείνη τὴν ἄλλη, ποὺ πετάει τὰ ροῦχα της καὶ περπατάει γυμνὴ κ' ἐπιδεικνύει τὶς σάρκες της λὲς κ' εἶνε κρέατα Άργεντινῆς; Αὐτὴ ἔχει τὸ ἴδιο δαιμόνιο μὲ τὸν ἄνθρωπο τοῦ σημερινοῦ εὐαγγελίου ποὺ ἔβγαζε τὰ ροῦχα του, τὸ δαιμόνιο τοῦ γυμνισμοῦ.

Μακρὺς εἶνε ὁ κατάλογος τῶν δαιμονίων. Καὶ στὸ ἐρώτημα «Ποιό εἶνε τ' ὄνομά σας;» ἡ ἀπάντησι ποὺ ἀνταποκρίνεται στὴν πραγματικότητα εἶνε πάλι «Λεγεών». Κι ὅχι μόνο γιὰ ἄτομα, ἀλλὰ καὶ γιὰ χωριὰ ὁλόκληρα καὶ πόλεις ἡ ἴδια ἀπάντησι ἀρμόζει. 'Ἀθήνα, Θεσσαλονίκη, Πάτρα, Βέρροια..., ποιό εἶνε τ' ὄνομά σας; 'Έχετε ὡραῖα ὀνόματα, ποὺ ὑπενθυμίζουν ἕνα ἔνδοξο παρελθὸν τῆς ἱστορίας σας ἀλλ' ἐὰν ἀπαντήσουν οἱ ταβέρνες, τὰ χαρτοπαίγνια, τὰ διαζύγια, οἱ ληστεῖες, τὰ ἐγκλήματα, τ' ἀμαρτωλὰ σπίτια, ἡ ἀπιστία καὶ διαφθορά, τότε χάθηκαν πλέον τὰ ἱστορικὰ ὀνόματα καὶ ἔνα ὄνομα ἀπέμεινε· «Λεγεών»!

Άλλ' ας ἔχη δόξα ὁ Χριστός. Ἐγὼ ἀκούω τὴ θριαμβευτικὴ φωνή, τὸ θούριο, τὸν παιανα. Δὲν τ' ἀκοῦτε σεῖς; Νίκησε ὁ Χριστός! Ποιόν νίκησε; Στὴν ἀρχή, μετὰ τὴ βάπτισί του στὸν Ἰορδάνη, βγῆκε στὴν ἔρημο, νήστεψε, προσευχήθηκε, πάλεψε ἐπὶ 40 μέρες μὲ τὸ διάβολο, κι ἀπέκρουσε τοὺς τρεῖς πειρασμούς μὲ τὸ «Ύπαγε ὁπίσω μου, σατανά» Νισέ (Ν). Καὶ τότε χαρὰ καὶ ἀγαλλίασι σὲ ὅλους, καὶ ἔνας ὕμνος θ' ἀναπέμπεται στὸν ἐν Τριάδι Θεό· Δόξα στὸν Υίό, δόξα στὸ Χριστό, τὸ νικητὴ τῶν πνευμάτων. Σ' αὐτὸν ἡ λατρεία εἰς αἰῶνας αἰώνων· ἀμήν.

#### James the Apostle, Brother of the Lord

This Saint James (Iakovos in Greek) is called the Less (Mark 1504) by the Evangelists to distinguish him from James, the son of Zebedee and brother of Saint John, who was called the Great. He became the first Bishop of Jerusalem, elevated to this hierarchical rank by the Apostles, according to Eusebius (Eccl. Hist., Book II: 23), and was called Obliah, that is, the Just, because of his great holiness and rightcousness. According to tradition, this Saint James ascended the crest of the Temple on the day of the Passover at the prompting of all, he bore testimony from there concerning his belief in Jesus, and he proclaimed with a great voice that Jesus sits at the right hand of the great power of God

and shall come again upon the clouds of become.

On hearing this testimony, many of those present cried, "Hosanna to the Son of David." But the Scribes and Pharisers cried, "So, even the just one has been led astray," and at the command of Ananias the high priest, the Apostle was cast down headlong from there. While being stoned to death, and while he prayed for his slayers, his head was crushed by the wooden club wielded by a certain scribe. The first of the Universal (General) Epistles written to the Jews in the Diaspora who believed in Christ was written by this Apostle James.

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
