

FIFTH SUNDAY OF LUKE



Icon of the Parable of the Rich Man and Lazarus (Luke 16:19-31)

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Prokeimenon. Mode 2. Psalm 117.14,18

The Lord is my strength and my song. Verse: The Lord has chastened me sorely. The reading is from St. Paul's Second Letter to the Corinthians 11:31-33; 12:1-9

Brethren, the God and Father of the Lord Jesus, he who is blessed for ever, knows that I do not lie. At Damascus, the governor under King Aretas guarded the city of Damascus in order to seize me, but I was let down in a basket through a window in the wall, and escaped his hands. I must boast; there is nothing to be gained by it, but I will go on to visions and revelations of the Lord. I know a man in Christ who fourteen years ago was caught up to the third heaven -- whether in the body or out of the body I do not know, God knows. And I know that this man was caught up into Paradise --whether in the body or out of the body I do not know, God knows -- and he heard things that cannot be told, which man may not utter. On behalf of this man I will boast, but on my own behalf I will not boast, except of my weaknesses. Though if I wish to boast, I shall not be a fool, for I shall be speaking the truth. But I refrain from it, so that no one may think more of me than he sees in me or hears from me. And to keep me from being too elated by the abundance of revelations, a thorn was given me in the flesh, a messenger of Satan, to harass me, to keep me from being too elated. Three times I besought the Lord about this, that it should leave me; but he said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness." I will all the more gladly boast of my weaknesses, that the power of Christ may rest upon me

Αδελφοί, Ό θεὸς καὶ πατὴς τοῦ κυςίου Ἰησοῦ Χςιστοῦ οἶδεν, ὁ ὢν εὐλογητὸς εἰς τοὺς αἰῶνας, ὅτι οὐ ψεύδομαι. Ἐν Δαμασκῷ ὁ ἐθνάρχης Ἀρέτα τοῦ βασιλέως ἐφρούρει τὴν Δαμασκηνῶν πόλιν, πιάσαι με θέλων· καὶ διὰ θυςίδος ἐν σαργάνῃ ἐχαλάσθην διὰ τοῦ τείχους καὶ ἐξέφυγον τὰς χείρας αὐτοῦ. Καυχᾶσθαι δὴ οὐ συμφέρει μοι· ἐλεύσομαι γὰρ εἰς ὀπτασίας καὶ ἀποκαλύψεις κυςίου. Οἶδα ἄνθρωπον ἐν Χριστῷ πρὸ ἐτῶν δεκατεσσάρων - εἴτε ἐν σώματι οὐκ οἶδα· εἴτε ἐκτὸς τοῦ σώματος οὐκ οἶδα· ὁ θεὸς οἶδεν - ἀρπαγέντα τὸν τοιοῦτον ἔως τρίτου οὐρανοῦ. Καὶ οἶδα τὸν τοιοῦτον ἄνθρωπον - εἴτε ἐν σώματι, εἴτε ἐκτὸς τοῦ σώματος, οὐκ οἶδα· ὁ θεὸς οἶδεν - ὅτι ἡρπάγη εἰς τὸν παράδεισον, καὶ ἡκουσεν ἄρρητα ἑἡματα, ἃ οὐκ ἑξὸν ἀνθρώπω λαλῆσαι. Ὑπὲς τοῦ τοιούτου καυχήσομαι· ὑπὲς δὲ ἐμαυτοῦ οὐ καυχήσομαι, εἰ μὴ ἐν ταῖς ἀσθενείαις μου· ἐὰν γὰρ θελήσω καυχήσασθαι, οὐκ ἔσομαι ἄφρων· ἀλήθειαν γὰρ ἐρῶ· φείδομαι δέ, μή τις εἰς ἐμὲ λογίσηται ὑπὲς ὃ βλέπει με, ἢ ἀκούει τι ἐξ ἐμοῦ. Καὶ τῃ ὑπερβολῆ τῶν ἀποκαλύψεων ἵνα μὴ ὑπεραίρωμαι, ἐδόθη μοι σκόλοψ τῆ σαρκί, ἄγγελος Σατᾶν, ἵνα με κολαφίζῃ, ἵνα μὴ ὑπεραίρωμαι. Ὑπὲς τούτου τοὶς τὸν κύριον παρεκάλεσα ἵνα ἀποστῆ ἀπ' ἐμοῦ. Καὶ εἴρηκέν μοι, Ἀρκεῖ σοι ἡ χάρις μου· ἡ γὰρ δύναμις μου ἐν ἀσθενείαι τελειοῦται. Ἡδιστα οὖν μᾶλλον καυχήσομαι ἐν ταῖς ἀσθενείαις μου, ἵνα ἐπισκηνώση ἐπ' ἐμὲ ἡ δύναμις τοῦ Χριστοῦ.

Ἐκ τοῦ Κατὰ Λουκᾶν 16:19-31 Εὐαγγελίου τὸ Ἀνάγνωσμα

The Lord said, "There was a rich man, who was clothed in purple and fine linen and who feasted sumptuously every day. And at his gate lay a poor man named Lazaros, full of sores, who desired to be fed with what fell from the rich man's table; moreover the dogs came and licked his sores. The poor man died and was carried by the angels to Abraham's bosom. The rich man also died and was buried; and in Hades, being in torment, he lifted up his eyes, and saw Abraham far off and Lazaros in his bosom. And he called out, 'Father Abraham, have mercy upon me, and send Lazaros to dip the end of his finger in water and cool my tongue; for I am in anguish in this flame.' But Abraham said, 'Son, remember that you in your lifetime received your good things, and Lazaros in like manner evil things; but now he is comforted here, and you are in anguish. And besides all this, between us and you a great chasm has been fixed, in order that those who would pass from here to you may not be able, and none may cross from there to us.' And he said, 'Then I beg you, father, to send him to my father's house, for I have five brothers, so that he may warn them, lest they also come into this place of torment.' But Abraham said, 'They have Moses, and the prophets; let them hear them.' And he said, 'No, father Abraham; but if some one goes to them from the dead, they will repent.' He said to them, 'If they do not hear Moses and the prophets, neither will they be convinced if some one should rise from the dead.'"



Πέντε διδάγματα

Σήμερα, ἀγαπητοί μου, σὲ ὅλους τοὺς ναοὺς τῆς Ὀρθοδόξου Ἐκκλησίας διαβάζεται ἡ περικοπὴ τοῦ εὐαγγελιστοῦ Λουκᾶ ποὺ
εἶνε γνωστὴ ὡς ἡ παραβολὴ τοῦ πλουσίου καὶ
τοῦ Λαζάρου (βλ. Μικ. 18,1931). Ὁ Λουκᾶς ἦταν γιατρὸς ἀλλὰ καὶ ζωγράφος ζωγραφίζει λοιπὸν
στὸ Εὐαγγέλιό του θαύματα καὶ παραβολὲς
τοῦ Κυρίου. Καὶ μία ἀπὸ τὶς ὡραιότερες εἰκόνες του εἶνε αὐτὴ ἡ σημερινὴ παραβολή. Ἔχουν περάσει τόσοι αἰῶνες, θὰ περάσουν καὶ
ἄλλοι, ἀλλὰ ἡ εἰκόνα τῆς παραβολῆς αὐτῆς
θὰ ἐξακολουθῆ νὰ ἔχη ἀμείωτη λάμψι.

Ζωγραφίζει δύο πρόσωπα· ἀπὸ τὴ μία τὸν πλούσιο στὸ ζενὶθ τῆς κατὰ κόσμον εὐτυχίας, καὶ ἀπὸ τὴν ἄλλη τὸν φτωχὸ στὸ ναδὶρ τῆς ἀνθρωπίνης δυστυχίας. Νὰ ἐρμηνεύσουμε ὅλη τὴν παραβολή; Οὕτε χρόνος ὑπάρχει, οὕτε ἐσεῖς ἔχετε ὑπομονή, οὕτε κ' ἐγὼ τὴ δύναμι. Θὰ προσπαθήσω μόνο, μὲ ἀφορμὴ τὴν παραβολή, νὰ βγάλω μερικὰ διδάγματα.

Πρῶτο δίδαγμα. Στὸν κόσμο αὐτὸν δὲν θὰ λείψη ποτέ ἡ δυστυχία· δὲν εἶνε δυνατόν. Θὰ ὑπάρχουν ἀπ' τὸ ἔνα μέρος πλούσιοι, ποὺ θὰ διαθέτουν κεφάλαια καὶ θὰ σκορπίζουν μέσα σὲ μιὰ νύχτα ἐκατομμύρια, κι ἀπ' τὸ ἄλλο μέρος φτωχοί, ποὺ δὲν θὰ ἔχουν οὕτε ψωμὶ νὰ φᾶνε οὕτε φάρμακο στὴν ἀρρώστια τους οὕτε μιὰ γωνιὰ νὰ στεγαστοῦν. Ἡ κατάστασι τοῦ Λαζάρου εἶκονίζει τὴ σύγχρονη ζωή.

Παρουσιάστηκαν βέβαια συστήματα παλαιότερα καὶ νεώτερα, ποὺ φιλοδόξησαν νὰ ἐξαλείψουν τὴν κοινωνικὴ ἀδικία, νὰ ἰσοπεδώσουν τὰ βουνὰ τῆς ἀνισότητος, νὰ κάνουν τὴ ζωὴ ἔνα λεῖο κάμπο χωρὶς τὶς αἰχμηρὲς προεξοχὲς τῆς ἰδιοτελείας καὶ τῆς ἀσπλαχνίας· ὑποσχέθηκαν, ὅτι ὅλοι οἱ ἄνθρωποι θὰ ζήσουν εὐτυχισμένοι. Τὸ πέτυχαν; "Όχι. "Η δυστυχία δὲν ἐξέλιπε οὕτε στὴ 'Ρωσία, ὅπου ἔγινε τὸ πείραμα τοῦ κομμουνισμοῦ. Τὴν ὥρα αὐτὴ ποὺ μιλᾶμε τὸ ἔνα τρίτο τῆς ἀνθρωπότητος ὑποσιτίζεται καὶ πολλοὶ πεθαίνουν ἀπὸ πεῖνα καὶ ἀσθένειες. Μένει λοιπὸν ἀπραγματοποίητο τὸ ὄνειρο τῆς ἀνθρωπότητος γιὰ δικαιοσύνη; "Όχι, ἀδελφοί μου. "Εὰν ὅλοι μας, ἐφαρμόσουμε τὸ Εὐαγγέλιο τοῦ Χριστοῦ, δὲν θὰ ὑπάρχουν πεινασμένοι καὶ δυστυχεῖς χωρὶς τὸ Εὐαγγέλιο ὅμως δὲν ὑπάρχει τέλος τῶν κακῶν.

 Τὸ δεύτερο δίδαγμα εἶνε, ὅτι κάποτε ὅλα τελειώνουν. Κι αν ακόμα ύποθέσουμε ότι καποιος ζῆ ὄχι ἔνα καὶ δυὸ χρόνια ἀλλὰ ἐκατὸ χρόνια σὲ πέλαγος εὐτυχίας, κ' εἶνε ἀπολύτως ύνιὴς καὶ πλούσιος ὅπως ὁ Κροῖσος καὶ δυνατὸς ὅπως ὁ Ναπολέων καὶ σοφὸς ὅπως ὁ Σολομῶν, αὐτὰ δὲν εἶνε αἰώνια. Τελειώνουν τὰ ώραῖα καὶ εὐχάριστα. "Ερχεται ὁ θάνατος, ὁ μεγάλος δημοκράτης, ποὺ ἐξισώνει ὅλους καὶ τοὺς Ισοπεδώνει ξαπλώνοντάς τους στὰ νεκροταφεῖα. "Όπως λένε τὰ τροπάρια τῆς Ἐκκλησίας, «ἐπελθὼν ὁ θάνατος, ταῦτα πάντα έξηφάνισται». Παύει πᾶσα διάκρισις: «*Αρα τίς έστι; βασιλεύς ἢ στρατιώτης, πλούσιος ἢ πένης, δίκαιος ή άμαρτωλός;» (Ακολ νεκρία διόμελ ής. γκαίηλα), Άλλ' ὅπως τελειώνουν τὰ ὡραῖα, ἔτσι τελειώνουν καὶ τὰ ἄσχημα καὶ δυσάρεστα. "Αν ύποθέσουμε ότι κάποιος ἐπὶ ἐκατὸ χρόνια δὲν βλέπει ἄσπρη μέρα, ἀλλὰ ζῆ ἀσθενὴς καὶ φτωχὸς καὶ ἀδικημένος, θὰ ἔρθη ὅμως καὶ νι' αύτὸν τὸ τέλος τῶν δεινῶν.

Συνεπῶς· καὶ σὺ ποὺ εὐτυχεῖς, μὴν ἐπαναπαύεσαι καὶ παγιδεύεσαι, καὶ σὺ ποὺ ὑποφέρεις, μὴν ἀπελπίζεσαι καὶ ἀθυμεῖς.

 Τὸ τρίτο δίδαγμα. Γιὰ νὰ λέμε τὴν ἀλήθεια, εἵμαστε ἐπιπόλαια καὶ ῥηχὰ πνεύματα δὲν ἔχουμε ἐμβαθύνει στὰ μυστήρια τοῦ Θεοῦ. Πρέπει νὰ τὸ πιστέψουμε ἀκραδάντως ὁ θάνατος δὲν ἀποτελεῖ τὸ τέρμα τῆς ζωῆς. "Όχι.

Δὲν εἴμαστε σὰν τὰ δέντρα ποὺ ξεραίνονται ἢ σὰν τὰ ζῷα ποὺ ψοφοῦν· εἴμαστε κάτι ἀνώτερο. Ὁ ἄνθρωπος ἔχει ψυχὴ ἀθάνατη. Τὸ σῶμα λειώνει, διαλύεται, ἀλλὰ ἡ ψυχὴ ὑπάρχει, μένει. Τί λέει τὸ σημερινὸ εὐαγγέλιο; Μᾶς παρουσιάζει τὶς δύο ψυχές· ἀπὸ τὴ μιὰ μεριὰ τοῦ πλουσίου στὴν κόλασι (τὴν ὁποία συμβολίζουν τὰ βάσανα καὶ ἡ φλόγα), κι ἀπὸ τὴν ἄλλη τοῦ Λαζάρου στὸν παράδεισο (τὸν ὁποῖο συμβολίζει ὁ κόλπος τοῦ Άβραάμ).

"Αθεοι, ἄπιστοι καὶ ὑλισταί, δὲν εἶνε ψέμα· ναί ὑπάρχει ἄλλος κόσμος, ἄλλη ζωή!

- Τέταρτο δίδαγμα. "Αν έδῶ ἀπὸ τὰ μάτια σου στάξη ἔνα δάκρυ μετανοίας γιὰ τὰ κρίματά σου, τὸ δάκρυ αὐτὸ γίνεται θάλασσα μέσα στὴν ὁποία σβήνουν όλα τ' άμαρτήματα. "Όταν όμως ὁ θάνατος μᾶς σφαλίση γιὰ πάντα τὰ μάτια καὶ ἀπ' έδῶ μὲ τὴ βαρκούλα τῆς ὑπάρξεώς μας διαπεράσουμε στη χώρα της αίωνιότητος, έκεῖ δχι ένα δάκρυ άλλὰ έναν Άλιάκμονα δακρύων νὰ χύσουμε πενθοῦντες, ἐκεῖνα τὰ δάκρυα δὲν θὰ ἔχουν καμμία ἰσχύ. Ἐκεῖ θ' ἀναστενάζουν οί ἄσπλαχνοι πλούσιοι, θὰ κλαΐνε οί πόρνοι καὶ οἱ μοιχοί, θὰ βογγοῦν οἱ βλάστημοι, θὰ καταριώνται τὴν ἡμέρα τῆς γεννήσεώς τους οί άμετανόητοι άμαρτωλοί, μὰ δὲν θὰ είσακούωνται. ή σημερινή παραβολή μᾶς βεβαιώνει, ότι «ἐν τῷ ἄδη οὐκ ἔστι μετάνοια».
- "Ενα τελευταΐο δίδαγμα προσφέρει ὁ σπουδαΐος διάλογος τῆς παραβολῆς -θά 'θελα ἐκτενέστερα νὰ διατρίψω σ' αὐτόν-, διάλογος ποὺ ἔγινε στὸν ἄδη· γιατὶ κ' ἐκεῖ ὁμιλοῦν οἱ ψυχές.

Ό πλούσιος, ἐνῷ καίγεται στὴν κόλασι, βλέπει τὸ Λάζαρο στὸν παράδεισο καὶ παρακαλεῖ·

-Πάτερ Άβραάμ, λέει, στείλε τὸ Λάζαρο νὰ μοῦ δροσίση λίγο τὴ γλῶσσα μὲ τὸ δαχτυλάκι του, γιατὶ βασανίζομαι σὲ τούτη τὴ φλόγα· μιὰ στάλα δροσιᾶς παραδείσου ζητῶ.

Μ' αὐτὸ μοιάζει ἐκεῖνο ποὺ ἔλεγε ὁ Ῥήγας Φεραῖος· «Καλύτερα μιᾶς ὥρας ἐλεύθερη ζωὴ παρὰ σαράντα χρόνια σκλαβιὰ καὶ φυλακή». Δὲν ζητῶ πολλά· παρακαλῶ γιὰ μιὰ στιγμὴ χαρᾶς ἀπὸ ἐκείνην ποὺ αἰσθάνεται ἡ ψυχὴ ὅταν λέῃ «Μνήσθητί μου, Κύριε...» Νω ဩΘ, ἐκείνη μὲ τὴν ὁποία δὲν συγκρίνονται οἱ ἐπίγειες χαρές.

-Όχι, ἀπαντῷ ὁ ᾿Αβραάμ· ὁ καθένας σας ἔζησε ὅπως διάλεξε. Καὶ τώρα χάσμα μεγάλο χωρίζει τὴ μία κατάστασι ἀπὸ τὴν ἄλλη· εἶνε

άδύνατη κάθε ἐπικοινωνία.

'Ο πλούσιος ὑποβάλλει δεύτερη παράκλησι"Έχω, πάτερ, στὴ γῆ πέντε ἀδέρφια. Ζοῦν ὅπως ζοῦσα κ' ἐγώ· σὲ παρακαλῶ, στεῖλε τὸ Λάζαρο στὸ πατρικό μου νὰ τοὺς πῆ νὰ μετανοήσουν μὴν ἔρθουν κι αὐτοὶ σὲ τοῦτα τὰ βάσανα.

- Έχουν τὸ Μωυσῆ καὶ τοὺς προφῆτες, τοῦ ἀπαντὰ ὁ Άβραάμ· ᾶς ἀκούσουν αὐτούς.

Μὰ ὁ πλούσιος ἔχει ἀντίρρησι κ' ἐπιμένει·
-"Όχι, πάτερ· ἃν ὅμως ἀναστηθῆ κάποιος νεκρὸς καὶ πάη σ' αὐτούς, θὰ μετανοιώσουν.

Καὶ ὁ Ἀβραὰμ κλείνει τὸ διάλογο λέγοντας -«Εί Μωϋσέως καὶ τῶν προφητῶν οὐκ ἀκούουσιν, οὐδὲ ἐάν τις ἐκ νεκρῶν ἀναστῆ πεισθήσονται» (λωκ 1631) - ἃν δὲν ἀκοῦνε τὴ Γραφή, καὶ νεκρανάστασι νὰ δοῦν δὲν θὰ πεισθοῦν. Θὰ ἥθελα στὸ σημεῖο αὐτὸ νὰ κάνω εἰδικὴ ὁμιλία· ἀλλ' ᾶς τελειώσω μὲ τὰ ἐξῆς λίγα λόγια ἐπὶ τῆς παραβολῆς, ποὺ κάποιος τὴν χαρακτήρισε ὡς κοινωνικὸ εὐαγγέλιο.

Πολλοί, άγαπητοί μου, ζητοῦν θαύματα γιὰ νὰ πιστέψουν νὰ ἔρθη π.χ. κάποιος ἀπ' τὸν ἄλλο κόσμο καὶ νὰ πῆ, 'Υπάρχει κόλασι καὶ παράδεισος! "Όχι, άδελφοί μου. Κι αὐτὸ νὰ γίνη, δὲν πιστεύουν. 'Απόδειξις' ὁ Χριστὸς ἀνέστησε τὸν τετραήμερο Λάζαρο. Πίστεψαν; "Όχι μόνο δὲν πίστεψαν, ἀλλὰ καὶ μελετοῦσαν πῶς νὰ θανατώσουν πάλι τὸν ἀναστημένο! [βλ. lu. 12.10-11]. Τόσο διεφθαρμένος εἶνε ὁ ἄνθρωπος' ὅποιος δὲν ἔχει καλὴ διάθεσι, ὅσα θαύματα κι ἄν δῆ δὲν πιστεύει.

Καὶ λοιπόν, δὲν ὑπάρχει κάτι ποὺ νὰ πείθη γιὰ τὴν πέρα τοῦ τάφου αἰωνία ζωή; "Υπάρχει ἔνα θαῦμα· μὴ μοῦ μιλᾶτε γιὰ ἄλλα θαύματα. Αὐτὸ εἶνε τὸ θαῦμα τῶν θαυμάτων. "Αν αὐτὸ δὲν τὸ πιστέψετε, τότε πλέον εἶστε ἄξιοι τῆς τύχης σας. Ποιό εἶνε τὸ θαῦμα; Εἶνε τὸ Εὐαγγέλιο, τὸ μικρὸ αὐτὸ βιβλίο, ποὺ μπορεῖτε νὰ τὸ ἀπολαμβάνετε μέρα καὶ νύχτα.

*Ω Εὐαγγέλιο, λόγια τοῦ Χριστοῦ ἀθάνατα! Κόσμε ταλαίπωρε, ποὺ ἀνοίγεις ῥαδιόφωνα καὶ τηλεοράσεις, νά τὸ θαῦμα! Πάρ' το, ἄνοιξέ το, μελέτησέ το. *Απιστοι, ποὺ τὸ μελέτησαν εἶπαν «Άληθῶς Θεοῦ Υίὸς ἦν οὖτος» (Μπθ. 27,54).

"Ένα παράδειγμα. 'Ο 'Ρῶσος Ντοστογιέφσκυ ἤταν ἄθεος· ἀλλ' ὅταν ἤρθε σὲ σύγκρουσι μὲ τὸ τσαρικὸ καθεστώς καὶ τὸν ὡδηγοῦσαν δεμένο στὴ Σιβηρία, στὸ δρόμο σ' ἔνα χωριό, μιὰ ἀπλοϊκὴ 'Ρωσίδα τοῦ 'δωσε λίγα φροῦτα καὶ τοῦ εἶπε· -Πάρε, γυιόκα μου, κι αὐτὸ τὸ μικρὸ βιβλίο (τὸ Εὐαγγέλιο) νὰ τὸ διαβάσης. Γέλασε ὁ Ντοστογιέφσκυ, ἀλλὰ τὸ πῆρε. Καὶ μέσα στὰ τρία χρόνια ποὺ ἔμεινε στὶς φυλακὲς ἤταν τὸ μόνο βιβλίο ποὺ διάβαζε. "Ανοιξαν τὰ μάτια του, πίστεψε, ἔγινε ἄλλος ἄνθρωπος καὶ κορυφαῖος λογοτέχνης.

Δὲν εἶνε ντροπή μας, νὰ διαβάζουν τὸ Εὐαγγέλιο Ῥῶσοι, Ἅγγλοι, Νέγροι,... κ' ἐμεῖς ποὺ τό χουμε γραμμένο στὴ γλῶσσα μας, νὰ μὴν τὸ διαβάζουμε; Χωρὶς τὴ Γραφὴ δὲν μπορεῖς νὰ σωθῆς. Ἐκεῖ θὰ δῆς τὸ πρόσωπο μὲ «τὸ

δνομα τὸ ὑπὲρ πᾶν δνομα» (Φλ 25).

Παντοῦ λοιπὸν ἡ Γραφή! στὰ σπίτια καὶ στὰ σχολεῖα. Καὶ τώρα ποὺ ἄρχισαν τὰ κατηχητικὰ μαθήματα παρακαλῶ ὅλους νὰ τρέξουν σὰν διψασμένα ἐλάφια γιὰ νὰ δροσιστοῦν στὰ ρεύματα τοῦ Εὐαγγελίου, καὶ κανείς νὰ μὴ βρεθῆ στὸν τόπο τῆς κολάσεως, ἀλλὰ ὅλοι ν' ἀπολαύσουμε τὴ χαρὰ στὴν ἀπέραντη αἰωνιότητα διὰ πρεσβειῶν τῆς ὑπεραγίας Θεοτόκου καὶ πάντων τῶν ἀγίων ἀμήν.

Lazarus and the Rich Man

In the 1940's, France was known for it's extensive collection of Egyptian artifacts. Many forgotten treasures were holed up in the basement of a Paris museum. One day, some workmen uncovered a forgotten burial case pushed into a dark corner of the basement. They decided that the box would be an excellent storage container for many of the smaller artifacts. So, without consulting any of the museum authorities, the workmen took it upon themselves to empty the contents of the box into the sewer. They then filled the empty box with odds and rich man was not his welath, it was his blindends. Some time later, they made the unhappy discovery that they had mistakenly discarded the remains of Cleopatra, one of the most famous women of ancient Egypt!

In ignorance, people regularly discard things of great value. One of the more valuable

things that people discard are opportunities. We see this in today's Gospel reading of the Parable of Lazarus and the Rich Man. The rich man had everything he needed in the world, while Lazarus was in constant need. Each day, the rich man had the opportunity to attend to the need of Lazarus who wanted nothing more than to eat the crumbs which fell from his table. The rich man, for his part, never abused Lazarus or mistreated him - his simply ignored him and for this he was condemned. The sin of the ness - blindness to the needs of others.
