

## LIFE'S JOURNEY IS NOT LINEAR!

"Amen, amen, I say to you, before Abraham came to be, I AM " John 8:58

Most of us are slaves to the calculation of time. Whether it be on the 'church calendar' posted on our refrigerator, or the listing on our phone or the web-site, we record important events, not to be overlooked. Doctor's appointments, tax payments (IRS) vacation plans, anniversaries, birthdays, and items of personal concerns are circled on the monthly page. The world view is strictly linear. Essentially it is a direct line from the present to the future. Our mind registers these indicators on the clockwork measure of time. However a variety of 'cultures' perceive time not in a straight unaltered line, but rather in a circular enduring relationship. The fellowship of man, and the DIVINE IS A CONSTANT CIRCULAR MOVEMENT OF GENERATION AND RETURN TO IT'S SOURCE. It's literally an embracement of spirit and flesh.

In the eye of the 'DIVINE', all creation and creatures therein are connected regardless of time or venue! Hence we are a people steeped in the hope of divinized eternal life.
